July 10

2. 11:00 a.m. Call of the Secretary on the Prince Regent at the Royal Palace.
3. 12:00 a.m. The Secretary's Press Conference at the Embassy.
4. 1:00 p.m. Lunch for the Secretary and his party at the residence of the Charge d'Affaires, 36, rue Vert Chasseur, Uccle.
5. 3:00 p.m. Call of the Secretary on the Minister of Finance.
6. 5:00 p.m. Call of the Secretary on the Governor of the National Bank.
7. 8:00 p.m. Dinner for the Secretary and his party, Embassy and Belgian officials at the Ministry of Finance. Dress: Black tie.
8. 10:00 p.m. Reception for the Secretary and his party at the Ministry of Finance. Dress: Black tie.
