The Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis today announced the following new official appointments made by the Board of Directors of the bank, effective January 1, 1954.

John J. Hofer, Manager, Collection-Transfer Department, has been appointed Assistant Vice President. Mr. Hofer has served in various capacities since joining the bank's staff in 1923. He was graduated in 1952 from the Central States School of Banking, University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wisconsin.

Orville O. Wyrick has been appointed an officer of the bank with the title of Assistant Chief Examiner. He joined the bank's staff in 1943 and has been associated with the Bank Examination Division since that time, except for a period of about five months in 1953 when he was loaned to the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System in Washington for a special assignment. He attended the University of Missouri and is a graduate of the Central States School of Banking.

Gerald T. Dunne has been appointed an officer of the bank with the title of Counsel and Assistant Secretary. Mr. Dunne received his B.S. degree from Georgetown University and his LL.B. degree from St. Louis University School of Law. He joined the Legal staff of the bank in 1949 as assistant to counsel.
