REVISED SUPPLEMENT A TO BULLETIN 1

TO ALL MEMBER BANKS  
AND OTHERS CONCERNED IN THE  
ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

The Texas Legislature has amended the list of banking holidays set out in the Texas Banking Code of 1943 to change the observance of Veterans' Day from the fourth Monday in October to November 11.

Accordingly, the Bank has amended the listing of nonbanking days observed by it to reflect this change.

You should remove Supplement A to Bulletin 1, "Banking and Nonbanking Days," dated July 27, 1971, presently in your binder, and replace it with the amended Supplement A, printed on the reverse of this circular.

**Supplement A****BANKING AND NONBANKING DAYS****A-1.00 Nonbanking days**

Nonbanking days for all offices of this Bank are:

Saturday

Sunday

January 1 (New Year's Day)

Third Monday in February (Presidents' Day)

Last Monday in May (Memorial Day)

July 4 (Independence Day)

First Monday in September (Labor Day)

Second Monday in October (Columbus Day)

November 11 (Veterans' Day)

Fourth Thursday in November (Thanksgiving Day)

December 25 (Christmas Day)

Any other day which this Bank elects to treat as a nonbanking day. (In such a case, advance notification will be sent.)

Should January 1, July 4, or December 25 occur on a Saturday, this Bank will be closed the preceding Friday. Should they occur on a Sunday, this Bank will be closed the following Monday.

**A-2.00 Banking days**

All days not listed as nonbanking days in A-1.00 of this bulletin are banking days for all offices of this Bank.
