TO ALL MEMBER BANKS IN THE ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

During the remainder of 1982, this Bank and its Branches at El Paso, Houston, and San Antonio, Texas, will observe the following holidays and will not be open on the dates indicated below:

February 15, Presidents' Day May 31, Memorial Day July 5, Independence Day September 6, Labor Day October 11, Columbus Day November 11, Veterans' Day November 25, Thanksgiving Day December 24, Christmas Day

In accordance with the Texas statutes relating to bank holidays, should July 4, November 11, or December 25 occur on a Saturday, this Bank will be closed the preceding Friday. Should January 1, July 4, November 11, or December 25 occur on a Sunday, this Bank will be closed the following Monday.

This is also to inform you that the Detroit Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago will process transfers of funds and securities transfers on February 12, 1982, Lincoln's birthday, which is a banking holiday for that office.

Please file this circular for convenient reference as individual notices of the holidays listed above will not be sent.

If there should be a change in the Texas statutes relating to bank holidays, a revised schedule of holidays to be observed by this Bank and its Branches will be furnished.
