## OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT

## TO ALL BANKS IN THE ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

It is a pleasure to announce that the Board of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas has made the following changes in the official staff of the Head Office effective today:

George C. Cochran, III, Vice President, has been promoted to Senior Vice President. Mr. Cochran will have responsibility for the Bank's Examination, Regulations, and Loans functions. A native of Dallas, Mr. Cochran joined the Bank in 1962. He held several positions in the Legal and Regulations Departments before being promoted to Vice President in January 1973. A graduate of Southern Methodist University and Harvard Law School, Mr. Cochran is a member of the Texas, Dallas, and American Bar Associations. Mr. Cochran has taught at the Southern Methodist University Law School and has been on the faculty of the Southwestern Graduate School of Banking at Southern Methodist University. He is also a graduate of the School of Banking of the South at Louisiana State University.

Harry E. Robinson, Jr., Vice President, has also been promoted to Senior Vice President. Mr. Robinson will have responsibility for the Cash, Fiscal Agency, Personnel, Protection, Securities, and Services and Building Maintenance functions. Mr. Robinson joined the Bank in 1955. He was elected to the official position of Assistant Cashier in 1966, promoted to Assistant Vice President in 1968, and promoted to Vice President in 1974. A native of Port Arthur, Texas, Mr. Robinson holds a B.B.A. degree from North Texas State University and an M.B.A. from The University of Texas at Austin. Mr. Robinson is a graduate of the Graduate School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin and has also served on the faculty of the Southwestern Graduate School of Banking. He is a member of the Dallas Management Association and the Dallas Personnel Association.
