RESTRUCTURING OF TENTH AND ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICTS

TO ALL DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS IN THE  
ELEVENTH FEDERAL RESERVE DISTRICT:

The Federal Reserve Board has announced approval of the transfer of eight counties in Oklahoma from the Eleventh Federal Reserve District to the Tenth Federal Reserve District effective in May 1984. These counties include Atoka, Bryan, Choctaw, Coal, Johnston, McCurtain, Marshall and Pushmataha. This area will be served by the Oklahoma City Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Kansas City after the effective date of the transfer.

The Federal Reserve Board has approved the transfer of eight counties in Southeast Oklahoma from the Eleventh (Dallas) District to the Tenth (Kansas City) District. These counties include Atoka, Bryan, Choctaw, Coal, Johnston, McCurtain, Marshall and Pushmataha. The area would become part of the territory served by the Oklahoma City Branch of the Kansas City Reserve Bank. This change will become effective May, 1984.
