## SLIDE PRESENTATION -- "BOGUS MONEY"

## TO THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE MEMBER BANK ADDRESSED IN THE ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

The Eleventh Federal Reserve District now has available to all member banks a slide presentation entitled "Bogus Money." The program was developed in cooperation with the Secret Service to help increase awareness and knowledge of the counterfeiting problem and to teach methods of detecting bogus money.

The presentation, which should take about 30 minutes, consists of 40 slides and related commentary. You will only need 35mm projection equipment and a screen in order to present a program that should have wide-spread appeal. The text of the presentation indicates when each numbered slide should be shown and also gives explanations and statistical data concerning each slide. To complement the presentation, counterfeit exhibits and distribution material are also available, if desired.
