**A Guide to Business Credit for
Women, Minorities, and Small Businesses;
Consumer Handbook to Credit Protection Laws**

DETAILS

The Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System has announced the reissue of a brochure titled *A Guide to Business Credit for Women, Minorities, and Small Businesses*. The brochure explains the application process for small business loans and steps to take if a loan is denied. It also provides information on the Equal Credit Opportunity Act and lists sources for assistance in the application process.

Also, the Board has announced the revision of its brochure titled *Consumer Handbook to Credit Protection Laws*. The new edition, the thirteenth, reflects changes in law and regulation. Topics covered in the handbook include the following:

- The cost of credit;
- Applying for credit;
- Credit histories and records;
- Correcting mistakes and resolving misunderstandings;
- Cancelling a mortgage;
- Liability limits on lost or stolen credit cards; and
- Electronic fund transfers.

The handbook also includes a directory of federal agencies and information on how to file a credit complaint.
