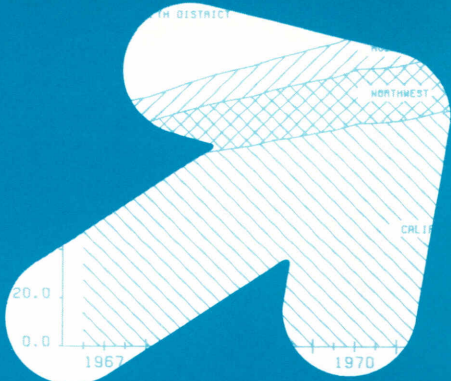

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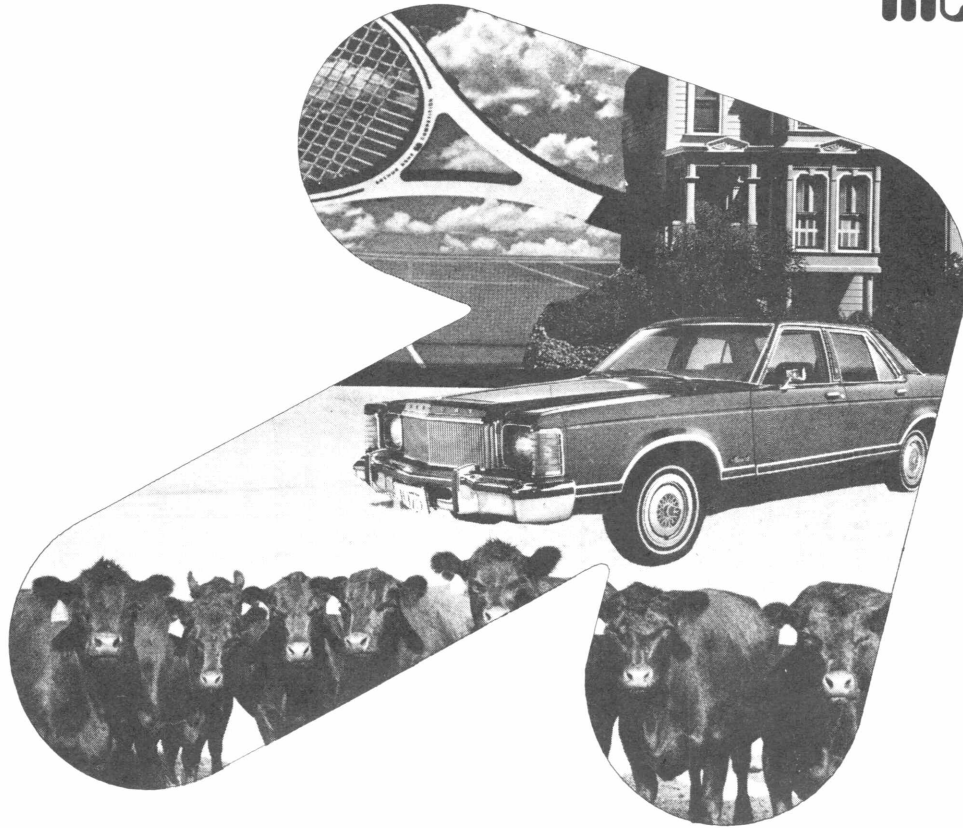

## Highlights of this Issue

- Region-wide employment declined slightly during January, and February figures for California indicate that the trend may be continuing. The only sectors showing employment gains in January were trade and government (B-2, 8). . . . The unemployment rate continued to rise in both the West and the nation in January, with only Alaska and Hawaii resisting the trend. In February California's jobless rate rose further to 9.4 percent (B-6).
- The demand for loans dropped off in both California and the District in February, as a slight increase in real-estate loans failed to offset a decline in business loans. Banks added to their holdings of U.S. Treasury securities while selling off other securities (E-4, 6). . . . As another sign of ease, large member banks dramatically reduced their borrowings at the Federal Reserve discount window in February to only \$13 million on a daily average basis—the lowest point since mid-1972 and a contrast with the near \$300-million borrowings of last August. Net purchases (borrowings) of Fed funds by large District banks decreased in February (E-2, 3).
- Throughout the District, state and local governments alike increased their municipal-bond sales in January. Alaska, California, Utah and Washington state governments issued bonds totaling \$192 thousand. Local governments in every state but Hawaii entered the bond market for a District-wide total of \$228 thousand (F-7, 8). . . . New-issue yields on all categories of bonds dropped markedly in January (F-4).
- Defense prime-contract awards rose to a new high of \$10.2 billion in 1974—an increase of more than 23 percent over 1973. Space-agency awards to Western contractors meanwhile zoomed to their highest level since 1968—\$1.2 billion—an increase of 68 percent over the year before. The West's share of total aerospace-industry awards rose from 28 percent in 1973 to 30 percent in 1974 (C-9, 10).
