DETAILS

This Bank and its Branches at El Paso, Houston and San Antonio, Texas, will observe the following holidays in 1995 and will not be open on the dates indicated below:

January 2, New Year's Day
January 16, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
February 20, Presidents Day
May 29, Memorial Day
July 4, Independence Day
September 4, Labor Day
October 9, Columbus Day
November 23, Thanksgiving Day
December 25, Christmas Day

The Federal Reserve standard holiday schedule mandates that if January 1, July 4, November 11, or December 25 falls on a Sunday, the following Monday will be observed as a holiday. If January 1, July 4, November 11, or December 25 occurs on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will not be observed as a holiday. Because November 11, 1995, falls on a Saturday, Friday, November 10, 1995, will not be observed as a holiday.
