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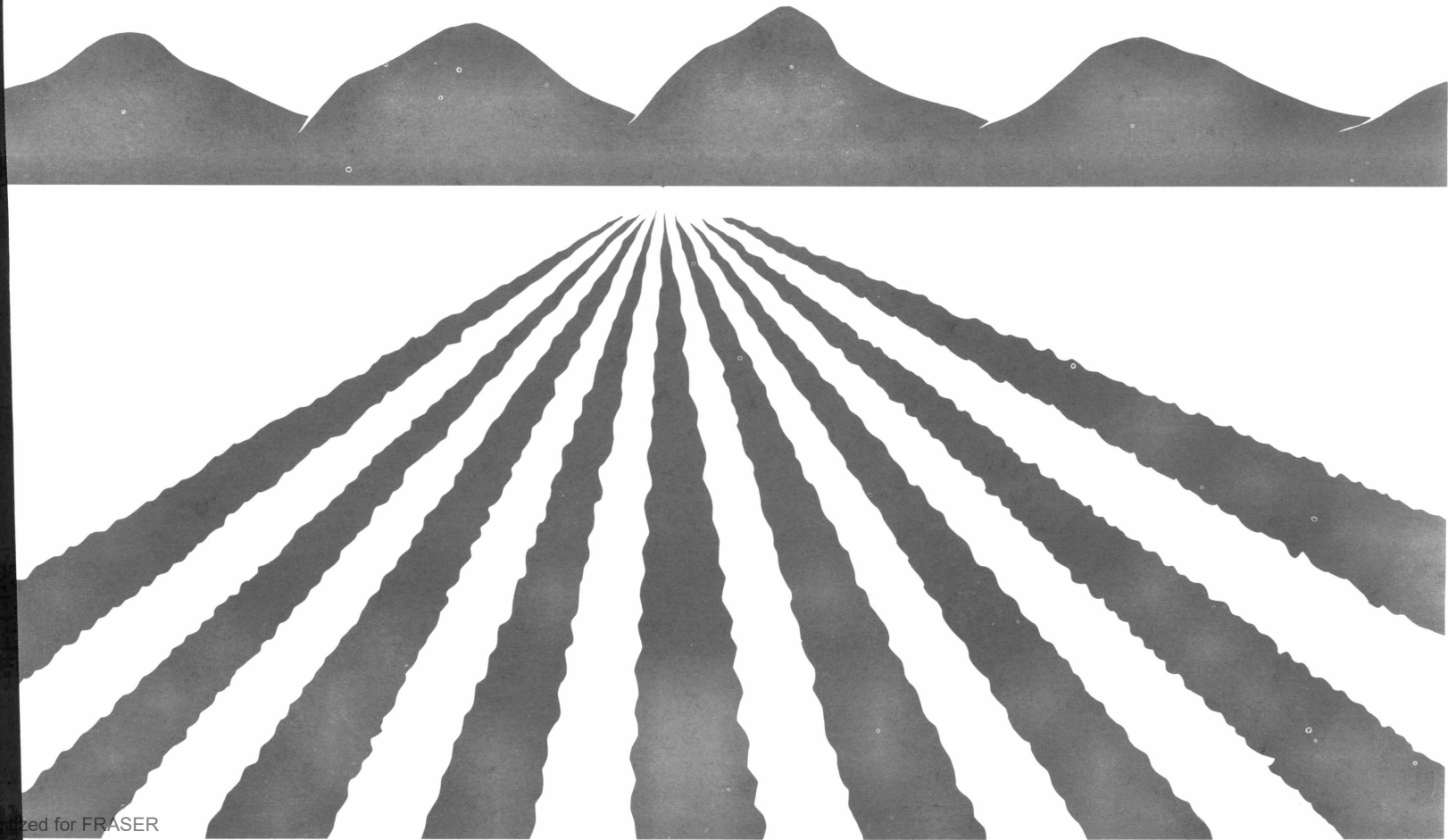
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Highlights of this Issue

- Total employment began to decline in early spring throughout the West, but declines in the construction and government sectors were largely offset by gains in trade and services (B-2,4) The unemployment rate rose in all Western states during this period so that at mid-year the California rate stood at 7.3 percent, not far below the national rate of 7.7 percent (B-3).
- Demand was strong for both business and real estate loans at California banks in May. Elsewhere in the District, business-loan demand slackened while real estate loans held strong. Banks helped meet the demand by selling “other” securities while adding to their portfolios of U.S. Treasury securities (E-4,5) Member-bank borrowings from the Fed dropped to their lowest point of the past several years — \$21 million on a daily average basis — but net purchases (borrowings) of Fed funds rose to their highest levels of recent years (E-2,3).
- Residential construction contracts were off sharply in early spring, but non-building projects held their ground. Housing starts were down, both in the West and the rest of the United States, reflecting the sharp rise in mortgage interest rates (D-2,3).

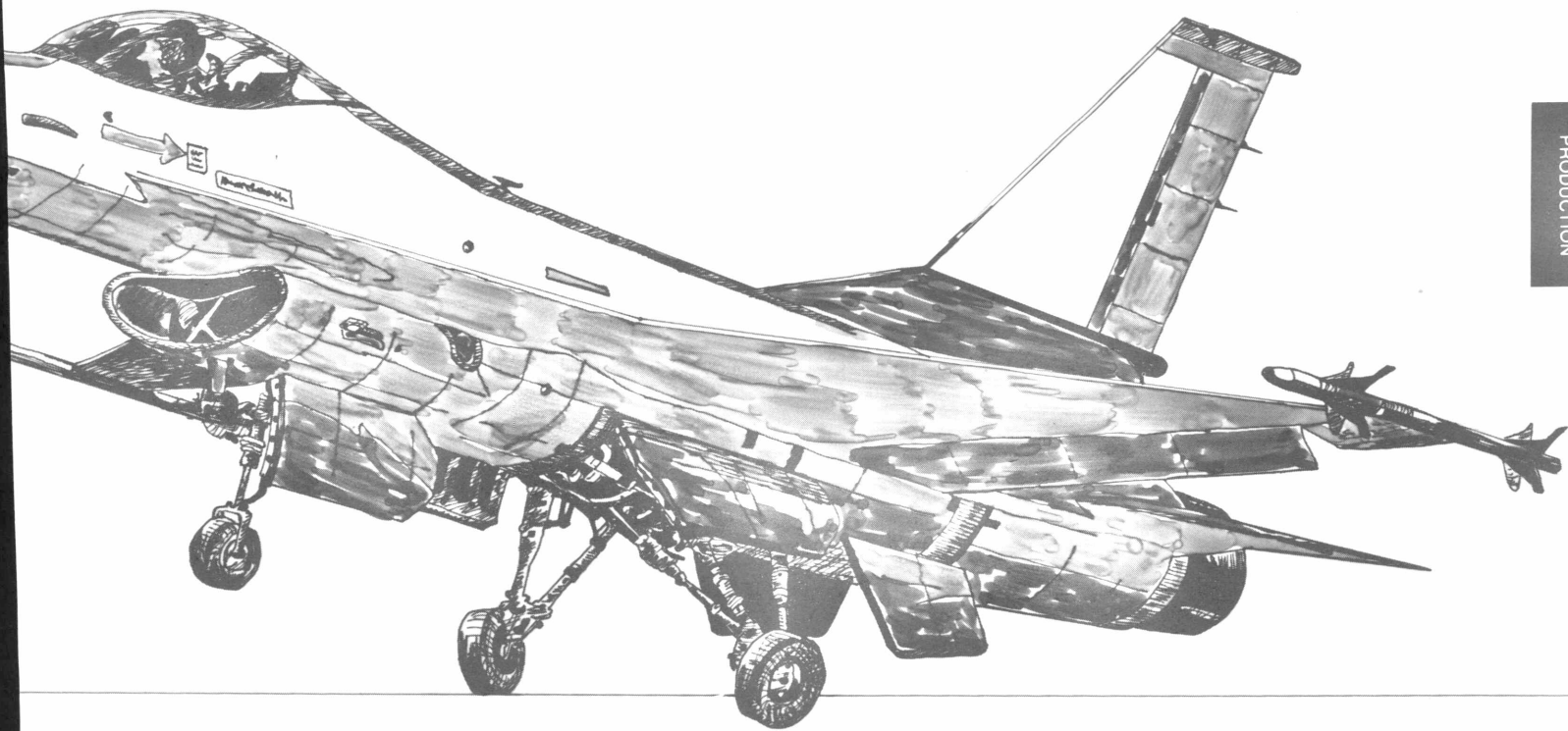
