In accordance with the Texas statutes relating to bank holidays, should July 4, November 11, or December 25 occur on a Saturday, this Bank will be closed the preceding Friday. Should January 1, July 4, November 11, or December 25 occur on a Sunday, this Bank will be closed on the following Monday.

Please file this circular for convenient reference as individual notices of the holidays listed above will not be sent.

If there should be a change in the Texas Statutes relating to bank holidays, a revised schedule of holidays to be observed by this Bank and its Branches will be furnished.
