AMENDMENTS TO RULES REGARDING DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

TO ALL MEMBER BANKS
AND OTHERS CONCERNED IN THE
ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System has amended its Rules Regarding Delegation of Authority effective March 19, 1975, and June 11, 1975.

The March 19, 1975 amendment reflects the delegation of authority to a designated Board member, contained in the revised Rules Regarding Availability of Information, to review and make determinations with respect to an appeal of a denial of access to records of the Board.

The June 11, 1975 amendment delegates authority to the Secretary of the Board to extend the time period for public comment on proposed regulations.

Printed on the reverse of this circular are the amendments to the Rules Regarding Delegation of Authority, referred to above, which should be filed in your Regulations binder. Additional copies will be furnished upon request to the Secretary's Office of this Bank.

RULES REGARDING DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

AMENDMENTS

Effective March 19, 1975, section 265.1a(b) is added to read as follows:

SECTION 265.1a—SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS DELEGATED TO BOARD MEMBERS

(b) Any Board member designated by the Chairman is authorized:

(1) Under section (a)(6) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. §552) and Part 261 of this Chapter (Rules Regarding Availability of Information) to review and make a determination with respect to an appeal of denial of access to records of the Board made in accordance with the procedures prescribed by the Board.

Effective June 11, 1975, section 265.2(a)(13) is added to read as follows:

SECTION 265.2—SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS DELEGATED TO BOARD EMPLOYEES AND FEDERAL RESERVE BANKS

(a) The Secretary of the Board (or, in his absence, the Acting Secretary) is authorized:

(13) Under the provisions of sections 262.2(a) and (b) of the Board's Rules of Procedure, to extend, when appropriate, the time period provided for public participation with respect to proposed regulations of the Board of Governors.
