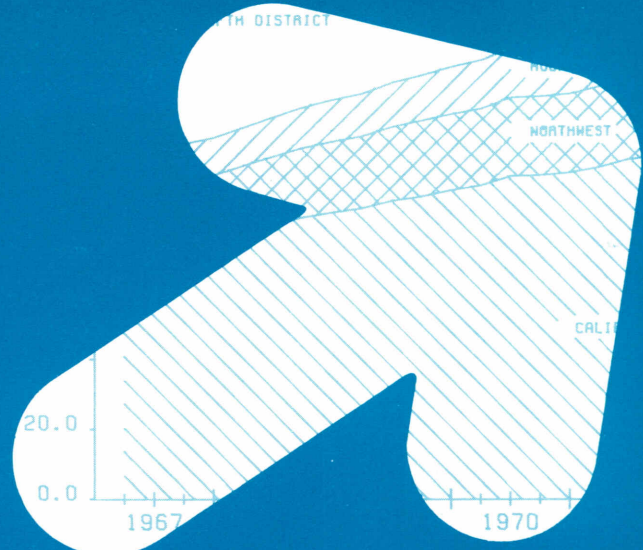

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## Highlights of this Issue

- Regional employment edged upward to 13.18 million in July, and apparently held close to that figure during August. Employment essentially has remained on a high plateau since May; construction and government jobs have declined, but most other industries have continued to post gains (B-2, B-8). The regional jobless rate rose slightly to 5.5 percent in July, and probably changed very little during August (B-6).
- Commercial-bank credit expanded rapidly in August, at about a 9-percent annual rate. Banks added substantially to their business loans and real estate loans, especially the latter; meanwhile, they continued to sell off Treasury securities while adding to their holdings of other securities. Banks supported this credit expansion with a very substantial increase in time deposits, especially large certificates of deposit (E-2, E-10).
- Municipal-bond sales were quite small during July, and were marked only by a moderate amount of placements by California local governments (F-7, F-8). Bond yields rose substantially, with the yield on rated general obligations going from 5.35 percent in June to 5.52 percent in July (F-4).
- Contract awards for nonresidential and heavy construction dropped from earlier near-record levels in July, while residential awards held near the June level. However, the number of housing starts and residential permits continued to decline, as they had been doing for most of the past year (D-2, D-6).
- Retail sales remained very strong in June, reflecting to some extent the much higher prices paid for food. Durable-goods sales declined somewhat from their early-spring peak (A-12).

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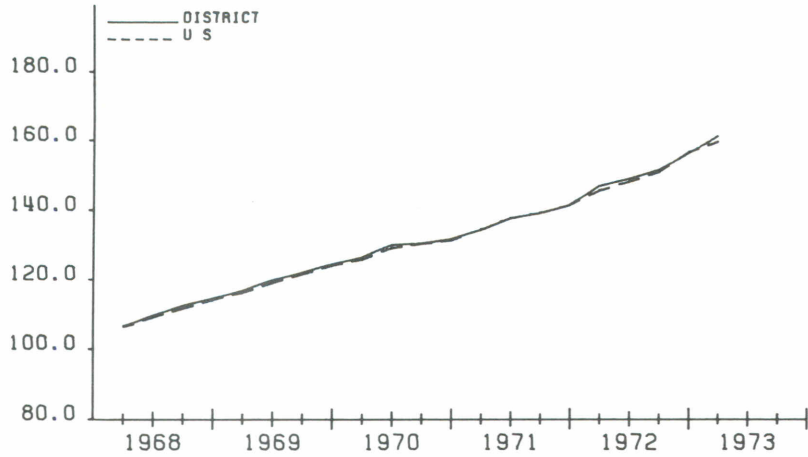

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED ANNUAL RATE

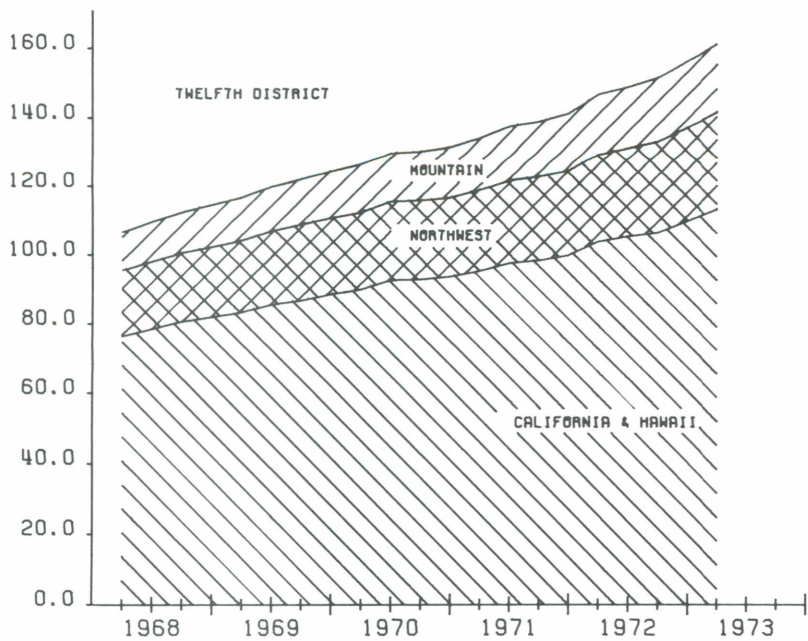

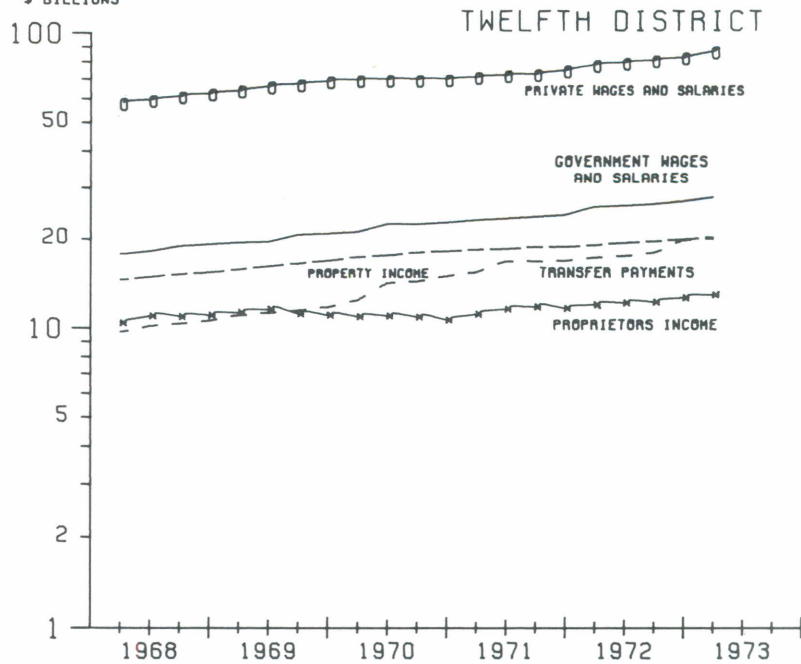


# PERSONAL INCOME

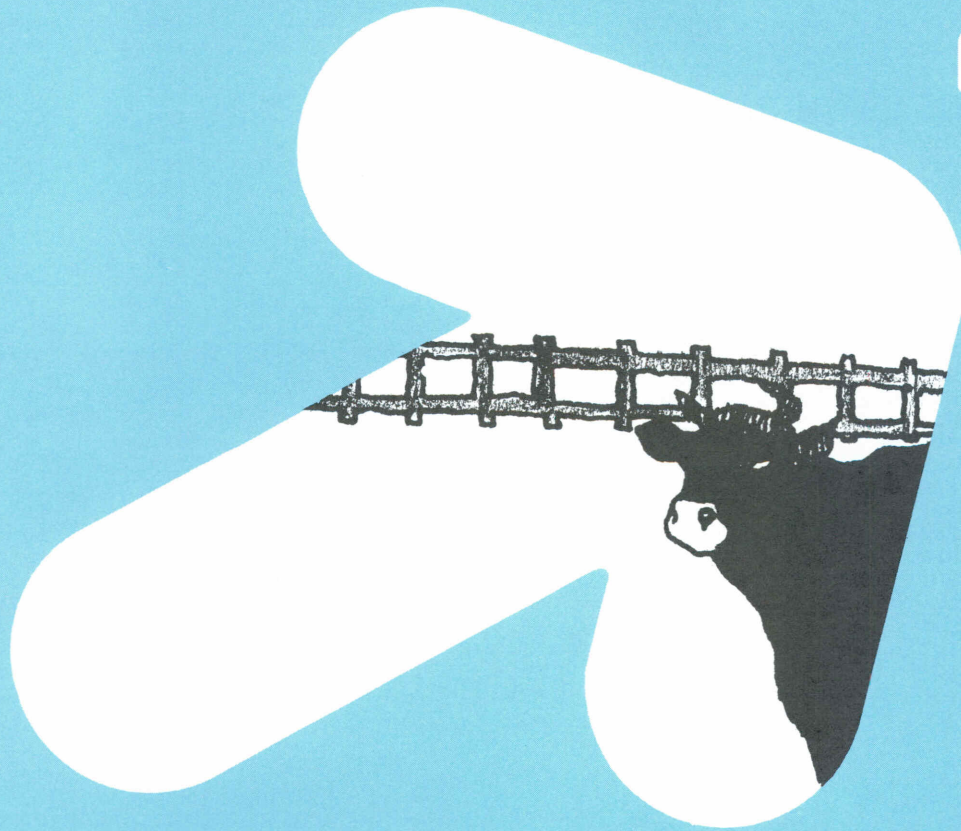

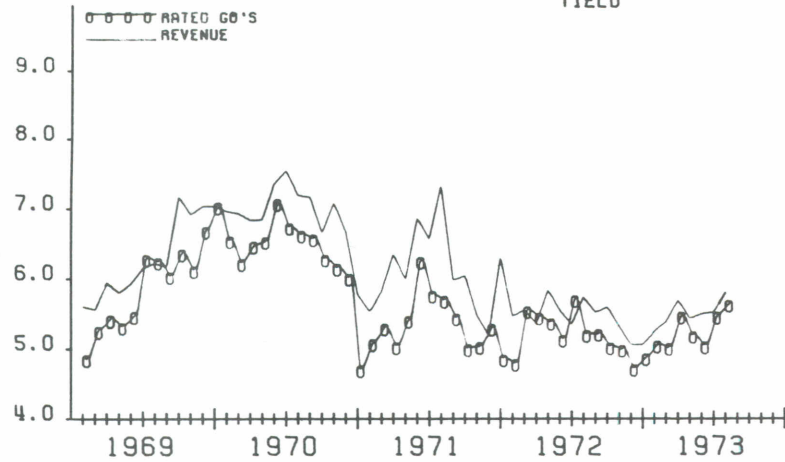
