TO ALL BANKS IN THE ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

There is enclosed a loose-leaf binder entitled "Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas Emergency Bulletins." The binder presents the basic plans, authorities, and procedures under which the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, its Branches, and the district commercial banks would operate in the event of a national emergency.

It is recommended that the enclosed material be made available to members of your staff, since knowledge of the operating capabilities of the commercial banking system will be most important in the event of a national emergency. This will aid the staff members of commercial banks in having a knowledge of the provisions that have been made for the continuity of the banking system and the restrictions that will be placed on the use of money and credit.
