Alvin Huffman, Jr., Blytheville, Arkansas, has been appointed a director of the Memphis Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis for the unexpired portion of a term ending December 31, 1970. His appointment, effective August 14, 1968, was made by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, and as a director of the Memphis Branch he succeeds James S. Williams, who resigned June 1, 1968, prior to moving to Cleveland, Ohio, as Vice President of American Greetings Corporation.

Born in Blytheville, Arkansas, Mr. Huffman attended [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. He is President of Huffman Brothers Lumber Company in Blytheville.
