ELECTION OF DIRECTORS NOMINATION PROCEDURES

September 15, 1972

To the Member Banks of the Eighth Federal Reserve District:

An election will be held under the provisions of Section 4 of the Federal Reserve Act to choose successors to the following directors of this bank, whose terms expire December 31, 1972:

Class A Director, Cecil W. Cupp, Jr.

President

Arkansas Bank and Trust Company

Hot Springs, Arkansas

Class B Director, Edward J. Schnuck
Chairman of the Board
Schnuck Markets, Inc.
Bridgeton, Missouri

Mr. Cecil W. Cupp, Jr., Class A Director, was elected by banks in Group 2, and his successor will be chosen by the banks in this group. Group 2 consists of banks having capital and surplus of \$700,000 and over, but under \$2,500,000.

Mr. Cupp, who has served as a Class A Director since January 1, 1967, has respect-fully requested that his name not be placed in nomination for reelection.

Mr. Edward J. Schnuck, who has served as a Class B Director since January 1, 1970, was elected by banks in Group 1, and his successor will be chosen by the banks in this group. Group 1 consists of banks having capital and surplus of \$2,500,000 and over.

The banks comprising Groups 1 and 2 are listed on the following pages.

The group in which a member bank will be entitled to vote will be determined by its classification as of the date of this letter, even though its capital and surplus may subsequently change prior to the date of the election.

Each bank in Group 1 is permitted to nominate one candidate for Class B Director and each bank in Group 2 is permitted to nominate one candidate for Class A Director.* The nominations must be made by resolution of the Board of Directors and certified to me on or before October 13, 1972. A form for this purpose is enclosed. On October 20, 1972, a list of the candidates (indicating by whom nominated) and a preferential ballot will be mailed to each bank in the voting groups. The ballot must be cast within fifteen days after receipt. The polls will open at 9 a.m. on October 24, 1972, and close at 2 p.m. on November 8, 1972. At that time the ballot box will be opened in the Board Room of this bank, the votes counted and results of the election announced. The candidates are invited to be present or represented on that occasion.

In order to be counted, the ballot must be executed by an officer authorized to cast the vote. If the official signature of the officer, or officers, authorized to cast the ballot has not been filed with this Federal Reserve Bank, such official signature should be filed before the polls close. Inasmuch as the authority conferred on these officers continues until revoked, they need not be reappointed. Each member bank which has not designated an officer, or officers, for the purpose of signing the ballot, or any bank that desires to change its authorization, should do so by resolution of its Board of Directors and certify the appointment to me before the polls close. A form for this purpose will be furnished upon request.

While the banks in Group 3 will not vote in this election, this circular is sent to them without forms for their information.

In a resolution adopted December 23, 1915, the Federal Reserve Board expressed the opinion "that persons holding political or public office in the service of the United States, or of any State, territory, county, district, political subdivision, or municipality thereof, or acting as members of political party committees, cannot consistently with the spirit and underlying principles of the Federal Reserve Act, serve as directors or officers of Federal Reserve Banks." Under interpretations of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System, a person whose sole occupation is that of officer of an insurance company or of a savings and loan association is not eligible for election as a Class B director of a Federal Reserve Bank.

[&]quot;Class A shall consist of three members, who shall be chosen by and be representative of the stockholding banks." "No officer or director of a member bank shall be eligible to serve as a Class A director unless nominated and elected by banks which are members of the same group as the member bank of which he is an officer or director." "Any person who is an officer or director of more than one member bank shall not be eligible for nomination as a Class A director except by banks in the same group as the bank having the largest aggregate resources of any of those of which such person is an officer or director." "Class B shall consist of three members, who at the time of their election shall be actively engaged in their district in commerce, agriculture or some other industrial pursuit." "No director of Class B shall be an officer, director, or employee of any bank." "No Senator or Representative in Congress shall be a member of the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System or an officer or a director of a Federal reserve bank."
