The Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council (FFIEC) has announced that the December 1987 UBPR is ready for distribution and sale to the public. The use of quarterly UBPR permits both summary and in-depth analysis of a commercial bank's financial performance and trends.

The December 1987 Uniform Bank Performance Report (UBPR) is now being distributed to all insured commercial banks and is available for sale to the public.

The December edition is identical in format to the September 1987 edition.

The quarterly UBPR is designed for use by bank examiners, financial analysts and bank managers, and permits both summary and in-depth analysis of a commercial bank's financial performance and trends.

Users of the UBPR are also advised that the March, 1988 edition, to be available in early July, 1988, will incorporate substantial changes. The report will be more compact by one-third, compared to present editions, through the restating or elimination of certain pages and sections. The March, 1988 edition will also include new items for home equity loans and deferred agricultural loan losses, and a revised presentation of the distribution of maturity and repricing opportunities. In addition, the criterion used to determine a bank's metropolitan/non-metropolitan location for peer grouping purposes will be changed to the "Metropolitan Statistical Area" (MSA) code defined by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget.

The March, 1988 version of the UBPR will be documented in a complete new text for the UBPR User's Guide. This new text will be available with the March, 1988 UBPR.

In addition, beginning with the March, 1988 edition, the FFIEC will make available computer tapes of UBPR data, including bank ratios and percentile ranks, and peer group and state averages. The tapes will contain bulk data for all banks, peer groups or states, and are expected to be of interest to requestors who make use of large-scale bank data such as quarterly Call Report tapes. These tapes, to be available in July, 1988, will be further described by a separate announcement.

All copies of individual bank UBPR's may be obtained by the public for \$30 per report. UBPR User's Guides may be obtained for \$15 each. December 1987 and prior State Average Reports are available for \$30 per copy, and Peer Group Reports are \$50 per copy.
