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## Highlights of this Issue

- Unemployment rates declined in most Western states during the early months of 1984. Employment also showed signs of strength during that time period, particularly in the aerospace, other manufacturing, construction, trade and services sectors (B-2,3,4).
- Construction contracts in the Twelfth District were up sharply in early 1984 over the same period a year ago. There was considerable growth in residential construction in the West during January and February (D-2).

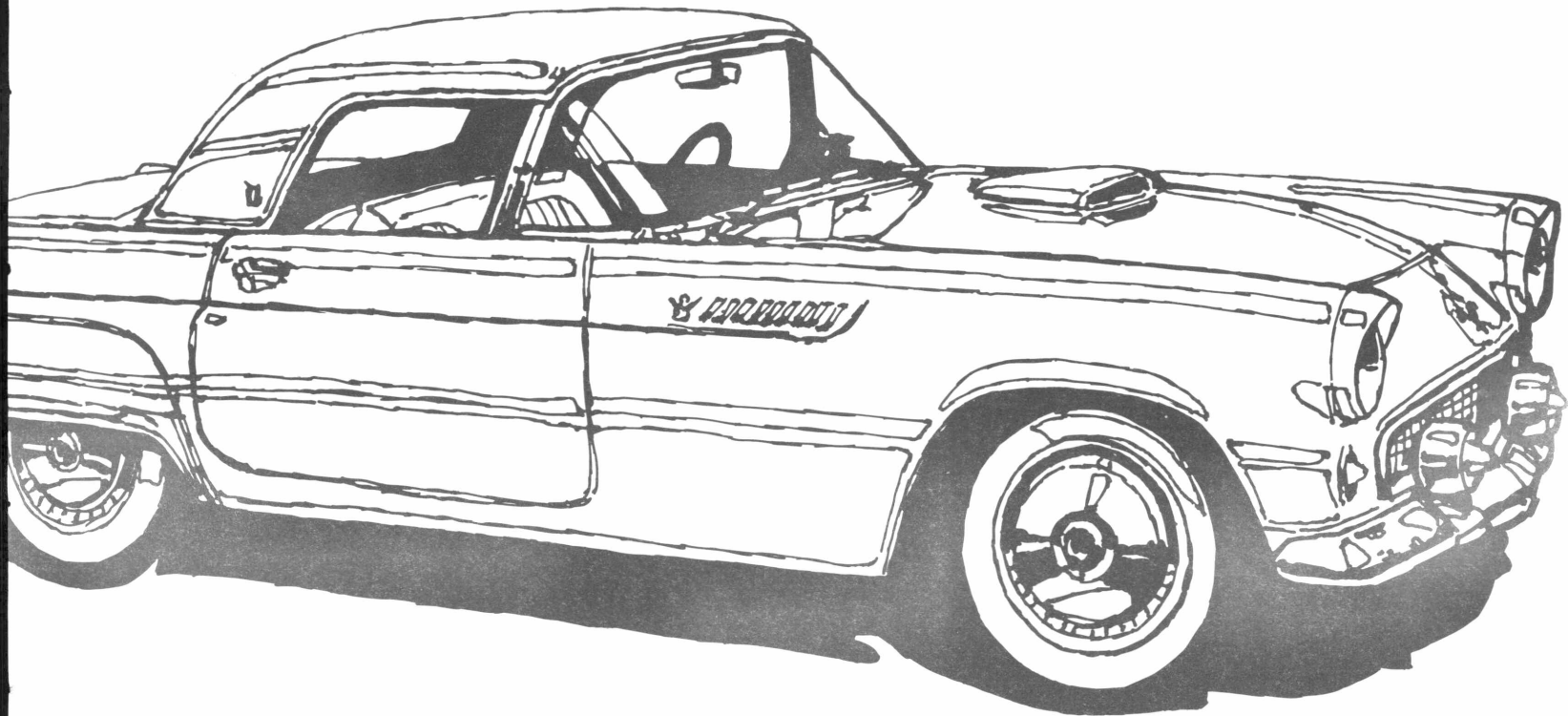
