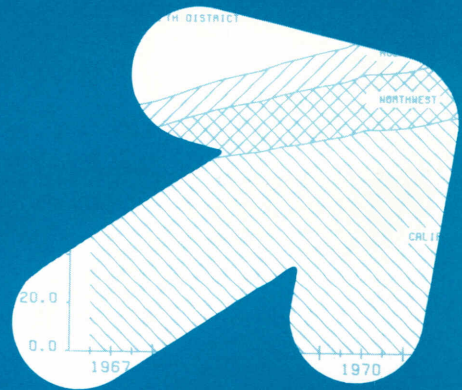

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Employment and Earnings—Revised Series

Employment and unemployment estimates have been revised for most states in accordance with methodology prescribed by the U.S. Department of Labor. The new procedures affect only total labor force, civilian employment, unemployment and unemployment rates. Nonfarm payroll employment is unaffected. All California figures have been revised on the basis of the new methodology. Data prior to December 1973 for Washington, Arizona, Utah, Nevada, Hawaii and Alaska are calculated by the former procedures and hence are not comparable with later figures. All data for Oregon and Idaho reflect the old methodology.

Industrial Production—New Series

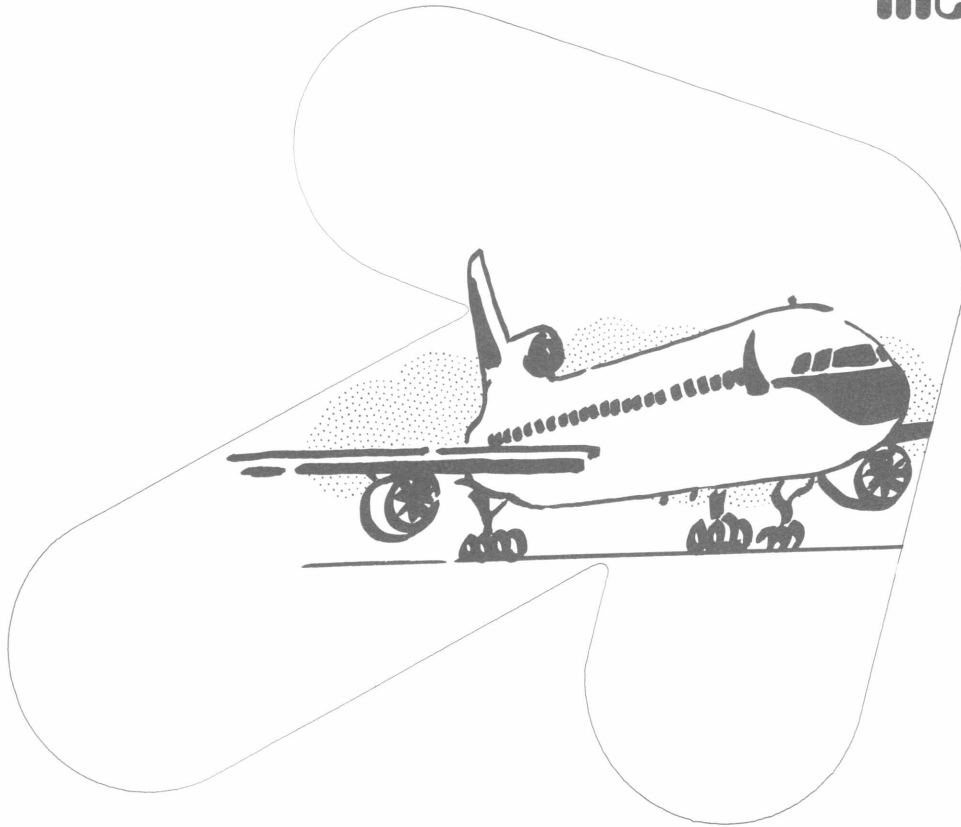
A new series has been added to the Production section of this issue: District Industrial Production Indexes—Manufacturing. Data compiled by the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco are now available monthly beginning January 1963. A technical paper describing the construction of the indexes is available on request to the Research Information Center, Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco, P.O. Box 7702, San Francisco, California 94120.

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Highlights of this Issue

- Western manufacturing production recovered partway from its steep January decline during February, but still lagged about 4 percent behind its November peak. Durable and nondurable goods production both advanced during the month. . . . Basic materials-producing industries generally strengthened during February. Petroleum and primary metals both rose sharply to new peaks, and paper production remained close to its earlier peak. Production increased in machinery (electrical and nonelectrical) and transportation equipment, but activity in these sectors remained well below the record levels reached last summer and fall (C4-C6).
- Employment continued rising in February, and judging from California data, evidently increased in March as well. Most industries posted employment gains during the month, except for construction and aerospace manufacturing (B2, B8). . . . The regional unemployment rate continued to hover around the 7-percent level during February, and it may have advanced again in March, since California's jobless rate rose from 7.2 percent to 7.4 percent in that month (B6).
- Bank credit rose sharply in March, largely because of a strong upsurge in business loans at California banks. In addition, banks added significantly to their holdings of Federal agency and other securities, although they reduced their Treasury security portfolios in the process. Bank deposits rose during the month, but the increase in time-and-savings deposits lagged considerably below the the pace of other recent months (E2, E4).
- Municipal-bond financing was rather sluggish in February, although some interest was generated by new offerings on the part of California, Arizona and Alaska local governments (F7, F8). Yields on rated general obligations slipped from 5.30 percent to 5.19 percent during the month (F4).
- The Western customs region recorded a 60-percent rise in exports and a 30-percent rise in imports in 1973, according to final figures for the year. Exports soared in every category, although the strongest increases were in crude materials and agricultural products. (Farm exports more than doubled during the year.) Imports of every type also advanced, with machinery and transportation equipment showing the largest increase (A8, A10).

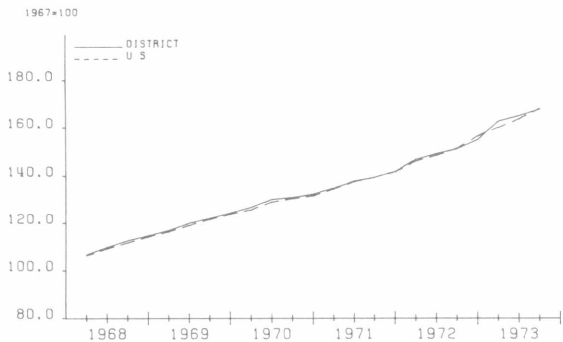

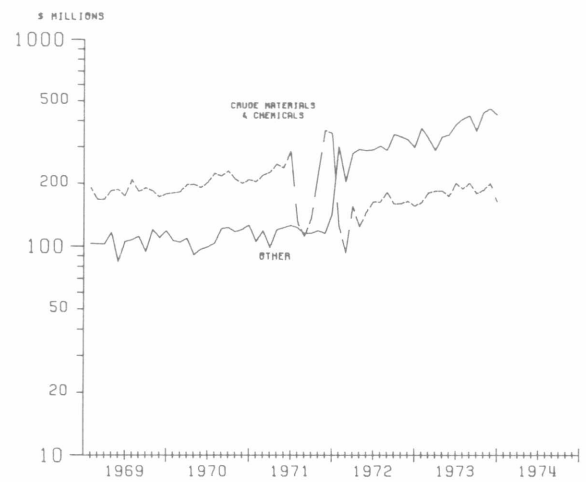
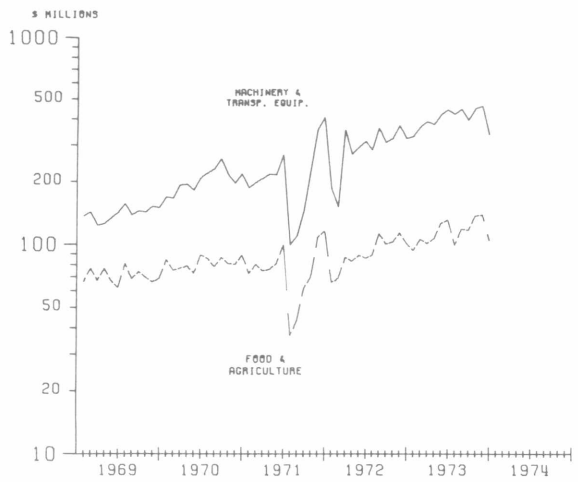
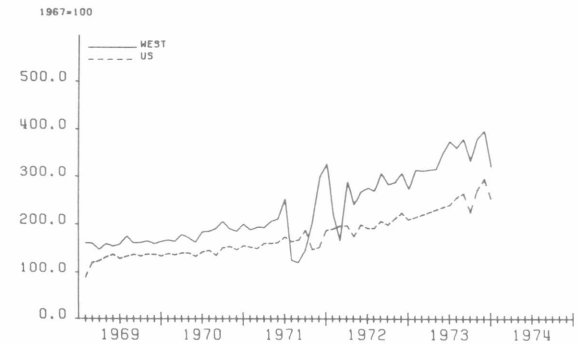
FOREIGN TRADE EXPORTS

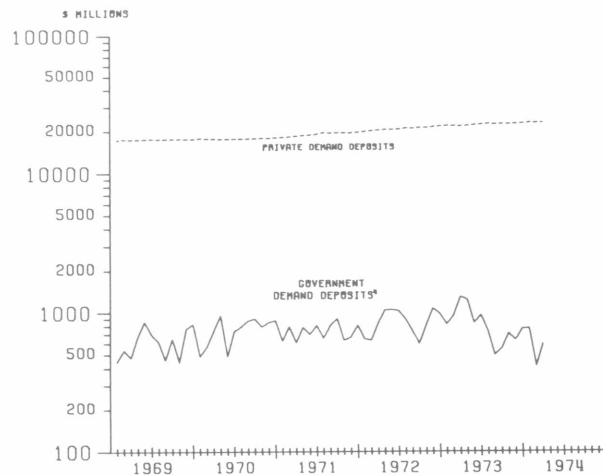
