Cities on map indicate location of Federal Reserve Offices.



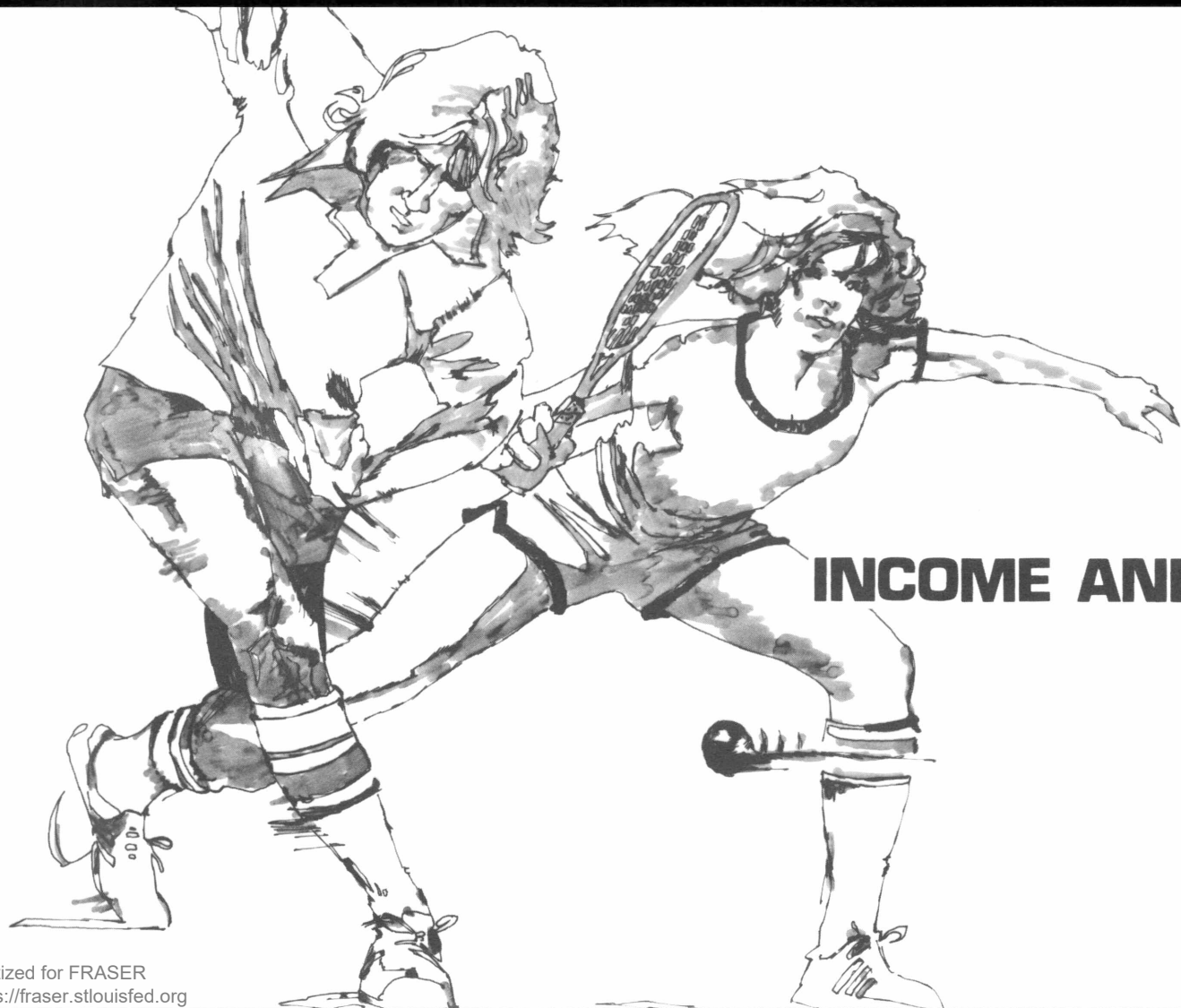

## Highlights of this Issue

- Unemployment rates either held steady or declined in most District states in May, showing considerable improvement from their levels at the beginning of 1984. Employment edged up slightly in the West in spring, particularly in the aerospace, construction, trade, services and government sectors (B-2,3,4).
- Construction contracts rose in May in the Twelfth District, primarily in the areas of non-residential and non-building projects (D-2).

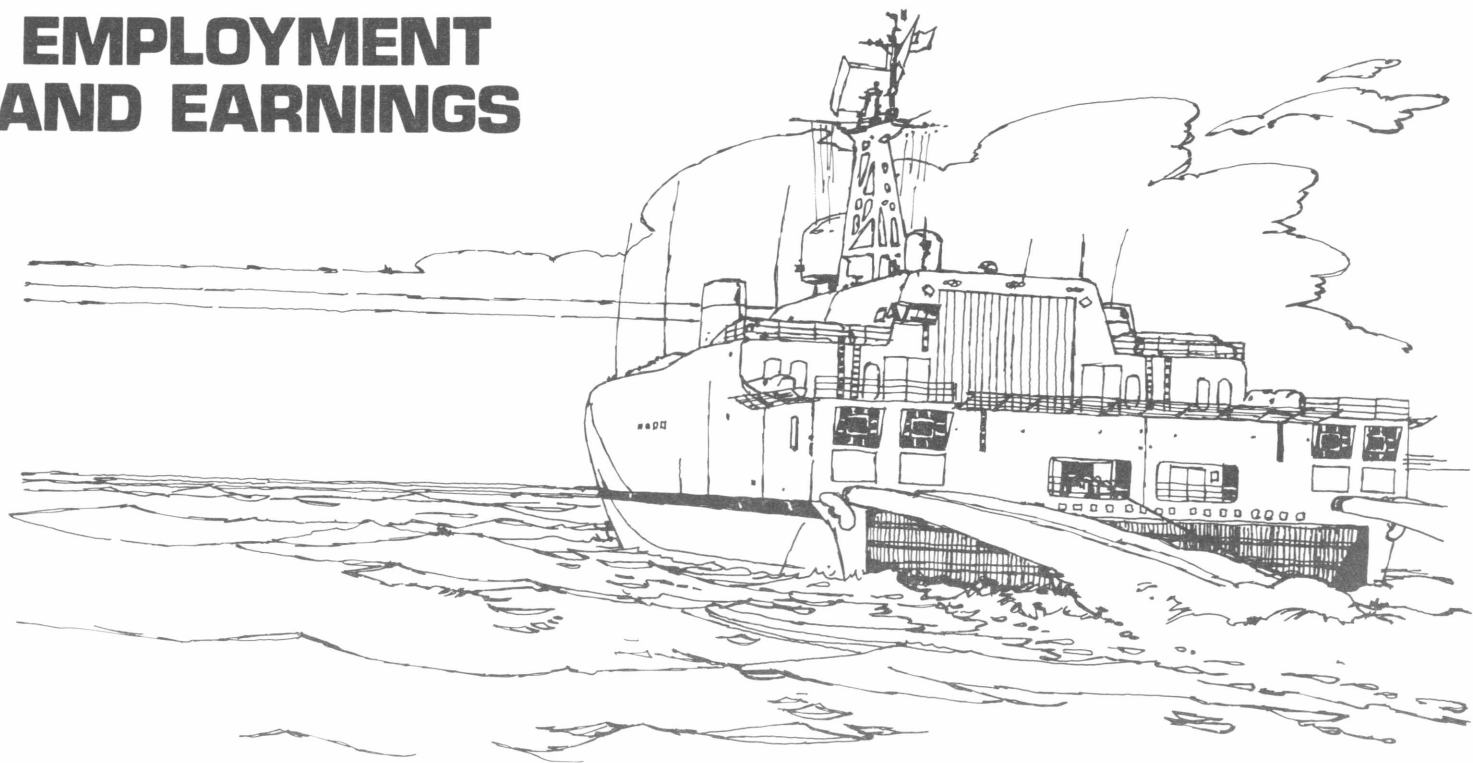

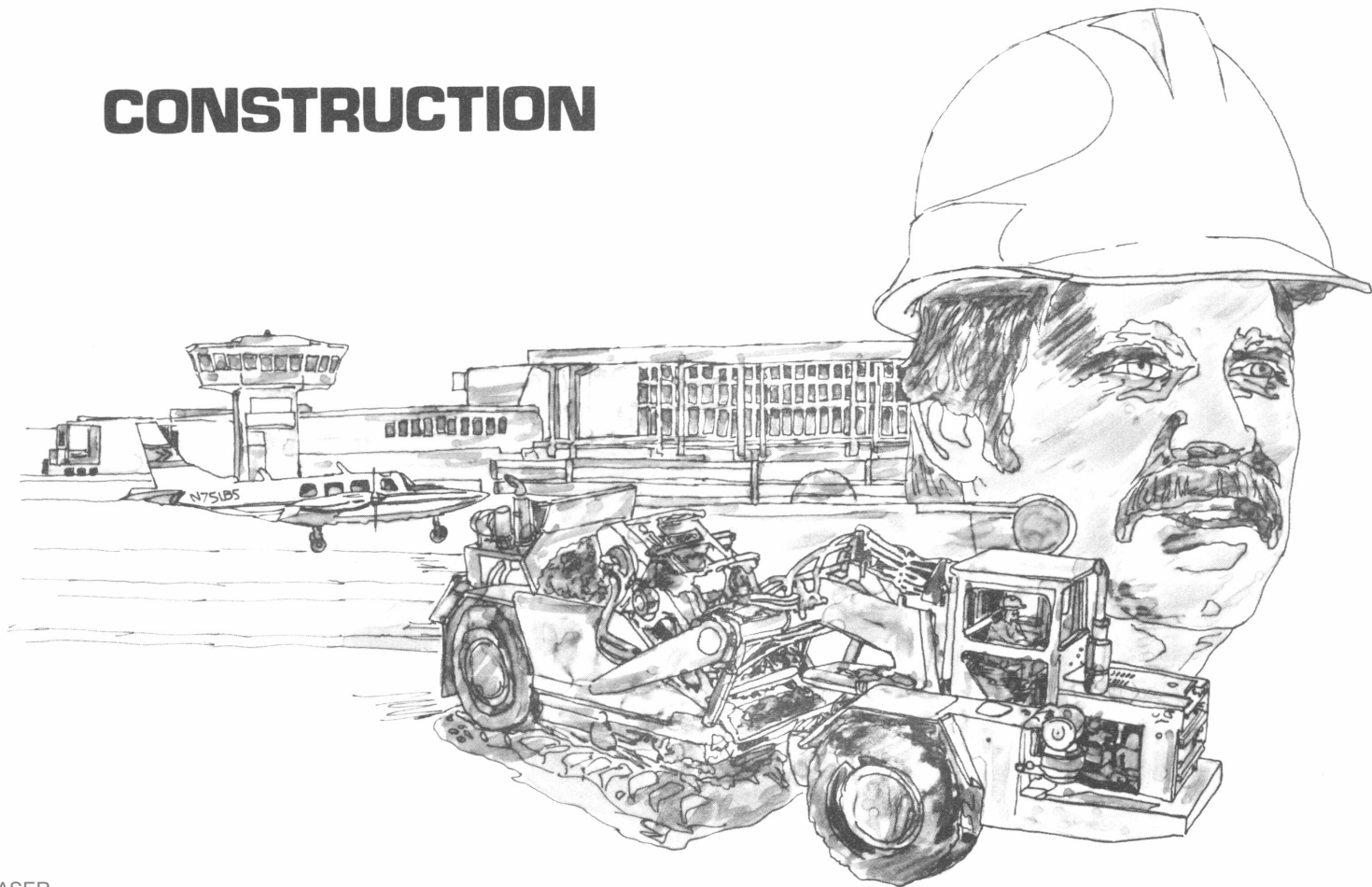
