This is to advise that the Commerce National Bank of Conroe, Conroe, Texas, a newly organized institution located in the territory served by the Houston Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, opened for business Monday, November 3, 1975, as a member of the Federal Reserve System.

The new member bank has capital of \$800,000, surplus of \$300,000, and undivided profits of \$200,000.
