TO ALL BANKS  
IN THE ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

Charles A. Gore, Chief Examiner of the Bank, will take an early retirement on February 1, 1975, after nearly 37 years of service with the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas. Mr. Gore, who was employed by the Bank in 1938, has served in various positions in the Examination Department since 1944. He is a native of Dallas and attended Southern Methodist University, where he received his Bachelor of Science degree in Commerce and where he was a member of the 1935 SMU football team which played in the 1936 Rose Bowl Game. While this Bank and the Federal Reserve System will miss his leadership, we join with all his friends and associates in wishing him a pleasant retirement.

Replacing Mr. Gore in the official position of Chief Examiner, effective February 1, 1975, will be John C. Blake, Review Examiner. He has almost 35 years of service with the Bank, including more than 26 years of continuous service in the Examination and Regulations Departments.
