DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

To all Banking Institutions in the Eighth Federal Reserve District:

Daylight Saving Time will be effective in St. Louis, Missouri, from Sunday, April 26, 1953, through Saturday, September 26, 1953. In Louisville, Kentucky, businesses will operate on "Voluntary Daylight Time" between those same dates. During this period local time will be one hour in advance of Central Standard Time in both cities. The Federal Reserve Bank at St. Louis and its branch at Louisville, Kentucky, will operate on local time.

Daylight Saving Time will not be in effect in the cities of Little Rock, Arkansas, and Memphis, Tennessee, and our branches located in those cities will continue to operate on Central Standard Time.
