GENERAL INFORMATION ON FORT WAYNE

Fort Wayne was one of the first trading posts to be established in Indiana. About 1800 the French built the first fort and named it Fort Miami. It was located on the bank of the St. Marys River just a little north of the Nickel Plate tracks and the foot of Superior Street. This Fort or Post was the garrison of the French until 1760. At that time a new Fort was built at the junction of Delaware Avenue and St. Joe Boulevard. In 1780 this Fort was captured by a detachment of English. The garrison at this Fort was brutally massacred in 1781. After the massacre the Indians were practically in command of this site until 1794 when General "Mad" Anthony Wayne built a Stockade and Fort on the site of Old Fort Park on East Main Street. The city was named after General "Mad" Anthony Wayne. In April 1810, Fort Wayne witnessed the departure of troops and the abandonment of the Fort as a military stronghold. That year also saw the start of a survey of the site of the present city. The first plat of the city of Fort Wayne was recorded in 1820. In 1820 Congress authorized the sale of the ground occupied by the Old Fort at \$1.25 per acre. Eighteen hundred and thirty-two saw the building of the first Court House at a cost of \$201,700 on the site of our present Court House. Original plat of Fort Wayne was recorded 1823. In 1878 the first water works was completed. Four other Court Houses were built before the present million dollar structure was built in 1892.

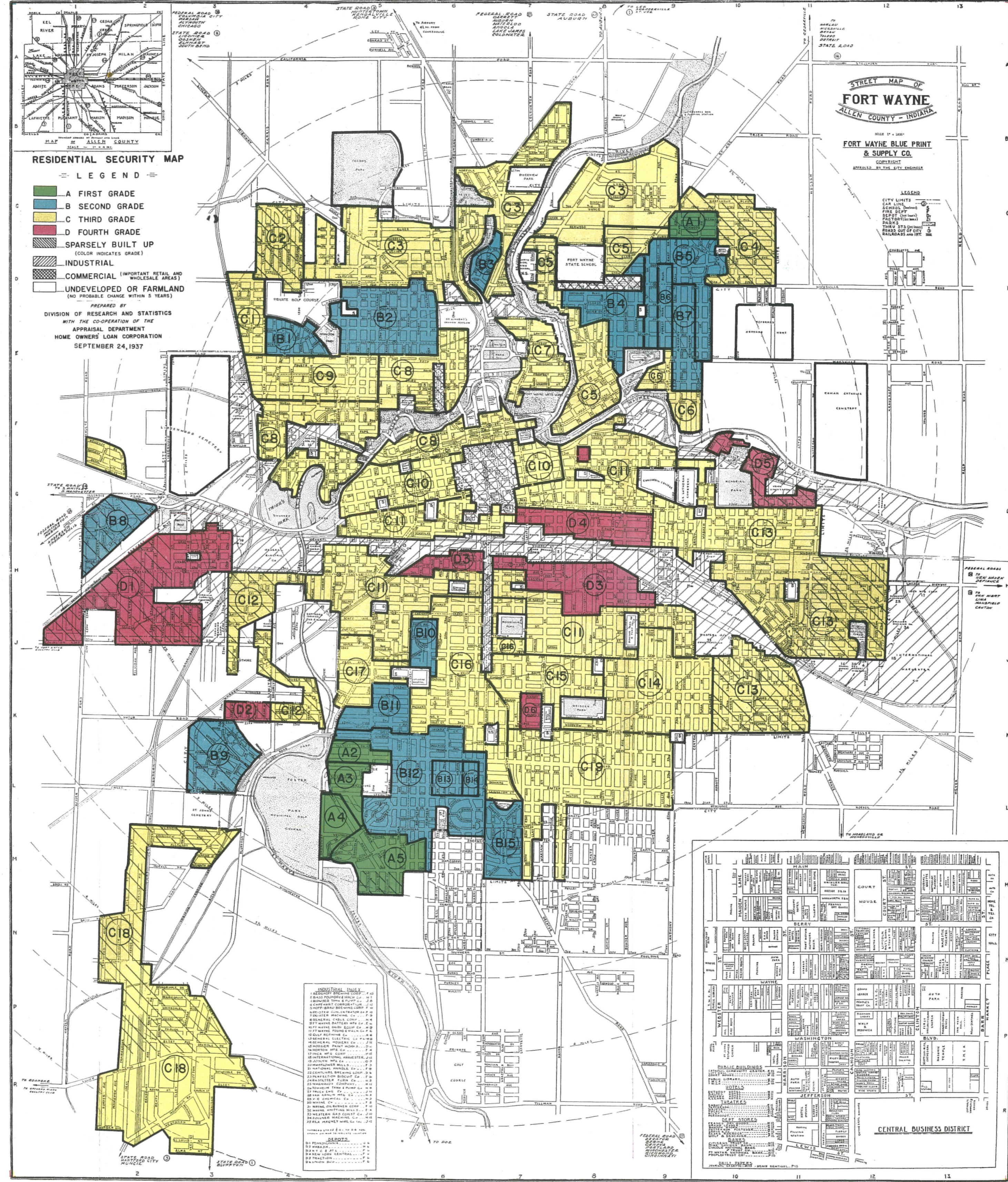


Table showing the layout of the Central Business District, including street names and building footprints.
