Cities on map indicate location of Federal Reserve Offices.

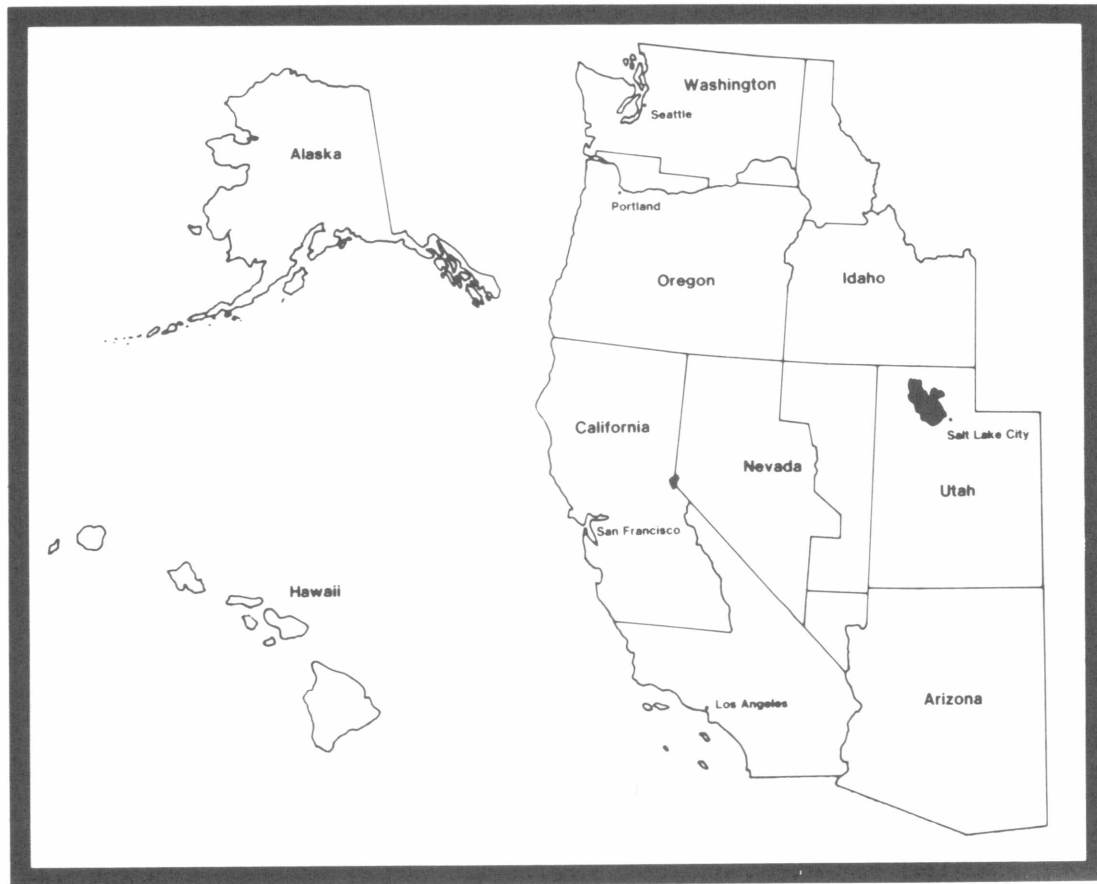


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Highlights of this Issue

- The Twelfth District states ended 1983 with continued strength in employment, matching the national trend. As a result of increased employment, unemployment rates continued to edge downward in California, Arizona, Hawaii, Nevada and Washington (B-2,3) . . . The employment gains were primarily in the aerospace, other manufacturing, trade, and services sectors (B-4).
- Construction contracts in the West were somewhat lower in December than in previous months. Housing starts were well above their year-ago levels although not as high as they had been in November (D-2,3).

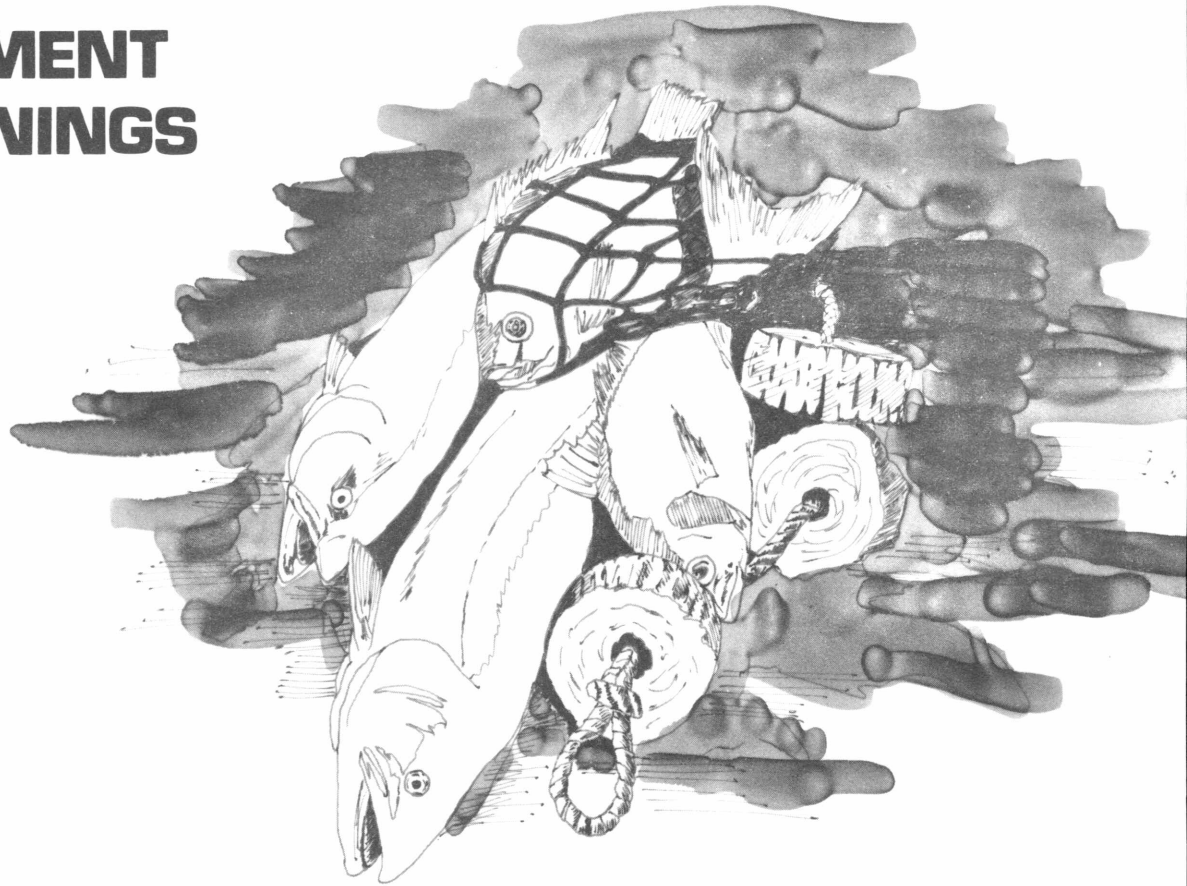

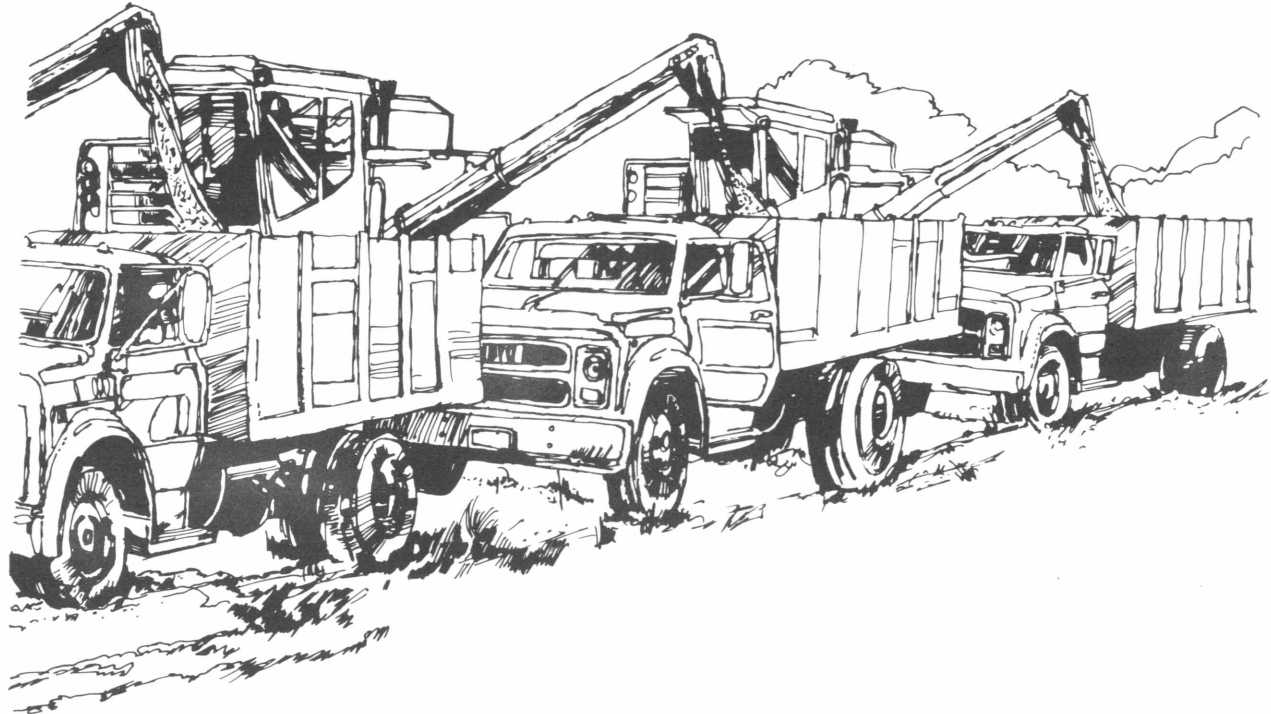

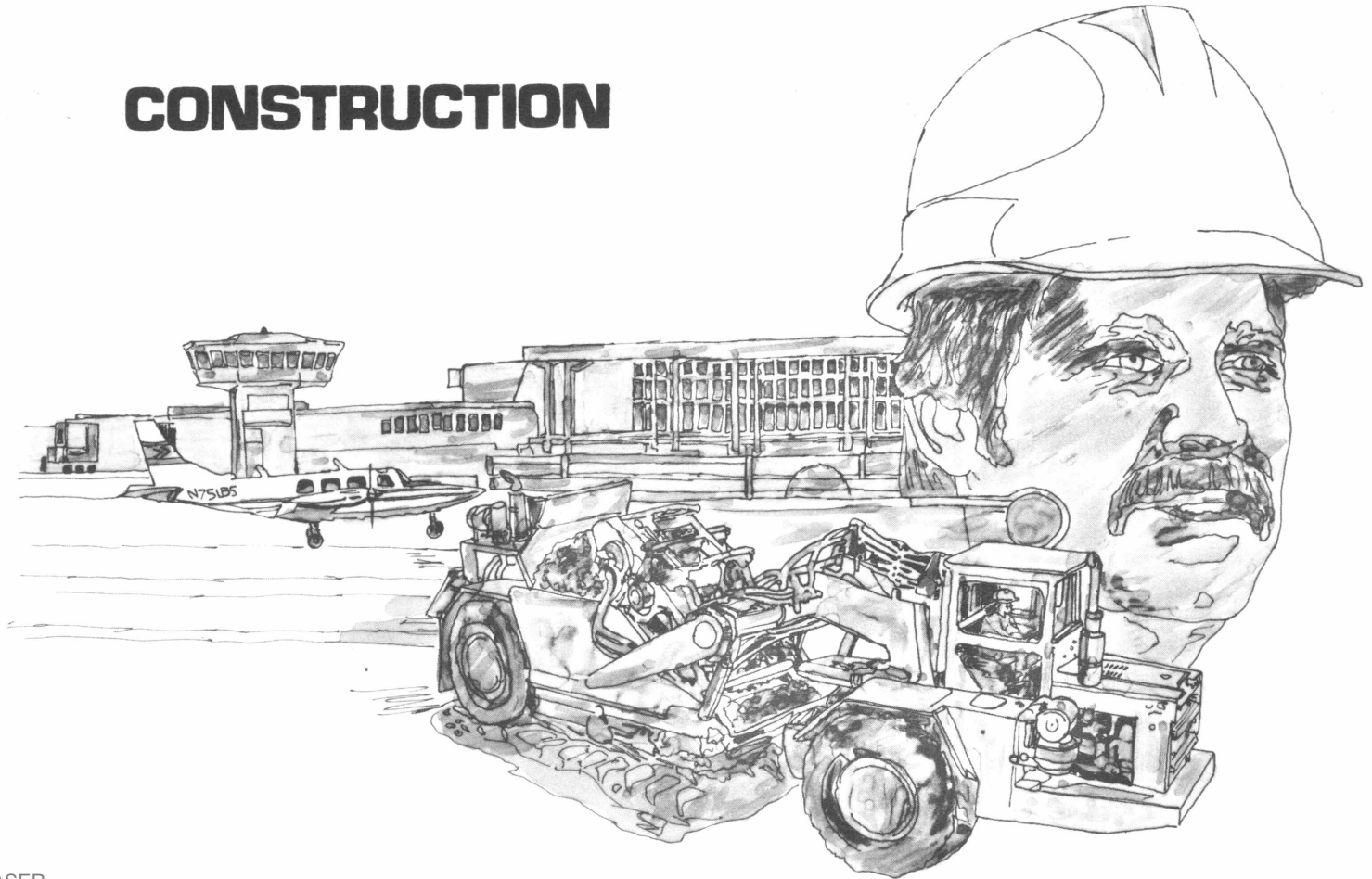
