ELECTION OF DIRECTORS REPORT OF NOMINATIONS — VOTING PROCEDURES

To All Member Banks

in the Eleventh Federal Reserve District:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act and my circular dated August 29, 1972, in regard to the election of directors of this Bank to succeed Mr. Murray Kyger, Class A Director, and Mr. C. A. Tatum, Jr., Class B Director, whose terms expire December 31, 1972, there are given herein the names of the candidates nominated for such directors and the names of the banks which made the nominations.

There is sent herewith to each bank in Group 1 a ballot for use in voting for a Class A Director and to each bank in Group 2 a ballot for use in voting for a Class B Director. An envelope bearing on its face the certificate in regard to the vote and a colored envelope marked "Ballot — Directors' Election," in which the ballot is to be sealed, are also enclosed.

The ballot and certificate on the envelope must be executed by an officer who has been authorized to cast the vote. A list of the designated officers, revised to date, forms a part of this circular. In order that the balloting may be secret, the name of the bank and of the voting officer should not be written on the ballot but only on the certificate envelope. If the official signature of the officer casting the ballot has not been filed with this Federal Reserve Bank, such official signature should be filed before the polls close.

Please follow carefully the instructions which are printed on the ballot and on the envelopes.

The following procedure is required in the case of both the Class A and Class B ballots:

- (1) The ballot should be marked.
- (2) It should then be placed in the colored envelope marked "Ballot Directors' Election" and that envelope sealed.
- (3) Then after the certificate on the white certificate envelope is executed, the colored sealed envelope (containing the ballot) should be placed within the white certificate envelope and that envelope sealed.
- (4) The sealed white certificate envelope containing the sealed ballot envelope should then be returned to me in the enclosed self-addressed envelope.

Under the law, the ballot must be returned so as to reach me within 15 days after its receipt. The polls will open on October 10, 1972 and close at 2 p.m. on October 25, 1972. At that time the ballot box will be opened at this Bank, the sealed envelopes containing the ballots will be opened, the votes counted, and the results of the election announced. The candidates are invited to be present or represented on that occasion.

While the banks in Group 3 will not vote in this election, this circular is sent to them, without forms, for their information. Group 3 consists of member banks with combined capital and surplus of under \$650,000.

CANDIDATE FOR CLASS A DIRECTOR

ROBERT H. STEWART, III

Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer
First National Bank in Dallas
Dallas, Texas

Mr. Stewart was born in Dallas, Texas, on December 3, 1925. He graduated from Highland Park High School in Dallas, attended Kemper Military School, Booneville, Missouri, and received his B.B.A. degree in banking from Southern Methodist University in 1949. He served as a First Lieutenant in the Infantry of the Army of the United States from 1944 to 1946, part of which time he served in Korea.

He began his banking career with the Empire State Bank, Dallas, Texas, as a runner in 1949 and was promoted to Assistant Cashier in 1950. Mr. Stewart has been with the First National Bank in Dallas since January 1951, starting as an Assistant Cashier in the Business Development Department and advancing through the ranks until he was elected President and Chief Executive Officer on January 19, 1960. He was elected Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of the First National Bank in Dallas in June 1965, which position he currently holds.

From January 1, 1966 through December 31, 1968, Mr. Stewart served as a member of the Federal Advisory Council representing the Eleventh Federal Reserve District. That Council meets periodically with the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System in Washington, D. C., to confer on general business and economic conditions and to make recommendations to the Board of Governors on matters related to credit and monetary policy.

Mr. Stewart is widely known in southwestern and national banking circles, and he is a director of a number of large financial and other corporations in the Dallas area including, among others, the following: Allied Finance Company; Braniff International Airways, Inc.; Campbell Taggart, Inc.; Dallas Power & Light Company; National Chemsearch Corporation; Republic Financial Services, Inc.; and Southwestern Life Insurance Company. He served as President of the Dallas Clearing House Association in 1966.

He has been active in civic affairs for a number of years. Some of the public service directorships which he currently holds are the following: United Fund; State Fair of Texas; Cotton Bowl Athletic Association; Dallas Council on World Affairs, Dallas Crime Commission, Dallas Symphony Orchestra, Greater Dallas Planning Council, Junior Achievement of Dallas, Camp Grady Spruce (YMCA), Kidney Foundation of Texas, Presbyterian Hospital of Texas,

Southwestern Medical Foundation, Texas A & M Research Foundation, Texas Research Foundation, Texas Research League, Trinity Improvement Program, and Texas 4-H Youth Development Foundation. He is also serving as a member of the Board of Governors of Southern Methodist University. He served as Chairman of the Finance Committee of the Committee for Economic Development 1969-70, President of the Dallas Citizens Council in 1969, and as a member of the Steering Committee for North Texas Commission of the Dallas Chamber of Commerce in 1971. He served as a member of President Nixon's Commission on the Financial Structure and Regulation from June 1970 to December 1971.

Mr. Stewart was elected one of the five Outstanding Young Texans in 1960.

He is a member of the Highland Park Presbyterian Church. He is also a member of the Brook Hollow Golf Club in Dallas and the Augusta National Golf Club.

Mr. Stewart is married and has two daughters. The family home is in Dallas.

CANDIDATE FOR CLASS B DIRECTOR

THOMAS W. HERRICK

President Mesa Agro Inc. Amarillo, Texas

Mr. Herrick was born in Denver, Colorado, on April 26, 1928. He attended Denver Public Schools and Colorado State University where he was a member of several agriculture related organizations and the Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity.

Mr. Herrick served in the U. S. Army from 1948 through 1949 and received an honorable discharge as a Sergeant.

Before entering the Army, Mr. Herrick was a show herdsman with the Pollock Hereford Ranch in Sacramento, California, and immediately subsequent to the service, he was a salesman trainee with the Denver Livestock Commission at the Denver Union Stockyards. After military duty, he worked in general cattle sales with the Denver Livestock Commission Company.

In 1954 he joined his father in the purchase of John Clay & Company, a livestock commission firm, where they made sales and purchases of cattle for their own account and were agents for others.

In 1958 Mr. Herrick and his family moved to Amarillo where he became associated with several companies engaged in the buying and selling of livestock, ranching, farming, and operating feed yards. In 1963 he became a full partner in these firms and concentrated on the expansion of the cattle-feeding industry.

Mr. Herrick and several other individuals formed Randall County Feed Yards, Central Cattle Company, and Central Leasing Company of Amarillo in 1967. These firms engaged in ranching, farming (backgrounding of feeder cattle), custom cattle feeding, and other related activities.

At the time that these companies were acquired by Mesa Petroleum Company, Randall County Feed Yard had been expanded to the largest feedlot in Texas with 60,000 head.

When these companies were acquired by Mesa Petroleum Company, a subsidiary, Mesa Agro Inc., was formed and Mr. Herrick was named President. As President of Mesa Agro Inc., he has the responsibility of operating three feed yards with a one-time capacity of 170,000 head, numerous ranches and farms in the backgrounding of cattle, and also a grain elevator and grain procurement company.

Mr. Herrick is President of the Texas Cattle Feeders Association; a past President of the Panhandle Livestock Association; a director of the Texas Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association, American National Cattlemen's Association, Cal Farley's Boys Ranch, and the Tri-State Fair Association. He is a past director of the Amarillo Chamber of Commerce and is a member of the U. S. Secretary of Agriculture's Livestock Advisory Committee.

In 1950 Mr. Herrick married Ann L. Elliott of Denver, and they have three daughters and a son. Mr. Herrick and his family attend the Catholic church and their home is in Amarillo.
