The Federal Reserve Board today announced that, effective immediately, it will make available to members of the public, upon request, final agency enforcement documents or portions of such documents, as the case may be, issued by the Board to enforce the Truth-in-Lending Act, the Equal Credit Opportunity Act, the Fair Housing Act, the Fair Credit Reporting Act, the Electronic Funds Transfer Act, the Fair Debt Collection Act, the Fair Credit Billing Act, and the Community Reinvestment Act. Such documents and portions of documents will be made available without charge but with identifying details relating to financial institutions and third parties removed to protect valid interests of confidentiality. This action was taken in order to accomplish the fullest possible public disclosure of information consistent with such valid interests of confidentiality.
