#### **SUBJECT**

1995 Fee Schedules for Services and the 1995 Private Sector Adjustment Factor (PSAF)

#### **DETAILS**

The Board of Governors has announced the 1995 fee schedules for services provided by the Reserve Banks. The fee schedules apply to automated clearinghouse (ACH), transfer of funds and net settlement, noncash collection (through the Jackson-ville Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta), book-entry securities, electronic connections to the Federal Reserve, and check collection and electronic check services.

The Board has approved only one change to the current ACH fees for 1995—an increase in the fee for processing government paper NOCs from \$5.00 to \$10.00, the current fee for commercial paper NOCs. The funds transfer fee has been reduced from \$0.53 to \$0.50. The current fees for the book-entry security service has been retained. In light of the increasing costs due to the implementation of Fednet®, the Board has approved increased fees for three types of electronic connections in 1995. In addition, the Board has approved two new standard connection options to support contingency testing by depository institutions that use dedicated leased-line connections for their production traffic. Return item fees for noncash collection were reduced from \$25.00 to \$15.00. Fees in some service areas of check collection and electronic check services have changed as indicated on the new schedule. New services for check collection and electronic check services are shaded, and old fees and old deadlines are included for reference.

The fees for 1995 are based on total costs for priced services, including float, the Private Sector Adjustment Factor (PSAF), and a portion of special project costs. The fee schedules become effective January 3, 1995.

In addition, the Board approved the 1995 PSAF for the priced services of Reserve Banks. The PSAF for 1995 will be \$94.7 million, a decrease of \$8.9 million or 8.6 percent from the \$103.6 million targeted for 1994. The PSAF is an allowance for the taxes that would have been paid and the return on capital that would have been provided had the Federal Reserve's priced services been provided by a private business firm.

#### **ATTACHMENTS**

#### **Return Items and NOCs**

Deposited electronically in files with or without other items, returns and NOCs are assessed the same basic fees and surcharges as are applied to debits and credits. Returns deposited electronically in files are also assessed a \$0.04 per item surcharge for processing in all exchanges.

Created and deposited via CATIE or dedicated terminal access to the ACH history database, returns are assessed a flat per-item fee of \$2.00. No other basic fees or surcharges apply.

Deposited in paper form, each return item and NOC is assessed a \$10.00 handling fee in addition to all fees that would apply if the item were deposited electronically. In addition, the Treasury Department has asked the Federal Reserve to charge depositors of paper government NOCs a \$10.00 per-item fee to partially defray the cost of and provide financial institutions an incentive for converting these items to electronic form.

# **Return Items and NOCs (continued)**

ACH participants are assessed a monthly accounting service fee of \$20.00 for each routing number listed on the Federal Reserve's Customer Information File (CIF).

An optional service for correspondents and processors, by which files are sorted by institution before delivery, will be assessed a file fee of \$10.00 per month for each file sorted.
