TO ALL DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS IN THE ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

Net Settlement is a service provided by the Federal Reserve System. As required by the Monetary Control Act of 1980, this Bank imposed a charge for such services beginning January 29, 1981.

This Net Settlement service will now be governed in accordance with the terms and conditions of Bulletin 15. The Bulletin will apply to all present and future settlement arrangements for which the Reserve Bank levies a charge and the clearings of which the Reserve Bank does not participate. The new Bulletin 15 is enclosed and should be filed in Vol. I of your Regulations Binders.

All current Settlement Group members are requested to respond, as soon as practical, by providing the necessary letter as shown in the exhibits in Bulletin 15.
