### SUBJECT

1987 fee schedules for financial services

#### DETAILS

The Federal Reserve Board has announced the 1987 fee schedules for services provided by the Reserve Banks. The attached schedules apply to the automated clearinghouse (ACH), wire transfer and net settlement, definitive securities safekeeping and noncash collection, and book-entry securities services for non-Treasury securities. Fee schedules relating to checks services were released in our Circular 86-96, dated November 20, 1986.

The new fee schedule for the ACH will go into effect April 1, 1987. Current prices will apply through the first quarter of 1987.

Price changes for wire transfer and net settlement will be effective January 1, 1987. The new electronic connection fees for RESPONSE network participants and institutions with data links are effective January 1, 1987 and are shown in the wire transfer fee schedule.

Fee schedules for definitive securities safekeeping, noncash collection and non-Treasury book-entry securities services are the same as those for 1986.

Effective April 1987, the following Automated Clearing House transactions will be billed as regular items: Corporate Trade Payments (CTP), Corporate Trade Exchange (CTX), Depository Institution Automated Returns (RET), Depository Institution Automated Notification of Changes (COR), and Prenotifications.

Night cycle processing surcharges are currently 6.0¢ for debit transactions and 3.0¢ for next day credits. These fees may be lowered at a later date to reflect float recovery through some other means, e.g., a float factor.
