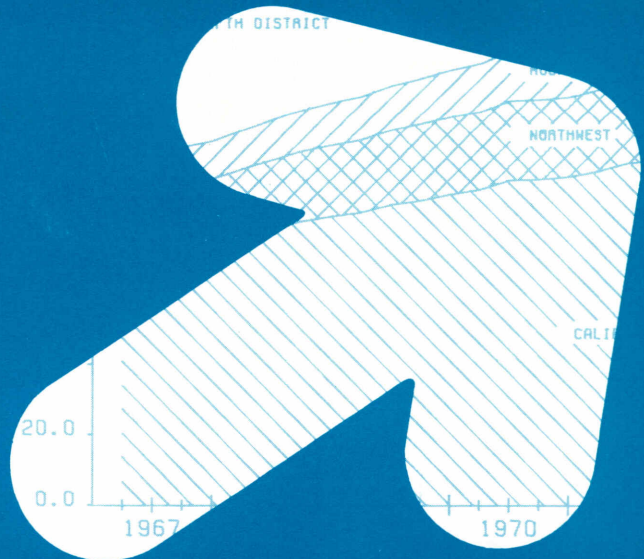

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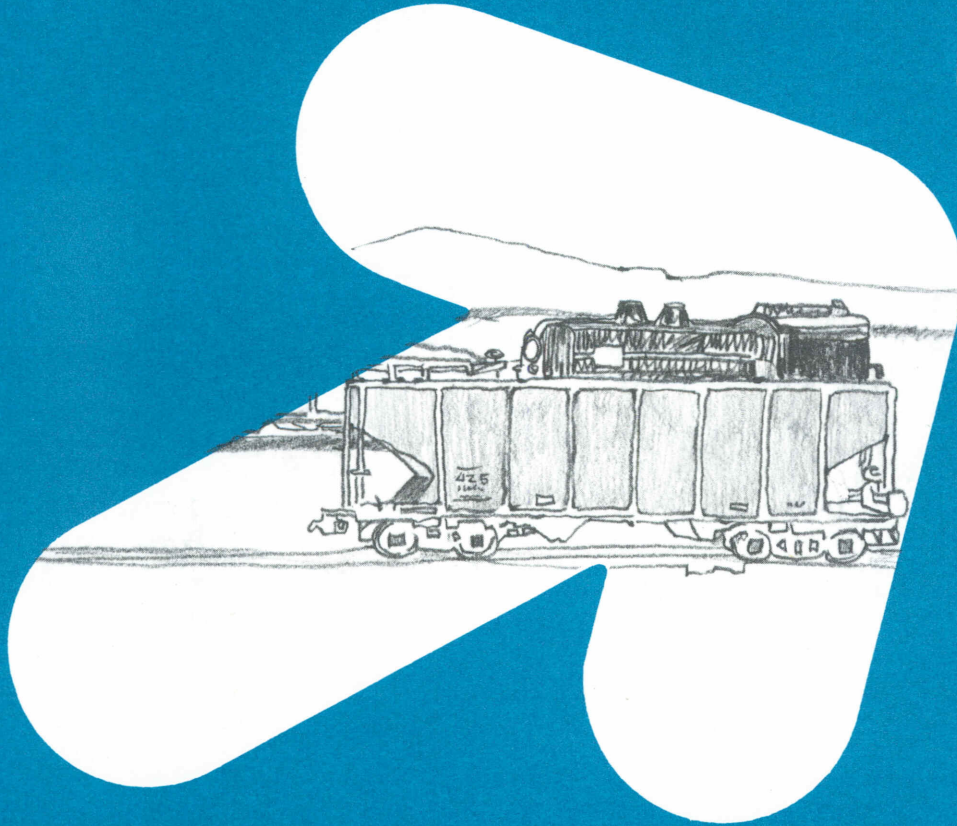
## Highlights of this Issue

- Nonfarm employment continued to advance in March, and apparently in April as well. However, the gains were somewhat smaller than during the employment upsurge of last fall and early winter (B-2, B-8). The regional unemployment rate edged upward during March, from 5.3 to 5.5 percent, but apparently declined again in April. The rate continued to average about one-half percentage point above the national figure (B-6).
- Commercial-bank loans again advanced at a phenomenal pace during April, despite a slowdown in business-loan growth. The loan increase for the first four months of 1973 was greater than for any full-year period except 1972. Banks recorded a modest increase in Treasury security holdings, but offset this (for the second straight month) with a decline in other securities. Time deposits, especially large CD's, continued to rise at a rapid pace (E-2). Consumer instalment credit increased during the first quarter, at a faster pace than in the comparable year-ago period. The auto boom continued to spark the upsurge in credit buying (E-20).
- Municipal-bond sales increased in March, but still ran somewhat below the January pace. Washington state agencies and California local governments were the heaviest borrowers during the month (F-7, F-8). Municipal-bond yields reached the highest levels since mid-1972 (F-4).
- Construction-contract awards turned upward in March, as activity increased substantially in residential and other types of construction. Residential permit activity also rose, but new housing starts continued to decline, as they had consistently since last fall (D-2, D-6). Effective rates on new-home loans generally increased during April (D-4).
- Retail sales continued their strong upsurge during February, as a strong auto-sales pace was supplemented by a sharp gain in nondurable-goods purchases (A-12).

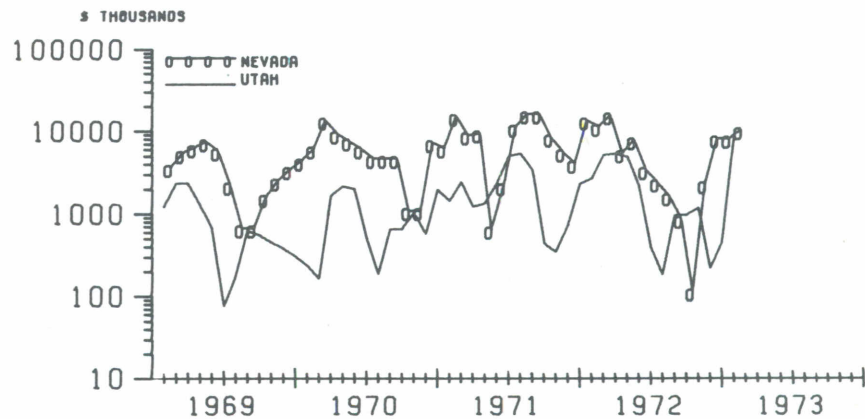
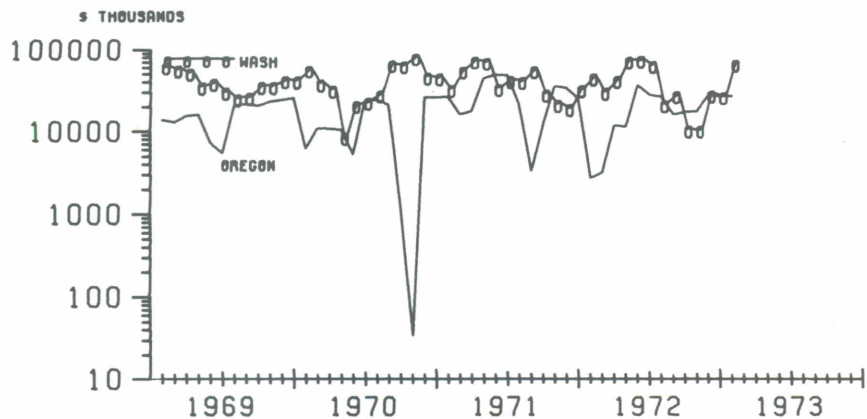
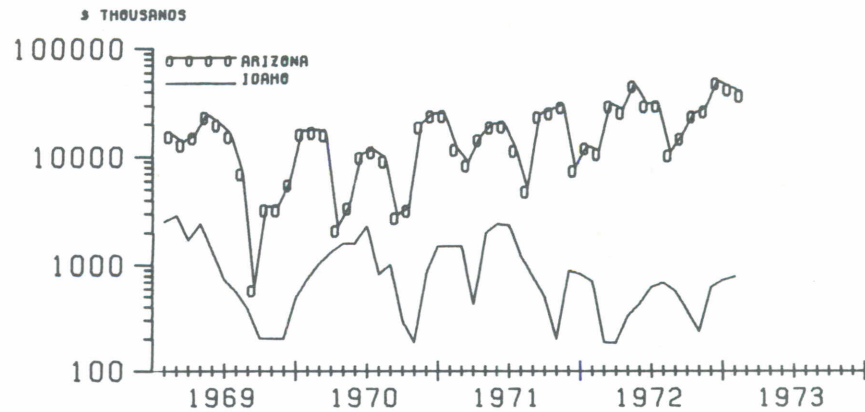
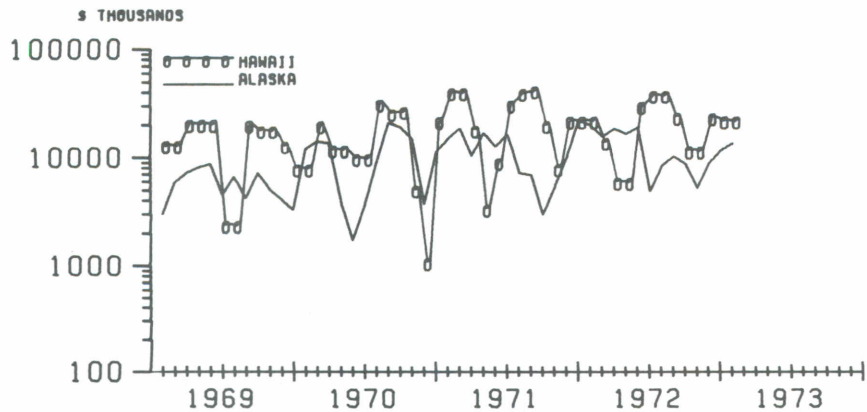
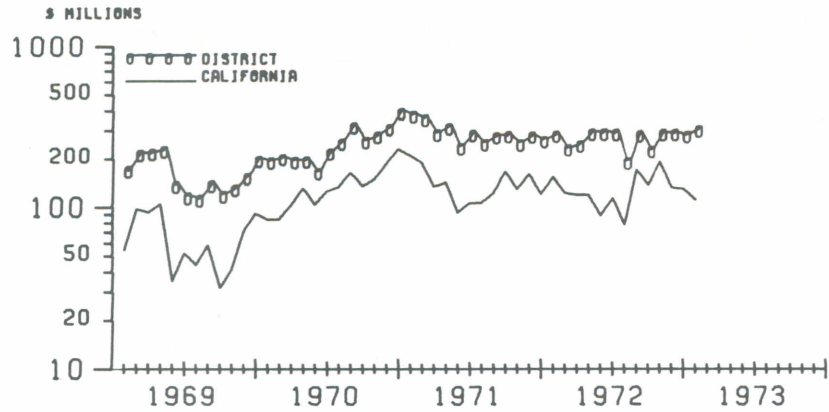
# TWELFTH DISTRICT MUNICIPAL BOND SALES
