TO ALL BANKS IN THE
ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

By order of the U.S. District Court, Eastern District of Louisiana, dated May 29, 1975, William E. Simon, Secretary of the Treasury, and Francine Neff, Treasurer, and those persons acting on their behalf or pursuant to their authority, to include the various Federal Reserve Banks, were enjoined from honoring, redeeming, or paying upon presentment the following Treasury bills:
