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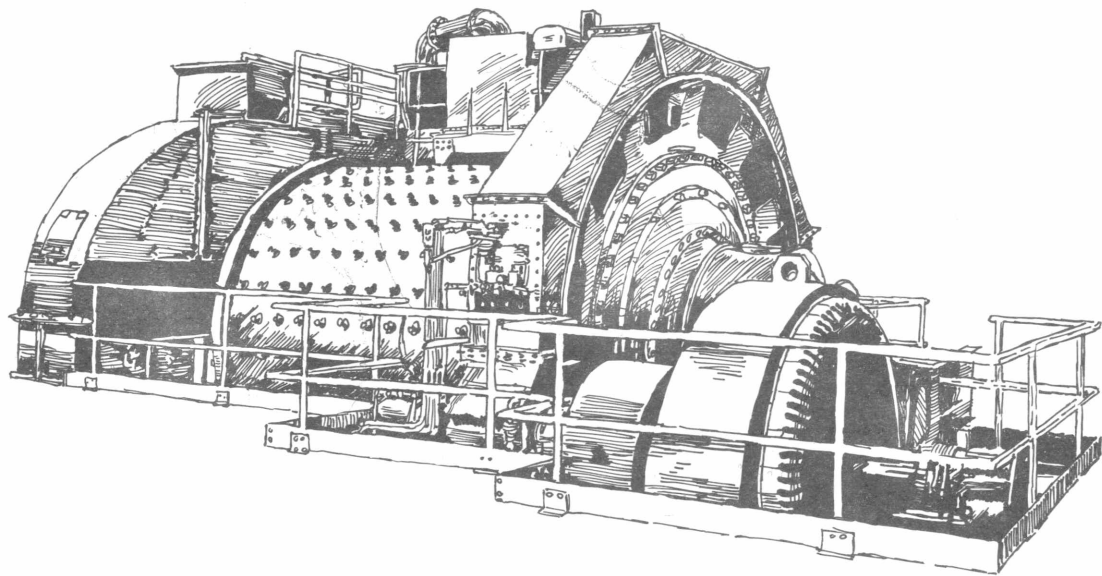
Highlights of this Issue

- Total employment weakened somewhat in 1980 in both the nation and the West, according to late-year figures (B-2,4) As employment weakened, unemployment rates rose, with California and U.S. rates both gaining nearly 1½ percentage points during 1980 (B-3).
- Housing starts in the West dropped dramatically in 1980 from year-ago levels, reflecting sharply rising mortgage-interest rates. Construction contracts, however, showed signs of picking up as the year ended, with strength evident in both residential and non-residential building projects (D-2,3).
- The demand for business and real-estate loans remained strong during 1980 in Western states. District banks decreased their holdings of U.S. securities while adding other (municipal and agency) securities to their portfolios (E-4,5) Member bank borrowings from the San Francisco Reserve Bank reached a relatively high \$120 million (daily average basis) in October (E-2).

NOTE: Due to data-collection problems, the only issues printed in 1980 were Number 1 and Number 2, 1980. Publication is scheduled on a quarterly basis this year.

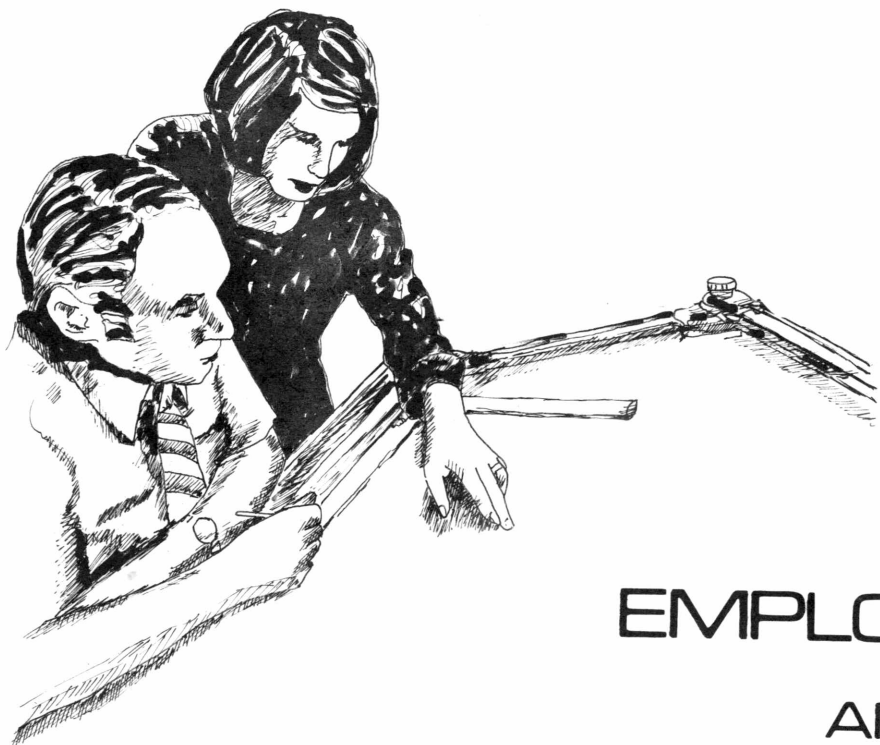

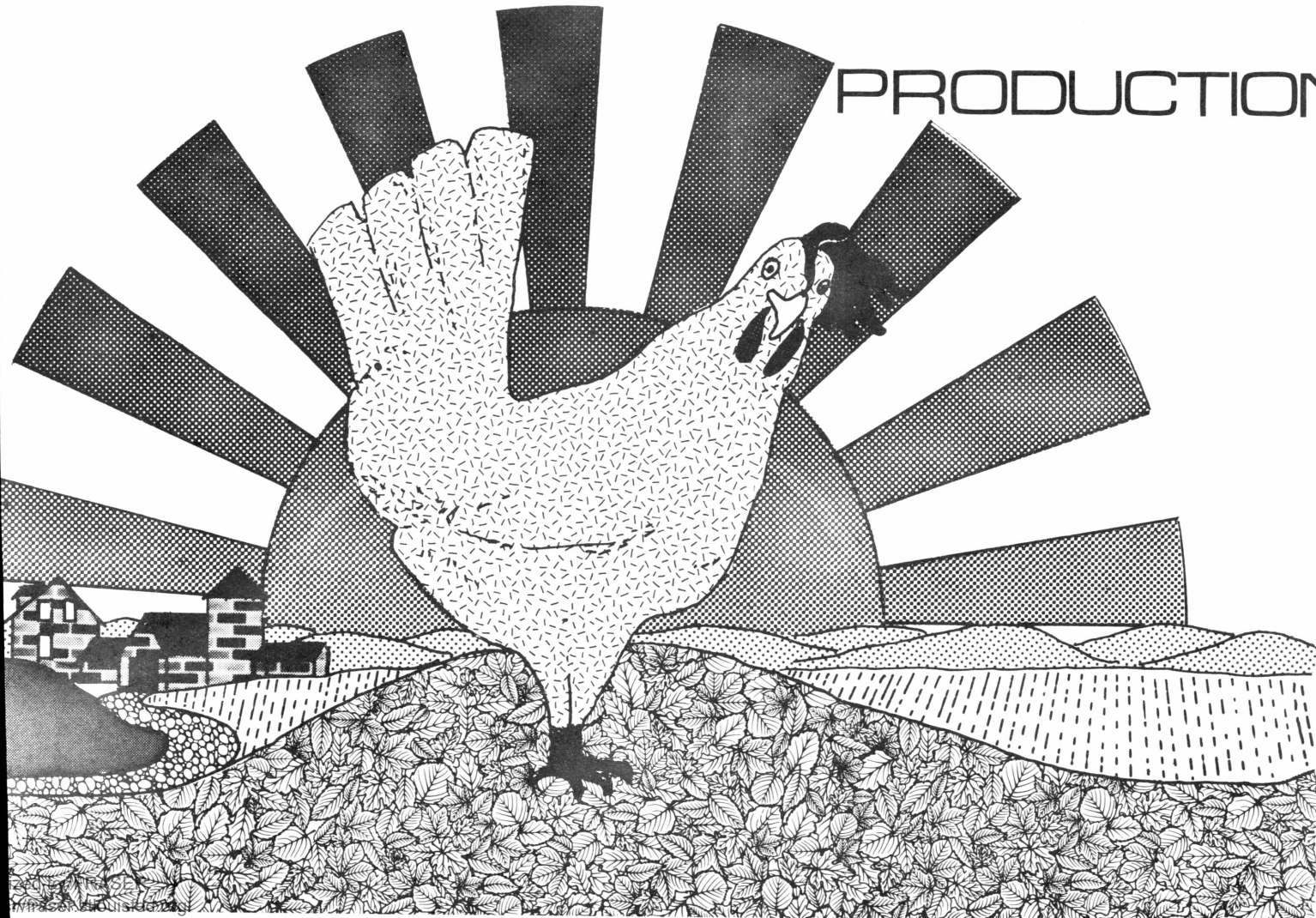

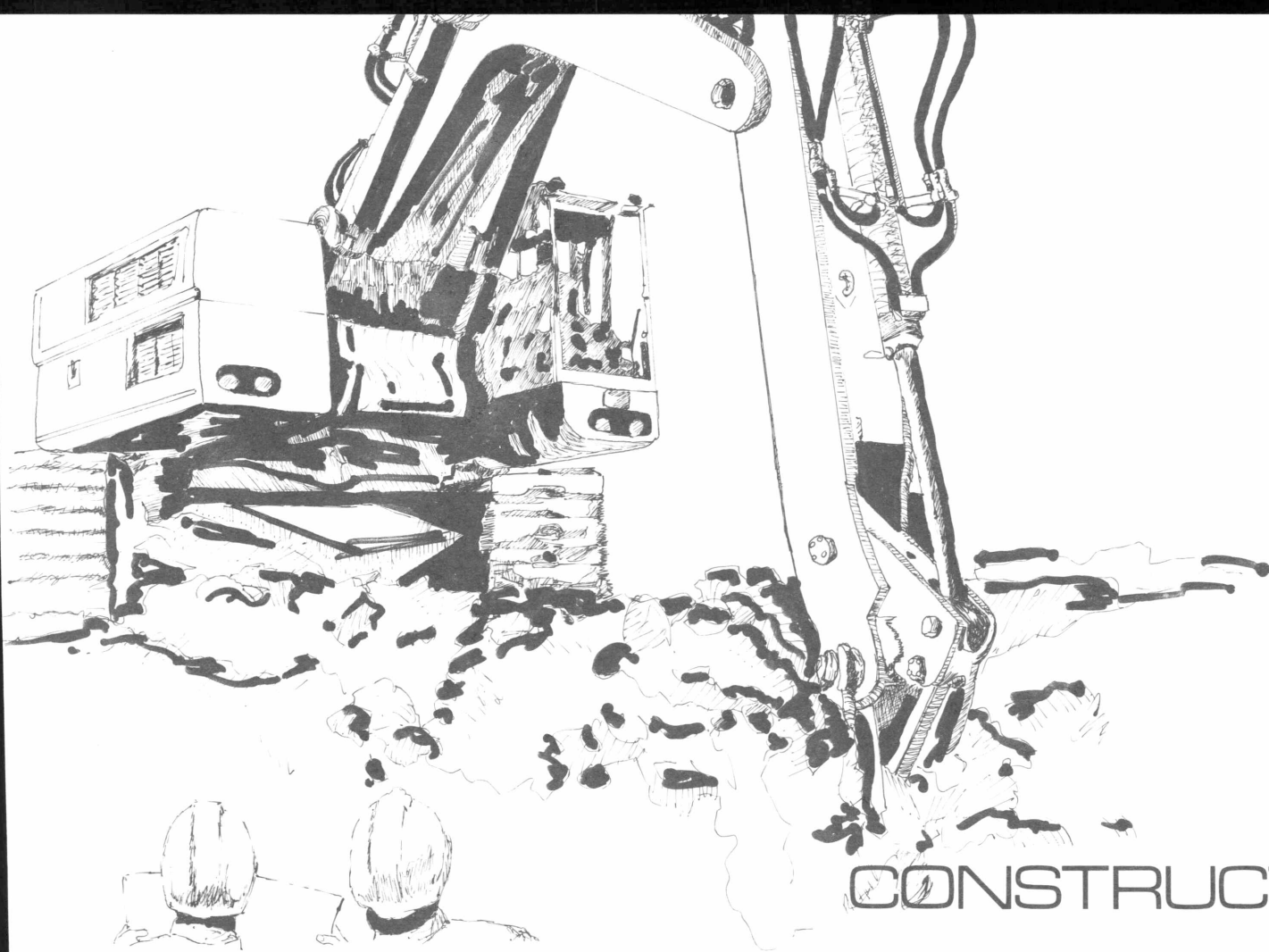

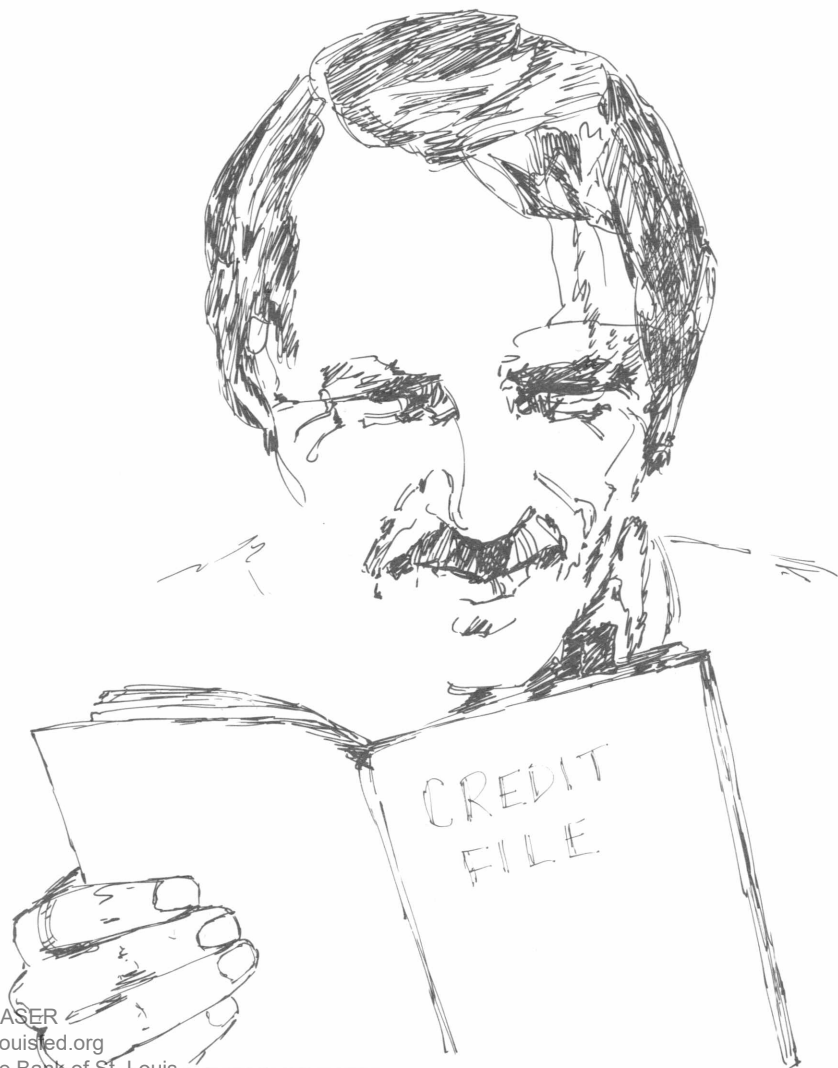
