RESULTS OF ELECTION

To the Member Banks of the
Eighth Federal Reserve District:

The election of directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis to succeed Mr. James P. Hickok, Class A director, and Mr. Sherwood J. Smith, Class B director, whose terms end December 31, 1971, has been duly held in accordance with the requirements of Section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act and the provisions of the circular issued by this office under date of September 17, 1971.

The results of the election are as follows:

Mr. Edwin S. Jones, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, First National Bank in St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri, was elected by member banks in Group 1 as a Class A director.

Dr. James M. Tuholski, President, Mead Johnson & Company, Evansville, Indiana, was elected by member banks in Group 3 as a Class B director.

Each director was chosen for a term of three years to begin January 1, 1972.

The Chairman of the Board, Mr. Frederic M. Peirce, made the following announcements with respect to the election of directors of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis:

Edwin S. Jones, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, First National Bank in St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri, was elected by member banks in Group 1 as a Class A director of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis for a three-year term beginning January 1, 1972.

In addition to being affiliated with numerous state and local civic and trade organizations, Mr. Jones is President and Chief Operating Officer of First Union, Inc., St. Louis, and a Director of Angelica Corporation, Alton Box Board Company, General American Life Insurance Company, General Steel Industries, Inc., Interco, Inc., McDonnell Douglas Corp., Pet, Inc., and Vico, Inc. Born in St. Louis, Missouri, Mr. Jones attended Yale University and the University of Wisconsin School of Banking.

James M. Tuholski, President, Mead Johnson & Company, Evansville, Indiana, was elected by member banks in Group 3 as a Class B director of the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis for a three-year term beginning January 1, 1972.

Dr. Tuholski is a Trustee of the University of Evansville, a Member of the Development Council, University of Tennessee, American Medical Association, American Academy of Pediatrics, and American Board of Pediatrics, and an Associate Staff Member of St. Mary's Hospital, Evansville, Indiana. A native of Henning, Tennessee, he received his M. D. from the University of Tennessee.

The Board of Directors of the Federal Reserve Bank consists of nine members, six of whom (Classes A and B) are chosen by the member banks and three (Class C) by the Board of Governors in Washington.
