Effective March 1, 1981, this District will discontinue Noncash services for collection of municipal and corporate coupons for any bank which has not executed an auto charge agreement. This will include coupons which are clipped from securities held in our Safekeeping Vaults.

If your bank has not signed an auto charge agreement (form COLL-187 for member banks, form COLL-188 for nonmember banks), please call the Federal Reserve office that services the geographic area in which you are located.
