COIN WRAPPING SERVICE

(Changes in Billing Procedure and Charge)

TO ALL DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS IN THE
HEAD OFFICE TERRITORY OF THE
ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

Earlier this year, the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas announced the availability of a new coin wrapping service. In order to improve the efficiency of the service, a new billing procedure will be instituted.


Effective January 3, 1983, the contract carrier for wrapping will bill directly for wrapped coin ordered from the Federal Reserve. Each endpoint receiving wrapped coin will be billed monthly based on the per roll charge.

The change to the billing procedure allows a reduction in the per roll charge for wrapped coin. The charge will be reduced from 3.7 cents per roll to 3.1 cents per roll.
