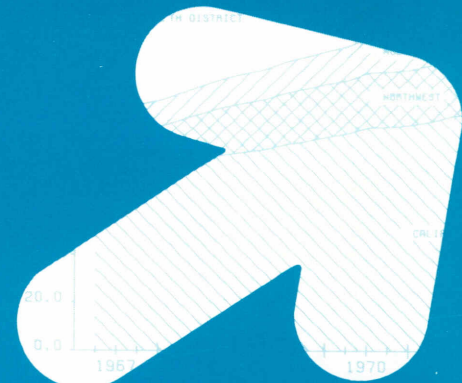

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NEW STATISTICAL PUBLICATION

The Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco will begin publication of *Pacific Basin Economic Indicators* on a quarterly basis in 1975. This periodical will be a compendium of statistics giving annual rate of change data for 13 Pacific Basin countries on gross national product, money supply, international reserves, consumer prices, wholesale prices, manufacturing employment, industrial production, imports and exports. The countries included in the survey are Australia, Canada, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, New Zealand, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and the United States.

Highlights of this Issue

- Manufacturing production in the West continued to strengthen in November in both durable and nondurable goods categories. Sectors showing notable increases were apparel, furniture, rubber and plastic products, fabricated metals and electrical machinery (C-4, 5, 6).
- Employment gains were registered in November in all District states except Alaska and California—and California recouped its losses in December. Employment increased primarily in construction, trade and services (B-2, 8) These employment gains were apparently sufficient to offset new entrants coming into the labor market, as the unemployment rate held steady for the District between October and November, and declined significantly in California in December (B-6).
- The demand for real estate loans continued to grow at District banks in December but fewer business loans were made. Banks added substantially to their holdings of U.S. Treasury securities (E-4, 6) Member bank borrowings from the Fed dropped to only \$1 million on a daily average basis in November, then rose to \$10 million in December (daily average basis). Meanwhile, net Fed funds purchased (borrowed) by large District banks rose to \$1.9 billion (daily average) in December (E-2, 3).
- Municipal bond offerings by District states and localities rose to \$298 million in December but remained below the spring peak. California and Arizona local governments were active in the bond market, while Washington was the major state borrower (F-7, 8) Yields rose significantly in December on both rated general-obligation bonds and revenue bonds (F-4).
- The dollar value of construction contracts in the West dropped substantially between October and November. The declines occurred in all three categories—residential, non-residential and non-building. Data for housing starts and permits issued both showed a slowing of activity in homebuilding following several monthly increases (D-2, 4).

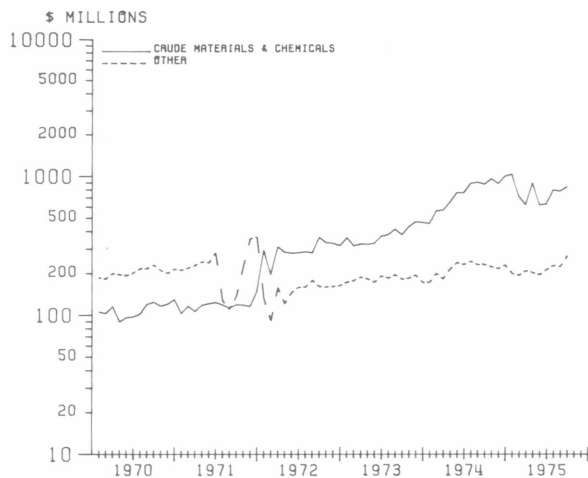
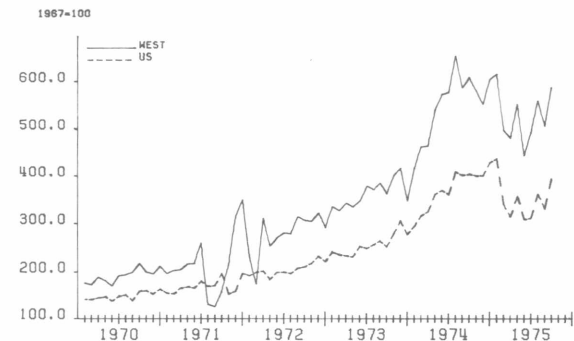
FOREIGN TRADE EXPORTS

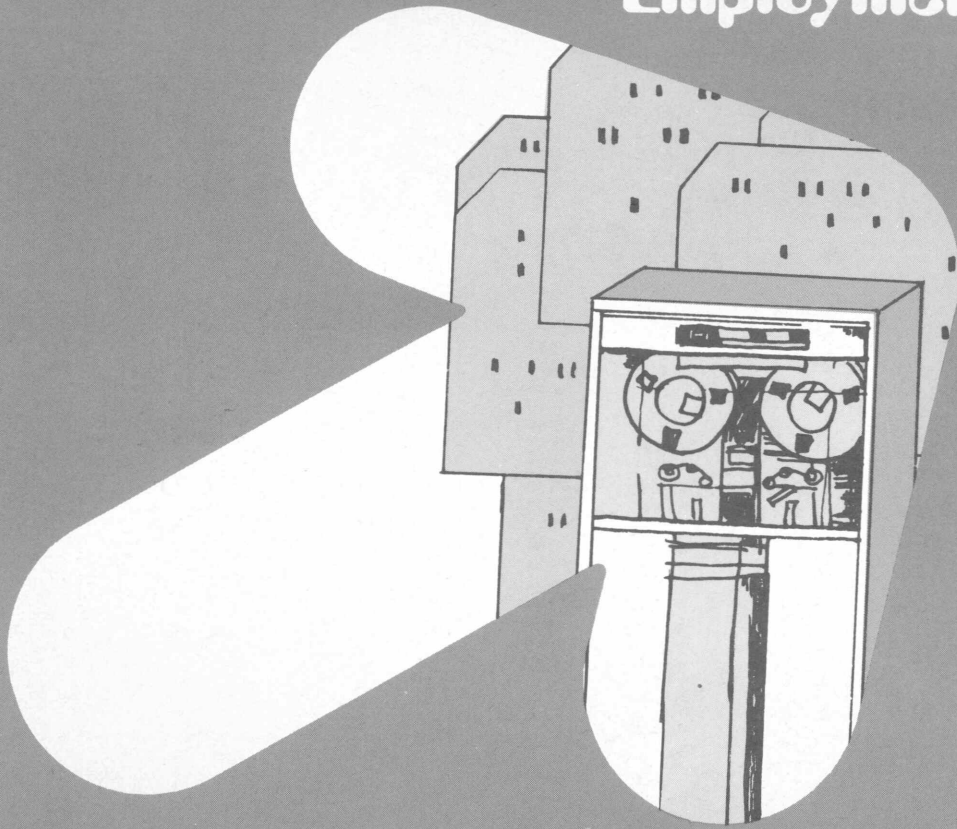

CALIFORNIA COMMERCIAL BANK CREDIT AND DEPOSITS¹



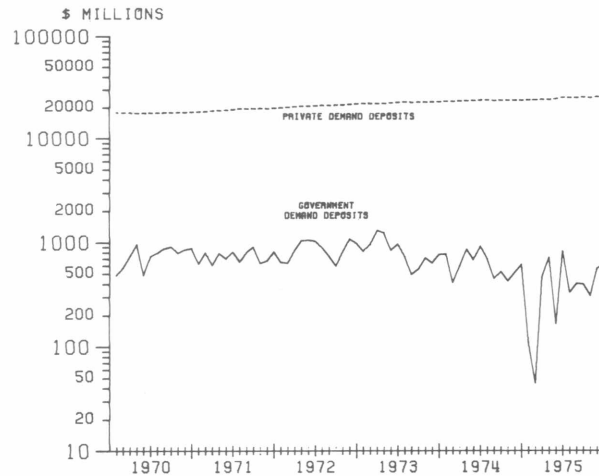
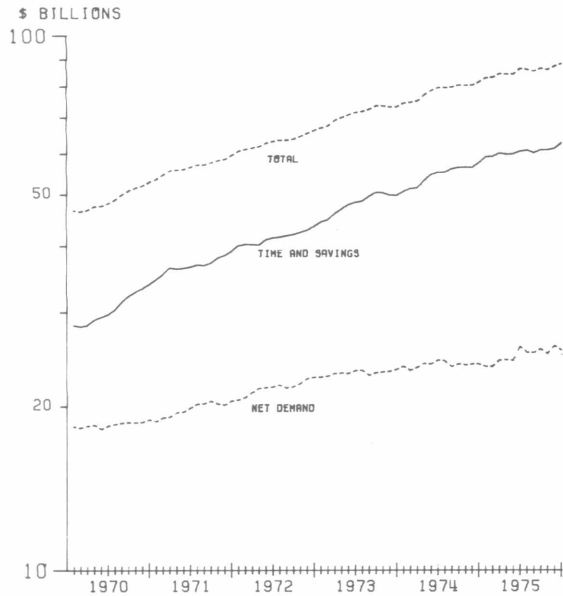

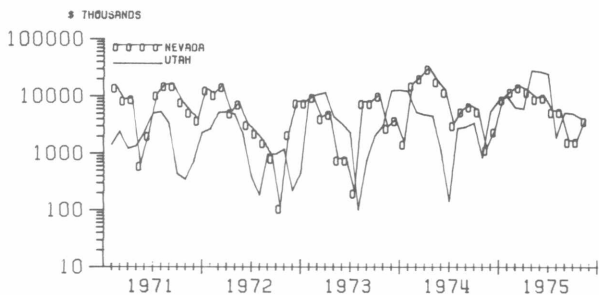
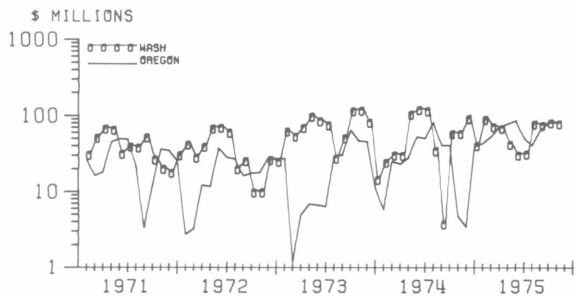
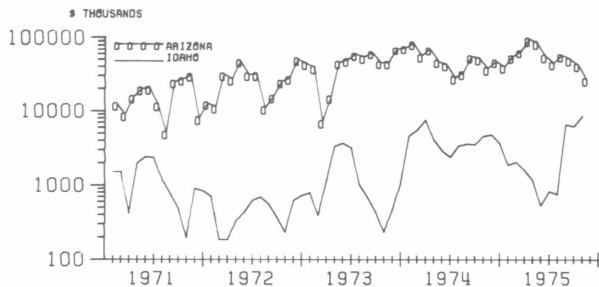
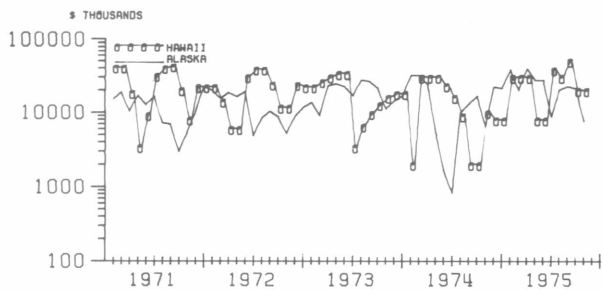
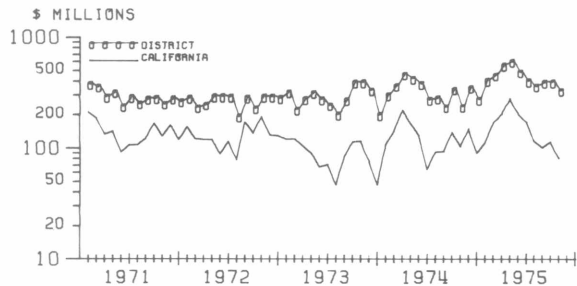
TWELFTH DISTRICT MUNICIPAL BOND SALES
