PAYMENT OF BAHAMIAN POSTAL MONEY ORDERS

TO ALL BANKS IN THE ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

We have been advised by the Postal Service that by agreement between the United States Postal Service (USPS) and the Commonwealth of the Bahamas, domestic (U.S.A.) Bahamian postal money orders will be accepted for payment by the USPS. Therefore, banks may deposit such money orders with us in the same manner as U.S. postal money orders.

The new money order contains a seal and is printed on white paper stock with light blue lines. For your information, a photocopy of the revised format is printed on the reverse of this circular. These revised Bahamian money orders are negotiable.

If you have any questions concerning the handling of these money orders, please contact your local Postmaster or the supervisor of our Government Check/Post Office Money Order Section, Ext. 6230.
