SUBJECT

The resumption of delivery of ACH items to those financial institutions still closed in the State of Ohio, and the reopening of certain institutions in Ohio

DETAILS

According to information received from the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland, effective March 25, 1985, all ODGF institutions identified in Circular 85-35 of March 22, 1985, will begin receiving debit and credit electronic items through the ACH. This arrangement has been made by order of Robert McAlister, Superintendent of Savings and Loan Associations for the State of Ohio.

Also, the FRB of Cleveland has advised that the institutions in Ohio listed on the reverse side of this circular are open for the presentment of cash items.
