DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME

To Banking Institutions in the Eighth Federal Reserve District:

Daylight Saving Time has been extended in St. Louis, Missouri, through Saturday, October 27, 1956. In Louisville, Kentucky, businesses will operate on "Voluntary Daylight Time" through the same date. Until that date local time will be one hour in advance of Central Standard Time in both cities. The Federal Reserve Bank at St. Louis and the Louisville Branch will operate on local time.

Daylight Saving Time is not in effect in the cities of Little Rock, Arkansas, and Memphis, Tennessee, and the branches located in those cities will continue to operate on Central Standard Time.
