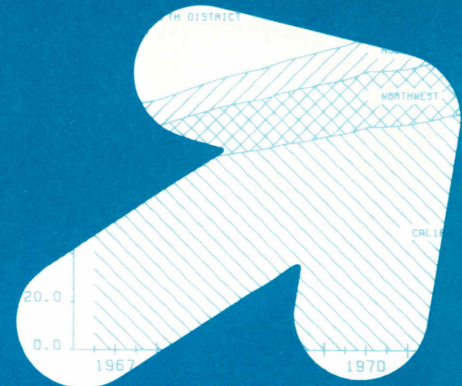

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Employment and Earnings—Revised Series

Employment and unemployment estimates have been revised for most states in accordance with methodology prescribed by the U.S. Department of Labor. The new procedures affect only total labor force, civilian employment, unemployment and unemployment rates. Nonfarm payroll employment is unaffected. All California and Oregon figures have been revised on the basis of the new methodology. Data prior to December 1973 for Utah, Nevada, Hawaii and Alaska are calculated by the former procedures and hence are not comparable with later figures. All data for Idaho reflect the old methodology.

Series on *Borrowings and Reserves of Member Banks* in the Twelfth Federal Reserve District have been added to the banking section. Daily average data for calendar months are available from January 1973 forward. Earlier data (quarterly and annually) are based on daily averages for reserve statement weeks.

Series on *Federal Funds and Related Transactions* of the seven Twelfth District banks included in the national Federal Funds sample also have been added to the banking section. For these series daily average data for calendar months are available from January 1968 forward.

These data series have been compiled by the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco.

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Highlights of this Issue

- Western manufacturing production in June rose to its highest point for the year, on the strength of good gains in the durable goods sector. Nonetheless, factory activity still lagged behind the 1973 pace. . . . Major industries showing increases in June were primary metal products, machinery (both electrical and non-electrical), transportation equipment and paper products (C-4, 5, 6).
- Employment declined slightly from the May peak during June, with losses fairly even in all sectors and all states. The construction industry showed a notable drop to the lowest level of the past 14 months (B-2, 8). . . . Unemployment held at 7.4 percent in the region for the third straight month, but California's July rate of 7.8 percent—an increase of three-tenths of a percent from June—may indicate an upward movement for the West as a whole (B-6).
- Bank credit increased sharply in July, especially in California, on the basis of strong demand for business and real estate loans. Banks added U.S. Treasury securities to their portfolios, but sold off holdings of other securities. The time-deposit upsurge continued in California but fell off elsewhere (E-4, 6). . . . The money situation tightened further as member-bank borrowings rose to a new peak (\$272 million daily average) at the Federal Reserve Bank. In addition, Fed-funds purchases (borrowings) of large banks remained at unprecedentedly high levels (E-2, 3).
- Local governments—Washington agencies in particular—were active in the municipal bond market during June with offerings reaching a near-record \$335 million. State governments, in contrast, were relatively inactive (F-7, 8). . . . Sharply rising interest rates on rated general obligations (6.20 percent) and revenue bonds (7.30 percent) were coupled with the high volume of activity (F-4).
- Construction contract activity (both residential and non-residential) rose strongly in the West in June, in contrast to a slowdown in the rest of the nation (D-2). . . . The number of housing permits issued in the West, however, showed a drop as interest rates for new homes continued to soar. The effective rate for new home loans in San Francisco neared 9 percent while in Seattle the rate topped that mark (D-4, 8).

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED ANNUAL RATE

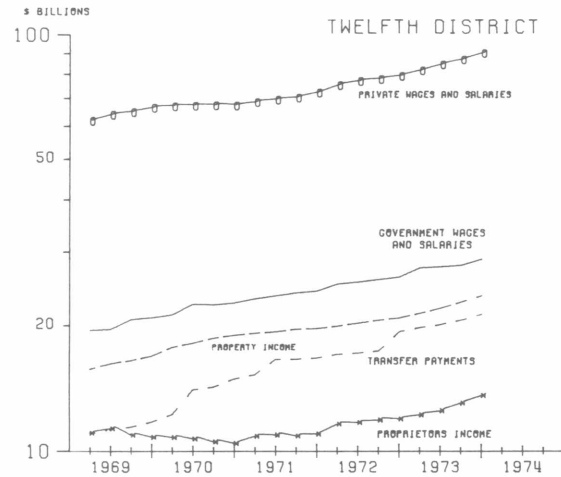
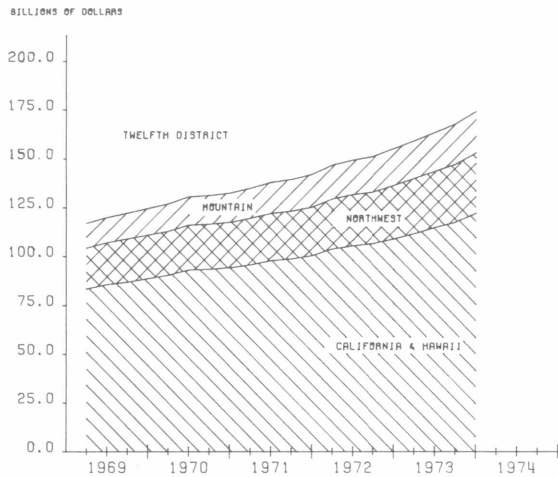
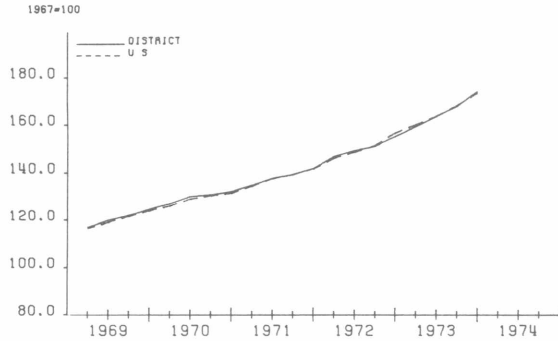

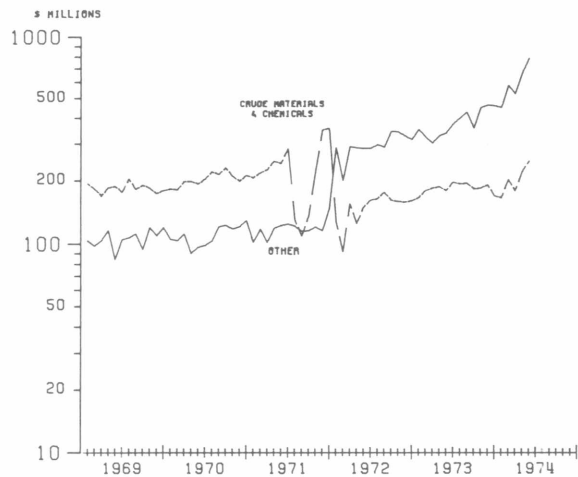
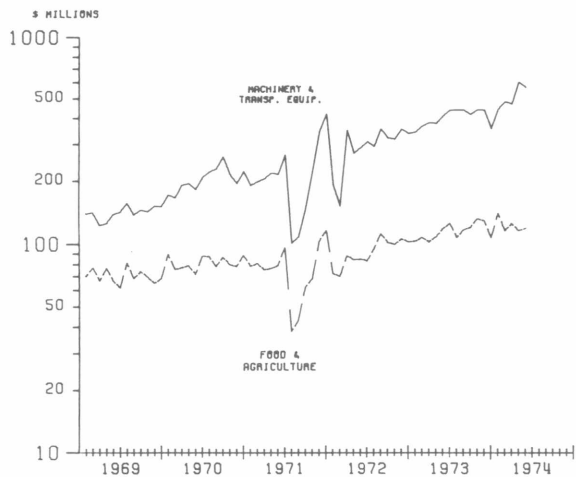
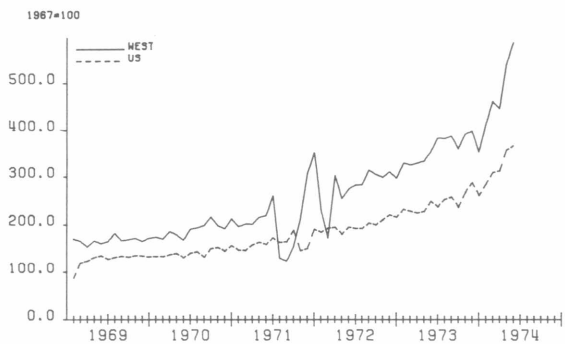


FOREIGN TRADE EXPORTS



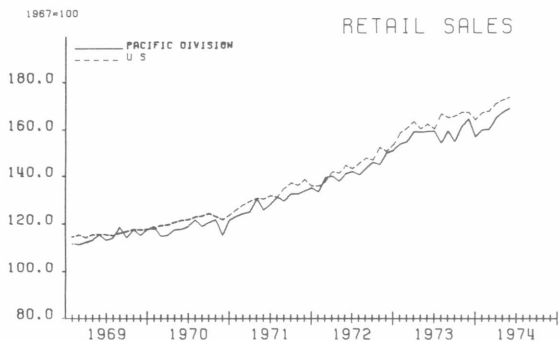

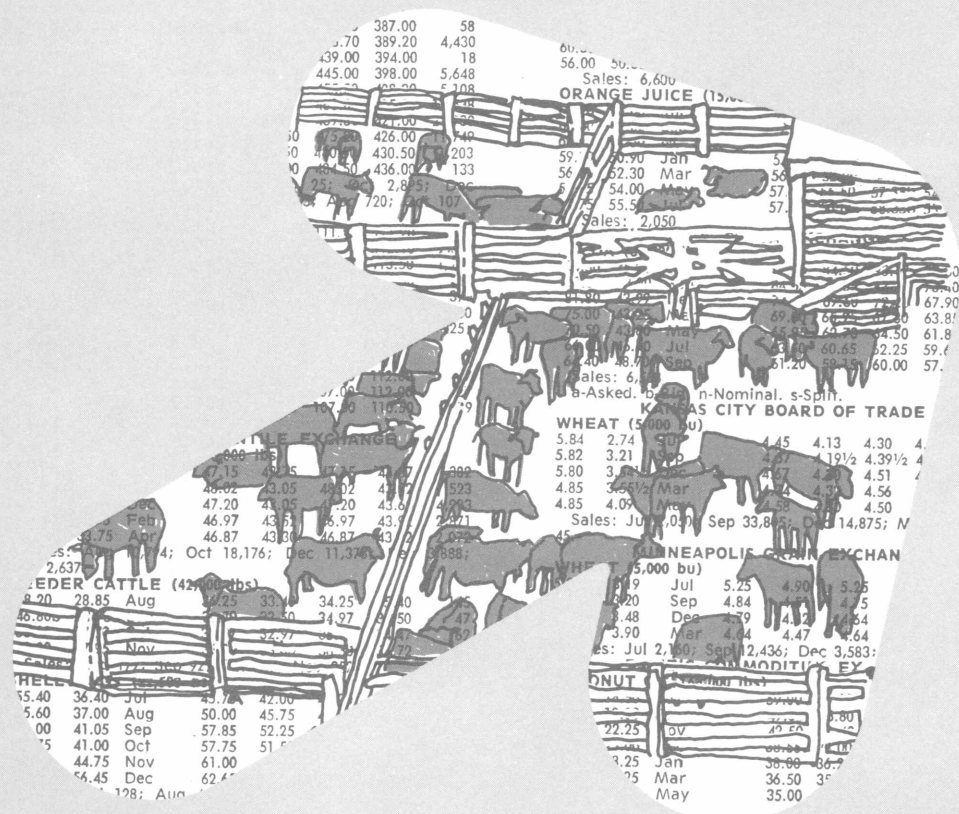

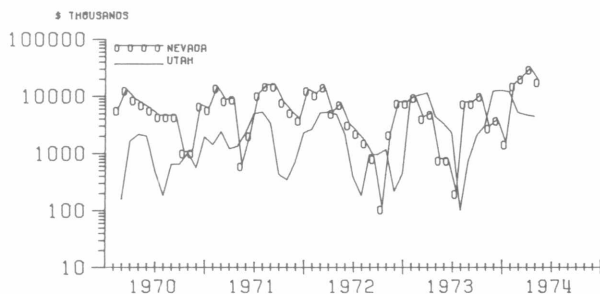
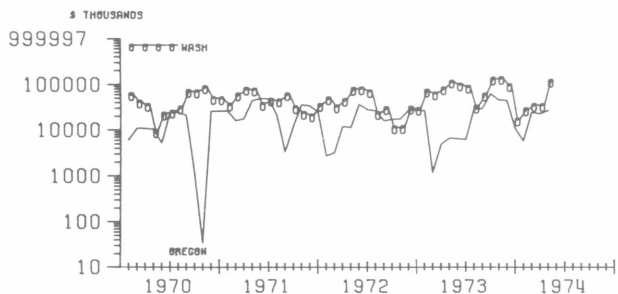
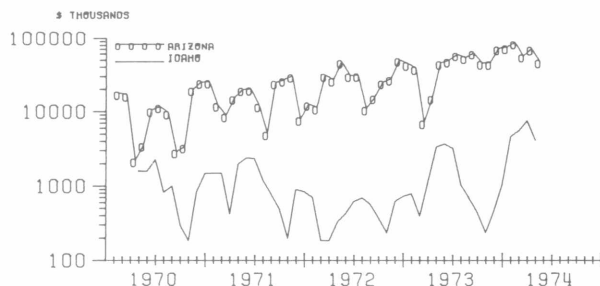
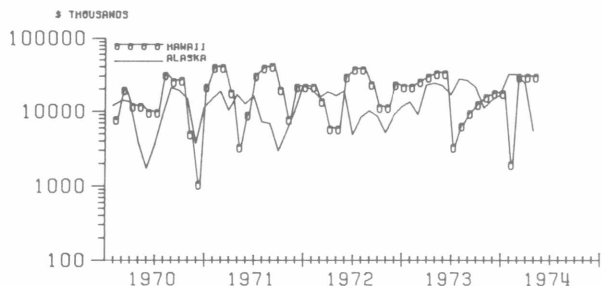
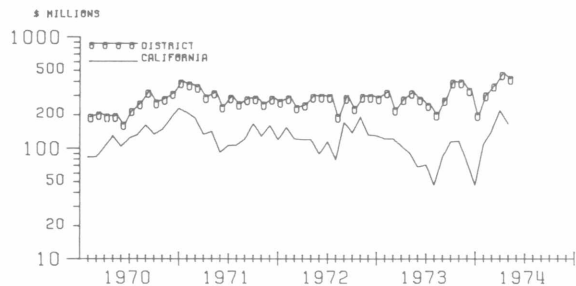
TWELFTH DISTRICT MUNICIPAL BOND SALES
