To All Banks in the Eleventh Federal Reserve District:

The Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, in cooperation with the United States Secret Service, has developed several exhibits comparing U. S. currency with counterfeit currency. Each exhibit contains counterfeit currency in denominations of \$1-5-10-20-50-100, displayed with genuine bills of the same denominations. The exhibits are designed to test an individual's ability to detect counterfeit currency.

The exhibits and the accompanying brochures will serve to familiarize the banking community and its customers with features of the genuine currency that will aid in counterfeit detection.
