Highlights of this Issue

- Western manufacturing production increased slightly in May on the basis of gains by nondurable-goods industries. Textiles, apparel, paper, chemicals and transportation equipment all showed strength, while decreased production was evident in lumber and wood products, fabricated metals and non-electrical machinery (C-3, 4, 5).
- Employment-growth trends continued strong in both California and the nation in June. In late-spring months, aerospace, trade, services and government all hired more workers in District states (B-2, 4). . . . An influx of jobseekers into the workforce caused unemployment to increase slightly in the nation during June, to 7.1 percent, while it declined substantially in California from 8.0 to 7.4 percent. June declines were also recorded in Arizona, Nevada and Oregon (B-3).
- The demand for both business and real-estate loans accelerated at Western banks in June. Mortgage-loan demand was concentrated at California banks, while all of the business-loan increase occurred outside California. In addition, District banks added both U.S. Treasury and other securities to their portfolios (E-4, 5). . . . Borrowings from the Fed increased slightly during June, to \$11 million on a daily average basis, but still remained very low in historical terms (E-2).
- Housing starts showed a small gain in the West in June, to 463,000 units at an annual rate. That figure was almost double the recession low, but was considerably below the peak reached last winter (D-3). . . . The dollar volume of construction contracts in the District moved upward in May, with all of the gain concentrated in residential building (D-2).

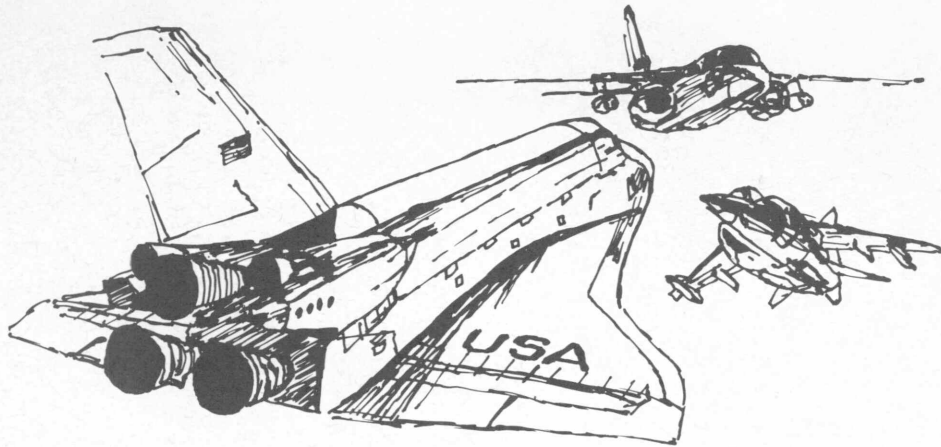

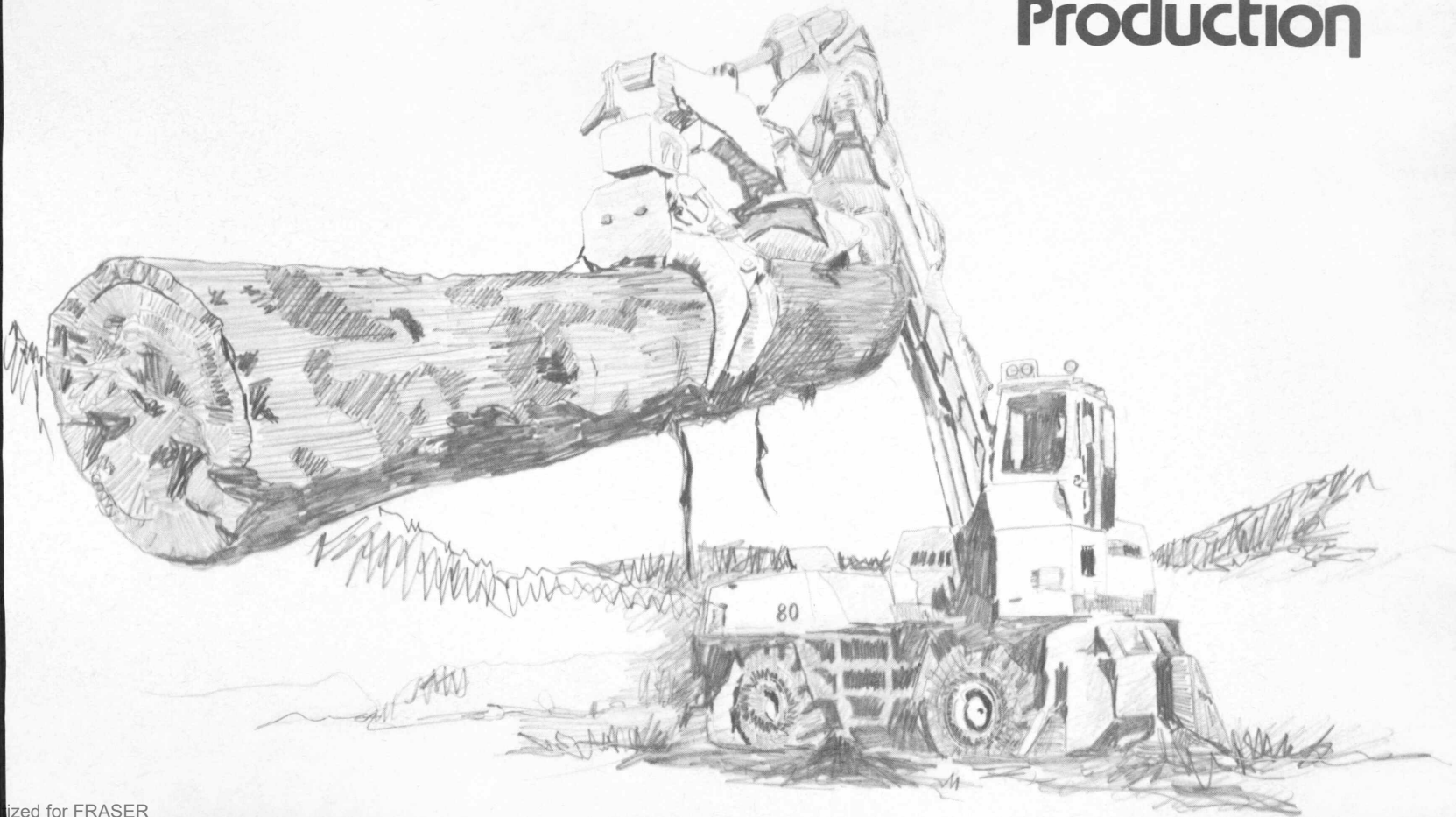

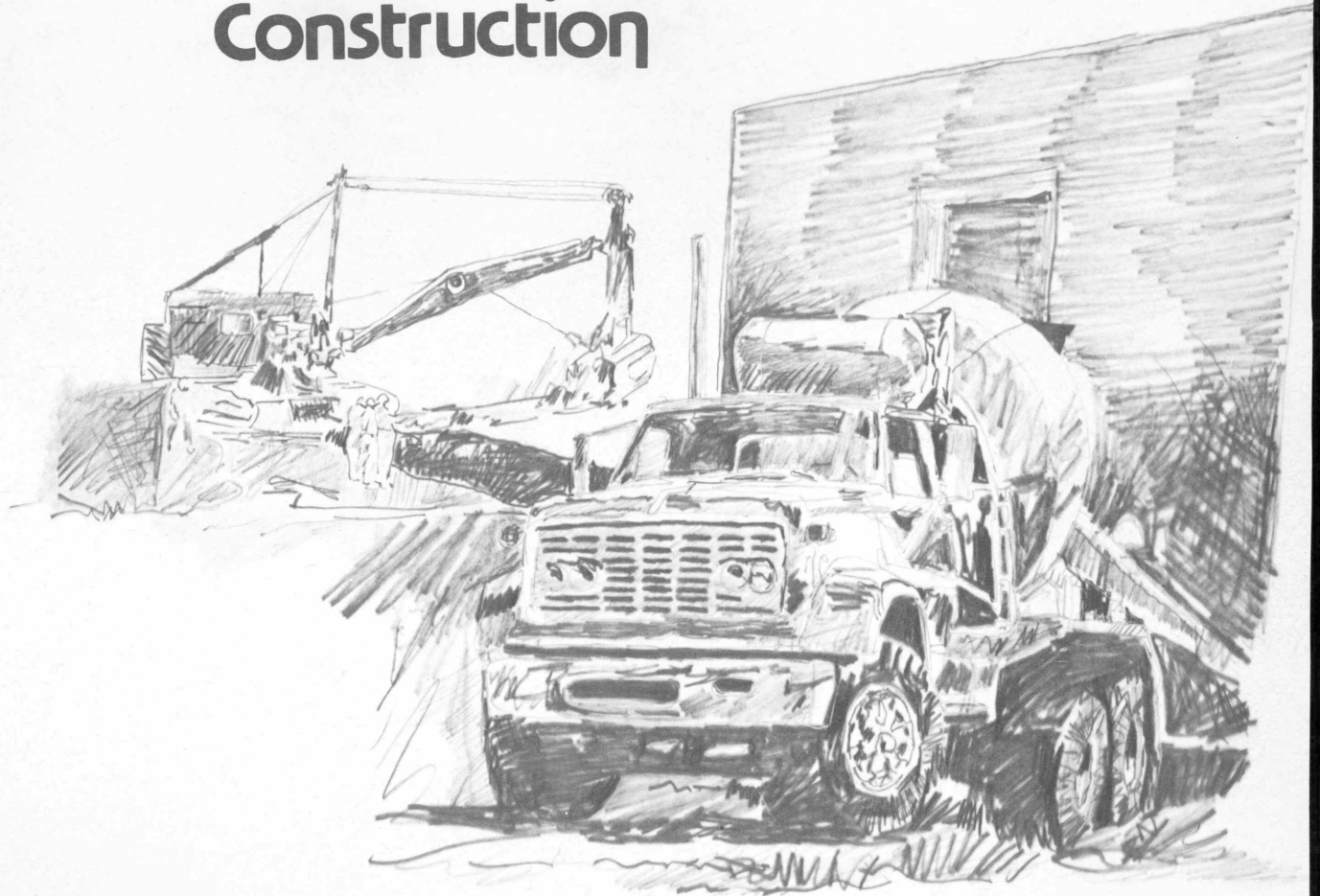

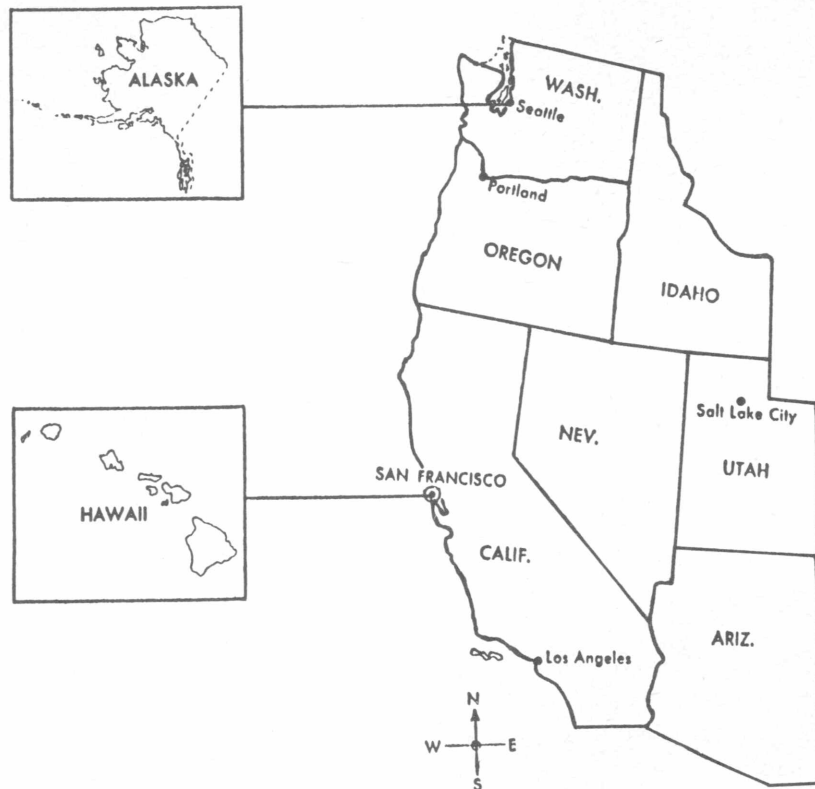
