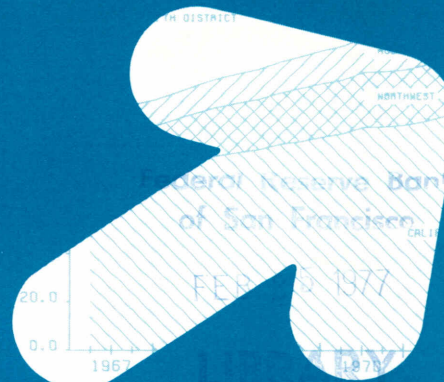

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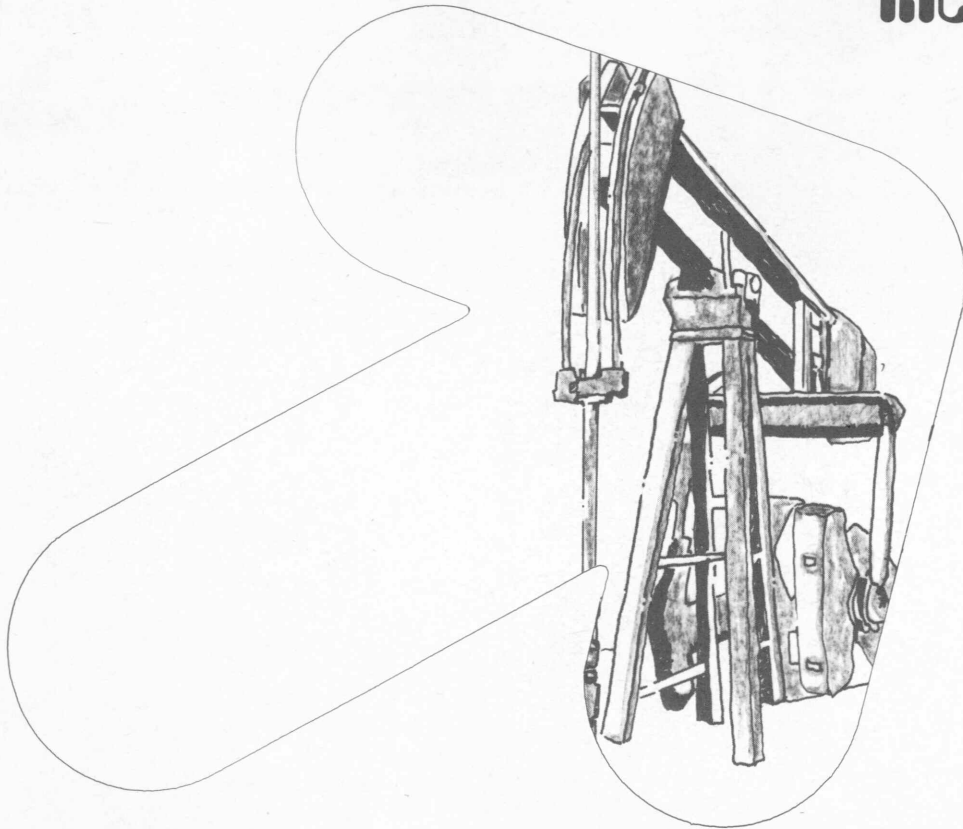
Highlights of this Issue

- Western manufacturing production posted strong gains in November as both durable and nondurable goods categories hit their highest production levels for the year. Nearly all sectors increased production with particular strength in food, textiles, lumber and wood products and transportation equipment (C-3, 4, 5).
- As 1976 ended, employment continued to expand steadily in California. Reflecting this growth, California's unemployment rate declined to 9.1 percent—its lowest point for the year but still more than a full percentage point higher than the national rate. In November all District states (except Alaska) improved their employment statistics. Most newly employed were finding jobs in the manufacturing, construction, trade or services fields (B-2, 4). . . . In November the unemployment rate for the District as a whole stood at 8.8 percent with areas of lowest unemployment in Arizona, Idaho and Utah (B-3).
- Demand for real-estate loans continued strong in the West during December, with the average for 1976 as a whole nearly 8 percent higher than for 1975. Business-loan demand, however, ended the year slightly down from a year ago. In December, banks added U.S. Treasury securities to their portfolios and decreased their holdings of other securities (E-4, 5, 6). . . . Member-bank borrowings from the Fed ended 1976 on the low level that has prevailed throughout the year—average daily borrowings in December were \$2 million, and for 1976 as a whole the daily average was \$5 million. Fed-funds transactions during the year also reflected ease, as net purchases (borrowings) in 1976 were less than one-third those of 1975 (daily average basis) (E-2, 3).
- Housing starts in the West (as in the U.S.) declined in November from October's very high level, but new housing permits increased to their highest point for the year (D-3). . . . The dollar volume of construction contracts increased substantially in November with strong gains in all categories—residential, non-residential and heavy (non-building) construction (D-2).

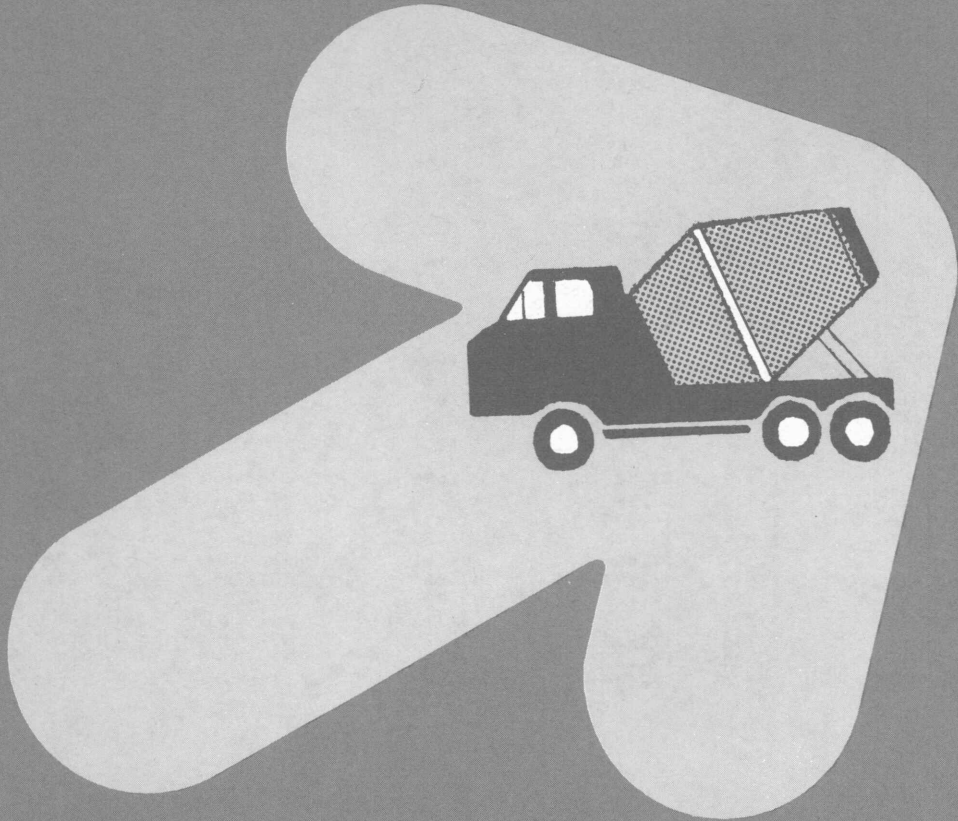
