## TRUNCATION OF TREASURY CHECKS

TO ALL MEMBER BANKS
AND OTHERS CONCERNED IN THE
ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

In the first half of 1978, this District will implement a new means of processing Treasury checks. Under the new processing method, Treasury checks will be truncated at the first Reserve Bank of deposit, and microfilm images and magnetic tape data will be furnished the Treasury Department. This should greatly expedite the processing cycle. To accommodate this new mode of processing, the symbol and serial number of each check will be pre-encoded in addition to the already MICR encoded routing number. On some checks, an additional one-digit transaction code will be MICR encoded in position 16; it is therefore important that this field not be used by your institution.

A sample Treasury check with the encoding referenced above is printed on the following page.

Due to this new method of processing Treasury checks, the following procedures must be followed when Treasury checks are submitted to a Reserve office for payment:

- All Treasury checks deposited with a Federal Reserve Bank must be amount encoded.
- All deposits submitted on or after December 15, 1977 must be accompanied by a form MAIL-68, "Advice of Shipment." A supply of these forms will be sent to banks currently depositing Government checks with any Reserve office prior to December 15, 1977.
- 3. No more than 2,000 items should be sent with each MAIL-68.
- 4. After May 1, 1978, depositing banks that have rehabilitation capabilities are encouraged to rehabilitate items that reject from their high speed check handling equipment. All fields should be rehabilitated for proper processing.
