- 1938 Sea Bright - Mother, Malcolm and I. Bill met us at Sea Bright. Malcolm came home by train. Mother and I drove.
- 1939 San Francisco Exposition and Glacier Park and Victoria, B.C. - Mother, Malcolm and I - Train and Hertz Drive-Yourself auto - Bill not with us
- 1940 Sea Bright via Saulte Ste. Marie - Mother, Malcolm and I, Bill joined us at Albany, New York. Mother and I drove home as Malcolm returned by train
- 1941 Duluth via Columbia, Missouri, where Mother and I picked up Malcolm after he finished his bar examination. Bill not with us.

1919

Melva, Missouri, Lucy's Mission.

Mother, Presley, Bill, Malcolm and I left Tuesday, June 17, at 8:30 a.m. I did driving as none of the boys were old enough. Flat tire at Denny Road. Ate lunch on side of road. Arrived Rolla about 8:00 p.m. and the other side of Rolla (Sand) at 8:30 p.m. mileage 160.44. Slept in tents by road. Mother disturbed by frogs and a cow. Hung revolver on tent ridge pole.

June 18, Wednesday. Had to fix tire in morning and left at 10:18 a.m. Had broken jack staff at Raymondville and was towed to Houston where arrived at 9:00 p.m. We slept in Houston Thursday, June 19. Left Houston 2:10 p.m. Friday June 20th in rain and roads slippery. Arrived Springfield, Missouri 9:30 p.m. and spent night. Left Springfield at 12:35 a.m. Saturday, June 21, arrived Hollister at 6:00 p.m., Melva (Lucy's collage) at 7:30 p.m. Sunday June 22 raining. Went to Sunday School in Melva School House. Monday, June 23, and Tuesday, June 24, spent in Melva with Lucy. Garage in Springfield had washed car and presumably gone over it. When went to use it after arrival at Melva, it would not run. Too far away to get help from any garage, so got out instruction book and finally fixed it myself. Left Melva Wednesday, June 25, at 8:30 a.m. Lucy went with us to Hollister where we arrived at 10:00 a.m. Ozark at 3:30 p.m. Arrived Sequiota Cave outside Springfield at 5:00 p.m. Slept night of June 25 in tents we had with us. Terrific storm at night with ground flooded.

Mother cooked breakfast the morning of Thursday June 26 on our little gasoline stove. Left Sequiota Cave about 8 a.m. Arrived

Mother cooked breakfast the morning of Thursday, June 26, on our little gasoline stove. Left Sequiota Cave about 8:00 a.m. Arrived Mt. Grove at 6:30 p.m. and stayed at Meyer Hotel. Roads very muddy, miry and slippery. Stuck in mud several times and had to be pulled out by team once, traveled 10 hours and made 61 miles. Friday, June 27, left Mt. Grove at 9:00 a.m. Raining and roads terrible, helped out once by man from Georgia in Ford car. We pulled out several stuck cars. Arrived St. Clair 9:00 p.m. Spent night at Commercial Hotel.

June 28, Saturday. Left St. Clair 8:30 a.m. arrived 5055 Waterman 11:00 a.m.

Used Hupmobile. Had two tents and beds, gasoline stove for cooking, spade and complete camping equipment. At night Malcolm slept on back seat of auto with comfort.

1920

Thursday, March 11. I arrived from conference with Memphis Banks at Gayso Hotel and Rebecca told me of storm at Melva. Tornado destroyed Melva and Lucy's cottage about noon. Newspaper reported 11 children killed, could not hear anything about Lucy.

Friday, March 12. Flora and I left to try to get to Lucy. Arrived via Springfield about 11:30 a.m. Lucy's cottage a complete wreck. Found Lucy, Mr. Alnut, Mr. Saalsbury of Hollister, Mr. and Mrs. Baxter, photographers of Branson and another lady. There was really nothing we could collect from

the wreckage. Left at 3:15 p.m. for Branson and spent night at Commercial Hotel.

Sunday, March 14. I went to Melva with Mr. Thompson, local insurance agent, who agreed residence a total loss. I left at 3:00 p.m. for St. Louis via Springfield and arrived 6:50 a.m. March 15. Lucy and Flora to return Wednesday morning.

1922

July 19. Bill and Presley left 5055 Waterman in Chevrolet at 8:15 a.m. for Ocean City, New Jersey.

Flora's family and ours left on train and spent up to sometime in August in Ocean City. I was going to Washington from time to time appearing before Banking and Currency Committee of the House about St. Louis Federal Reserve Bank Building.

1923

July 23. Mother, Bill, Malcolm and I left St. Louis in Franklin automobile in morning and drove via Indianapolis, Columbus and Cleveland to Buffalo, N.Y. where we stayed at Statler Hotel. From Buffalo as base we spent several days at Niagara Falls. At Buffalo we put car on boat "Octarara" for overnight trip to Macinac Island. Took ferry to Mainland and drove to Charlevoix, Michigan, where we stayed in our cottage for the rest of our summer. Drove from Charlevoix to St. Louis via Starved Rock where we ate lunch. Arrived at

St. Louis, September 11. Ate lunch at Union Station before going to 5055 Waterman.

1924

St. Louis to Quebec.

August. Mother, Bill, Malcolm and I drove in Franklin to Quebec via Indianapolis, Dayton for lunch, Columbus, Cleveland. Stayed at Hotel Cleveland. At Erie had an encounter with dumb policeman who was rattled about a fire that had broken out. We went through Buffalo, visited Niagara Falls, drove on to Mexico, N.Y., where we spent night with Cousin John and Cousin Bettie Young. Had to go to Rochester, N.Y. to get boat. Then had to change to smaller boat to go through Lachine Rapids to Montreal where we stayed at Mt. Royal Hotel, which was crowded with boisterous guests who had come from across the border to get liquor. This country had prohibition. In morning drove on Canadian side from Montreal to Quebec. Stayed at Chateau Frontenac. Left car in garage there and took boat trip up Saquenay River. Drove over road not quite finished but very passable from Quebec to Augusta, Maine. American custom officials disagreeable. The scenery wild and through forest. Franklin was bucking and jumping and stopping. Filling stations talking only French. Bill could talk to them a little. Arrived Augusta about 10:00 p.m. and Hotel dining room had closed. Finally got something to eat at a Chinese Restaurant. Stopped one night at Ogunquit. Stayed at Copley Plaza in Boston, where a G.A.R. Convention was being held. Bill, Malcolm and I went

to fire works on Boston Common. At New London stopped at Griswold. Visited New Haven and drove home via Philadelphia, Gettysburg, Uniontown (Summit) and Wheeling.

1925

July 2nd. Bill, Malcolm and I left Montreal on S.S. Marlock, Room 242 for Europe. Met Flora at Glasgow, Scotland. Bill went on with Flora. Malcolm and I left Southhampton on Friday, July 24, on S. S. Orbita, Staterooms 604 and 605. Arrived New York August 4.

1926

July 30. Mother, Bill, Malcolm and I left St. Louis July 30, Friday, via Missouri Pacific for Yellowstone Park. Returned to St. Louis Tuesday, August 17. Due to wreck were transferred from Mo. Pac. to Rock Island at Washington, Mo.

Friday, July 30 - Left St. Louis 2:02 p.m., Missouri Pacific.

Saturday, July 31. Arrived Colorado Springs 12:57 p.m. Stopped at Alta Vista Hotel and by auto visited North and South Cheyenne Canyons, Seven Falls, Garden of the Gods, Cave of the Winds, etc.

Sunday, Aug. 1. Colorado Springs. Went to First Presbyterian Church.

Monday, Aug. 2. Colorado Springs. Took Pike's Peak trip in the morning. In afternoon Miss Carrie Miller, Bill,

Malcolm and I went up Manitou Incline.

Tuesday, Aug. 3 - Left Colorado Springs 11:00 a.m. D&RG, went through Royal Gorge about two o'clock.

Wednesday, Aug. 4 - Arrived Salt Lake City 11:40 a.m. Stopped at Newhouse. In the afternoon took auto ride through city and vicinity.

Thursday, Aug. 5 - Salt Lake City. In the morning went to Saltaire and the Great Salt Lake and took a swim. In the afternoon went to the Bingham Copper Mines.

Thursday, Aug. 5 - Left Salt Lake City 8 p.m. via Union Pacific.

Friday, Aug. 6 - Arrived West Yellowstone 7:30 a.m. Left for tour of Yellowstone Park 9:30 a.m., arrived Old Faithful 11:55 a.m.

Saturday, Aug. 7 - Left Old Faithful 1:50 p.m., arrived Yellowstone Lake 4:55 p.m.

Sunday, Aug. 8 - Spent the day at Yellowstone Lake.

Monday, Aug. 9 - Left Yellowstone Lake 10 a.m., arrived Grand Canyon 12 m. for lunch. Left Grand Canyon 1:15 p.m., arrived Mammoth Hot Springs 4:48 p.m.

Tuesday, Aug. 10 - Left Mammoth Hot Springs 12:30 p.m., arrived Grand Canyon via Norris Geyser Basin 3 p.m.

Wednesday, Aug. 11 - Left Grand Canyon 9 a.m., arrived Sylvan Pass Lodge 1 p.m. for lunch. Left Sylvan Pass Lodge 1:15 p.m., arrived Cody 5:10 p.m.

Thursday, Aug. 12 - Left Cody 8:20 a.m. Burlington.

Friday, Aug. 13 - Arrived Denver 10:05 a.m. Stopped at Brown Palace Hotel. In afternoon took Mountain Park Drive over Lookout Mountain.

Saturday, Aug. 14 - Went by auto to Loveland and hired auto to take us to Neville's Ranch to see Mr. & Mrs. Felix E. Anderson.

Sunday, Aug. 15 - In the morning went to First Avenue Presbyterian Church. At night Mrs. Martin and Bill went to Trinity Methodist Church.

Monday, Aug. 16 - Left Denver 11:40 a.m. D&RG - Mo. Pac.

Tuesday, Aug. 17 - Train stopped at Washington, Mo. by news of derailment of four freight cars ahead. When found that track could not be fixed to get train into St. Louis at reasonable time, train was run up to Labadie, Mo. and at that point passengers transferred to Rock Island. Arrived 5:25 p. m. St. Louis.

1928

Via auto to Bill's commencement at Yale. Left St. Louis June 11th Mother and I. Malcolm had to stay in St. Louis for college board examinations. Mother and I spent night at Painesville, Ohio. In garage I found a car which had been damaged by wooden blocks of the road blowing up on account of steam generated by rain seeping between the blocks which were very hot. Electric storm at Canandague. June 19 gave lunch at Taft to Johnson, his mother and brother, Mr. & Mrs. Kauffman, Kauffman, his sister & Golden; mother, Bill and I present. Saw boat race at New London. Malcolm arrived Saturday June 23. Went to Sheldon House and had Tyler and sister to supper (dinner) there. Arrived Delaware Water Gap 3:30 p.m. July 3. Lehigh University and Annapolis July 5th. Luray Caverns Friday July 6, Univ. of Va. Staunton, Lexington, Va., Natural Bridge, Mt. Sterling, Lexington, Ky., Louisville, Mammoth Cave, Louisville (Tyler Hotel). Arrived home Friday July 13. Total mileage 3840.

1929

Trip to Iron Ore Country and Port Arthur on Lake Superior. July 9. Arrived at Hotel Stevens, Chicago 6:30 p.m. July 9 via Springfield and Bloomington. Mrs. Martin, Lucy, Malcolm and I left St. Louis Tuesday July 9. Left Chicago Friday Morning July 12. Menomane Falls for lunch. Milwaukee, Green Bay, Wis. for night. Ephraim, Fish Creek, Bailey's Harbor, etc., Sturgeon Bay. Left Green Bay Northland Hotel 8:10 a.m. Monday July 15. Lunch Iron River, Michigan, Curry Hotel Ironwood Michigan for night. Here first saw in circulation the new smaller currency. Arrived Duluth 1:30 p.m. Hotel

Duluth. Met Mr. and Mrs. Harrison. Left Duluth Friday July 19 at 8:15 a.m. Little Marias, Grand Marias. Arrived Prince Arthur Hotel at 5:00 p. m. Friday July 19. Received telegram telling of birth of Elizabeth, Burntside Lodge Ely, Minn. Tuesday July 23, took ride on Burntside Lake in out-board motor. Left Burntside Lodge 9:00 a. m. Wed. July 24. Lunch Androne Hotel, Hibbing, Minnesota. Arrived Bemidje, Minn at Hotel New Markham at 5:00 Wednesday July 24. Left Bemidje 10:30 a.m. Arrived Douglas Lodge, Lake Itasca. On Friday July 26 hired motor boat and went to source of Miss. River. Very hot. Went to Methodist Church July 28, Park Rapids, Minn. Arrived at Nicolet Hotel, Minneapolis 3:30 p.m. Monday July 29. Toured St. Paul visited Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis, Lake Minnetonka. Left Nicollet Hotel Minneapolis 8:25 a.m. Thursday Aug. 1. Lunch Hotel Wenonah Minn. La Cross, Wis., Madison, Dells of Wisconsin. At Madison on Aug. 2 received telegram telling me to come to conference in Washington on Aug. 7. Left Lorraine Hotel, Madison, Wis. at 7:35 a.m. Aug. 3. Lunch Starved Rock Park. Springfield, Ill. at 4:45 p.m. Stayed at Abraham Lincoln Hotel. At 1st Pres. Church met Misses Helen and Eliza Conell. Left Springfield Monday Aug. 5. at 7:25 a.m. Arrived 5055 Waterman at 11:25 a.m. and I attended Executive Com. meeting at bank that morning. On this trip we saw iron ore being mined.

1930

July. Left St. Louis in Franklin July 8 at 8 a.m.

Topeka, Dodge City, La Junta, Colorado, Las Vegas, New Mexico, Castaneda Hotel, July 12 at Ilfeld, New Mexico at 11:50 a.m. where Tom owned a shack and property. Santa Fe, N.M. La Fondar Hotel. Arrived Grand Canyon Arizona, El Tovar Hotel via Williams Tuesday July 15. On Thursday July 17 Malcolm and I rode down Bright ^{Angel} ~~Angel~~ Trail to bottom of Canyon 15045 feet from ^{Rim} ~~River~~. Left El Tovar Hotel at 1:00 p.m. in rain & raining hard at Williams but continued to Winslow where we arrived at Hotel La Pasala at 7:35 p.m. July 18. Came near being washed away in Dip between Williams and Winslow. Hotel clerk surprised that we got through. Gallup, N.M. for lunch July 19. We had stopped at Gallup for night going to Canyon. Arrived Albuquerque, N.M. Alvarado Hotel 8 p.m. July 19 after a beautiful exciting ride through several thunderstorms. Dodge City, Hutchinson Kansas, Topeka, Kansas. Road from Dodge City to Topeka muddy and slippery. Booneville, Mo., St. Charles. Arrived 5055 Waterman at 5:45 p.m. Friday July 25. Total mileage 3545. Cost of trip for three (Mother, Malcolm and I) \$597.09.

1931.

Trip to California.

Tuesday July 21 Mo. Pac. tickets for Mother, Malcolm and I to San Francisco and return via San Diego and Vancouver. Left 5055 Waterman at 5:00 p.m. via taxi for station. Fort Worth, El Paso Thursday, July 23. Changed from Sunset to

Southern Golden Limited. Difficult to sleep on account of intense heat. Arrived San Diego, Cal. at 10:30 a.m. Took Mother to Grant Hotel. Got Hertz drive-your-self Buick license 30494. Malcolm and I took examinations for California Drivers license. I was issued No. 674774 and Malcolm No. 674784. Lunch Hotel U.S. Grant. In afternoon drove around Point Loma and over Breakwater to Coronado Hotel and back to San Diego by ferry. Saturday July 25 left U. S. Grant Hotel at 10:15 am. Sat on bench Crest Del Mar. Lunch Laguna Beach. Santa Monica, Miramer Hotel at 6:00 p.m. Saturday July 26. Could not get room in hotel but they gave us a detached apartment. Saw La Jolla, Del Mar, Laguna Long Beach, San Pedro Harbor (Los Angeles) Hermoso, Manhattan Venice etc. Sunday July 27 went to 1st Pres. Church, Santa Monica. Monday morning July 28 went swimming Miramar Beach Club. Surf high and had undertow. Left Santa Monica at 1:00 p.m. Stopped by and saw Margaret Leonard who had been with us at Charlevoix. Went through Beverly Hills and Hollywood. Arrived Biltmore Hotel Los Angeles in afternoon, weather hot and sticky. Got mail at Los Angeles Branch, Federal Reserve of S. F. Saw Gerald Dever, formerly one of my examiners. Left Biltmore, Los Angeles at 1:20 p.m. Tuesday July 29. Arrived Santa Barba about 4:00 pm. Stopped at Hotel Vista Marmonte. Left in morning. Lunch Atarcalers. Arrived Del Monte Hotel, Monterey at 4:30 p.m. Enormous bath tubs. Left Thursday July 30. Lunch Tiogo Hotel, Merced. Arrived Ahewahnee Hotel Yosemite National Park at 4:30 p.m. Thursday July 30. Friday July 31 drove around Park but there was little or no water in falls. Saw

fire fall for second time. Left Ahwahnee Hotel 7:55 a.m. Lunch Hughson Hotel, Modesto, Cal. Over Dumbarton Bridge to Palo Alto. Saw Leland Stanford University. Arrived Fairmont Hotel San Francisco 6:00 p.m. on Saturday August 1 after a hot ride. Jew wedding. Sunday August 2 Church 1st Congregational preacher Dr. Juniper of St. Petersburg, Florida. Saw Missions at Santa Barbara (San Miguel) and at San Jose near San Francisco. Monday Aug. 3 Mother and Malcolm rode ferry to Oakland. I attended Ex. Com. meeting F.R. B. of S. F. Lunch with Gov. Calkins and Mr. Day at Pacific Union Club. Rode through Presidio and Golden Gate Park to Twin Peaks. In evening Mr. and Mrs. Newton came to see us. Sent telegram to Mary about Lucy. Tuesday August 4 Gov. Calkins gave me telegram calling meeting Open Market Committee in Washington for Aug. 11. On Aug. 5 Wednesday I returned car to Hertz Drive Yourself at San Francisco. Total mileage used 1295, total cost \$158.48.

Left by Southern Pacific Overland Limited Wednesday Aug. 5. Arrived 5055 Waterman Saturday August 8 at 8:00 a.m. (Delmar Station).

1932

August 23, Monday. Left at 10:30 a.m. from Wynne's house on Wydown. Three cars, Presley's, Wynne's and mine. My Franklin had a burnt out bearing and left it in Rolla to be fixed going on with two cars. Had 8 sodas at Waynesville, ate lunch, which we took with us, in school yard other side of

Rolla. Arrived Holliday House at 5:00 p.m. Tuesday Aug. 23 took boat ride on lake in morning and afterwards young Dorcas, Malcolm and I went swimming in lake and Presley and Virginia. Tuesday Aug. 23 left Holliday House in afternoon, picked up Franklin at Rolla and arrived at Lucy's in Moselle at 6:30 p.m. where we ate remainder of lunch we had started with helped out by Lucy. Arrived at 5055 Waterman at 9:30 p.m. Fine trip. Present on trip Presley and Virginia and Mary Edwards, Mother, Malcolm and I, Wynne, Dorcas and young Dorcas.

June. Left 5055 Waterman 7:00 a.m. Monday June 12 Mother, Bill and I. Lunch Claypool Hotel at 12:50. Visited Mary and Harold Martin at 4001 on Route 4 Indianapolis stayed from 2:00 p.m. to 2:20 p.m. 6:00 p.m. arrived Neil House Columbus. Left 8:30 a.m. Tuesday. Sent telegram to Malcolm. Steubenville Bridge toll. Huntington July 14 Wednesday Pottsville, Port Jervis. Arr. Peekshill 6:15 p.m. Spent night Forbush Inn. June 15 left Peekshill Inn at 10:10 a.m. Arr. New Haven at 11:00 a.m. Lunch at Hasselbach, Malcolm, Bill, Mother and I. Mother's birthday we ate at Mary's. Friday June 16 went to Yale-Harvard boat race at New London. Yale lost. About 10 p.m. had dinner at New Haven Mother, Malcolm, Walther Newhall and I. Saturday June 17 Malcolm drove us to Yale Club, where we met Bill. We four ate at Frienjie's lunch. Drove over Westchester County Bill showing us estates. At 9:00 p.m. ate dinner at Ridgefield,

Conn. then returned to New Haven. Sunday June 18 for Baccalaureate sermon. Tom Woods called and took supper with us. Bill left for New York at 4:13 p.m. Monday June 19th Mother packed Malcolm at 1513 Pierson. I went to Sheffield Class Day. Mother and I went to Malcolm's Class Day and to Dr. Angell's reception in Art School at 4:00 p.m. Took ride to Mt. Carmel (Sleeping Grant Park). Tuesday June 20 received telegram from Bill saying he could not come on account activity of Stock Market. Mother and I saw Malcolm get his degree. We saw Yale win baseball game from Harvard 5 to 3 also Reunion Class Parade. Bill arrived. Fanny Woods, Francis and twins and Tom's fiancée called at hotel. Wednesday June 21 saw Graduation (Honorary Degrees) form on campus. Closed Malcolm's account at New Haven Bank. Paid Taft Hotel for room 807 for June 15 and 16 @ \$8.00 - \$16.00 and for June 17, 18, 19 and 20 @ \$12.00 - \$48.00. Left New Haven at 1:30 p.m. Ate supper Buzzard's Bay and arrived Hyannis Arms Hotel at 7:30 p.m. Thursday June 22 went to Hyannisport and saw where Mother visited when a girl. Provincetown on tip of Cape Cod. Lunch at Sagamore, Mass. Visited Plymouth Rock. Arrived Portsmouth 6:10 p.m. at Rockingham Hotel. Left Friday June 23 at 8:00 a.m. Lunch Eastland Hotel, Portland, Maine. Had rear right flat tire before reaching Bangor, Maine where we arrived at 4:30 p.m. Saturday June 24 left Bangor Hotel 7:25 a.m. Went through Bar Harbor. Reached Canadian border at Calais, Maine at 2:45 p.m. Spent about 15 minutes at Customs. Arrived St. Johns, New Brunswick at 6:00 p.m.,

8:00 p.m. as town was on Atlantic Day light time. Sunday June 25, went to St. John's and St. Stephen's Pres. Church. Stayed at Admiral Beatty Hotel and saw the Reversing Falls. Monday June 26 went aboard the S. S. Princess Helene with car to cross Bay of Fundy to Digby at 8:30 a.m. Arrived Digby 11:20 a.m. Drove to Sandy Cove and had lunch at ^{Pines} ~~Paris~~ Hotel. Stayed at Grand Hotel, Yarmouth. Left Yarmouth Tuesday June 27 at 8:30 a.m. A.S.T. About 15 miles before reaching Liverpool fog was heavy and Mother and Malcolm got out to recuperate. Arrived Morcey Hotel, Liverpool, N.S. at 12:45 p.m. for lunch. On veranda met a Mr. George S. McClearn who took me over to Branch of Bank of Nova Scotia and introduced me to Mr. Gardner. Arrived Nova Scotia Hotel, Halifax at 6:05 p.m.

Stayed at Nova Scotia Hotel (Canadian Natl. Rys) Left Nova Scotia Hotel (Halifax) Friday June 30 at 9:15 am. Lunch 12:30 a.m. Cornwallis Inn Huntville left 2:00 p.m. arrived ^{Pines} ~~Paris~~ Hotel, Digby, June 30. Saturday July 1 ^{Bill and I} walked over ~~Paris~~ Hotel Golf Course. Left Digby on S. S. Helene at 3:00 p. m. Rough trip but Mother did not get sick. Arrived St. John, N.B. at 5:45 p.m. Spent night at Admiral Beatty Hotel. Sunday July 2 in St. John went to St.

John's and St. Stephen's Pres. Church. Left Monday, July 3, at 8:00 a.m. St. Stephen at 10:15 a.m. Custom officers very pleasant and we cleared by 10:30 a.m. Left Callais, Maine, at that time. Lunch Mathias (New Eastern Hotel). Arrived Bangor, Maine. Spent night at Bangor House. Tuesday July 4 left at 7:00 a.m. Arrived Mt. Madison Hotel at Gorham N.H. went to top of Mt. Washington over toll road. Went through Pinkham's Gap and Crawford's Gap arriving at 5:30 p.m. at St. Johnsbury, Vermont (St. Johnsbury House). Sat on balcony and saw fire workd and fire crackers set off at Fire Engine House aided and abetted by firemen.

Wednesday, July 5. Left St. Johnsbury, Vermont, at 8:00 a.m. Arrived Burlington, Vermont, (Lake Champlain) at 10:00 a.m. Left via Burlington-Port Kent Ferry at 11:00 a.m. Arrived at Keeneville, N. Y. at Green Apple Inn about 12:00 a.m. Had to have a stuck valve fixed and Mother talked to lady who ran inn and found she had taken her honeymoon on Anchor line boat from St. Louis to New Orleans. Arrived Lake Placid Club at 3:30 p.m. Gave Bill \$20.00 to cover his fare to New York as he had to leave.

Thursday, July 6. Spent day at Lake Placid.

Friday, July 7. Mother, Malsolm, and I left at 9:20 a.m. Arrived Ogdensbury, N. Y. at 12:30 p.m. Went to Prescott, Canada, on Prescott-Ogdensbury Ferry (Lewis) arriving 2:00 p.m. Drove up St. Lawrence River to Morrisville, thence to Ottawa arriving 4:00 p.m. Saw Peace Tower and Parliament Buildings and

stayed at Chateau Laurier, Rooms 306 and 308. Boats went through Rideau locks right by our rooms. Raining but walked to Parliament Building and Mother delighted to see every one had an umbrella.

Saturday, July 8. Left Ottawa at 7:25 a.m. Belleville Ontario at 11:50 a.m. Coburg. Arrived at Royal York Hotel, Toronto at 4:40 p.m.

Sunday, July 9. Went to James St. Baptist Church (Br. T. T. Shields). In afternoon drove to Lake Front and sat in Park.

Monday, July 10. Left Toronto, arrived Hamilton, Ont. at 12 m. Lunch Royal Conneough Hotel. Arrived Niagra about 3:00 p.m. General Brock Hotel on Canadian Side. Spent afternoon in Glenn and after supper sat on rim and saw illumination of Falls. ~~Bob~~ Malcolm and I rode across in bucket.

Tuesday, July 11. Lunch Chatham Hotel Wm. Pitt. Arrived Ambassador Bridge Windsor at 2:30 p.m. No trouble with Customs. Arrived Statler Hotel, Detroit at 3:00 p.m. Malcolm and I took walk and saw Detroit Branch, Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago.

Wednesday, July 12. Left Detroit at 8:00 a.m. Kalamazoo for lunch. Arrived Stevens Hotel, Chicago, 4:45 p.m. Women's Convention in Session and could not get rooms until 6:30 p.m. Visited World's Fair at night.

Thursday, July 13. In morning Mother, Malcolm and I visited World's Fair and rode around grounds in Greyhound Sight Seeing bus. Mother and I returned to Hotel at noon. Malcolm

returned from Fair at 2:00 p.m. and at lunch we suddenly decided we had seen enough of the Fair. Left Stevens Hotel at 3:15 p.m. Arrived Madison, Wisconsin at 7:15 p.m. Stopped at Laramie Hotel.

Friday, July 14. Rode around Madison and saw University of Wisconsin. Left Madison at 10:30 a.m. Drove in rain from Plattville, Wis. to Dubuque, Ia. Crossed Miss. River. Arrived Burlington, Ia. at 6:30 p.m. Still in rain. Stayed at Hotel Burlington.

Saturday, July 15. Left at 8:40 a.m. Arrived Hannibal Missouri via Quincy 11:45 a.m. Lunch Mark Twain Hotel. Crossed Quincy Memorial Bridge. Bowling Green, Mo. Arrived 5055 Waterman at 3:30 p.m.

Saturday, July 7. Malcolm came from office and met Mother and me at Delmar and ~~Spring~~ ^{Union} from which point we left at 1:00 p.m. Ten miles before we reached Bowling Green, Missouri, Mother and Bill found the back seat on fire. We pulled it out on the side of the road and Malcolm and Bill got bucket of water from nearby house. Stuffing pretty well burned out but we decided to go on. My left hand burned, but no other casualty. Had car looked over at filling station in Bowling Green and got unguentine for my hand. At 7:30 p.m. ate dinner at Ottumwa, Ia. Tuesday, July 10. Left Mitchell at 8:15 a.m. Went through Chamberlin S. D., Belvedere, S. D. Lunch at Dacotah. Drove through Bad Lands route 40. Soda water at Wall, S. D. Arrived Alex Johnson Hotel, Rapid City, S. D. at 3:15 p.m. Mountain time and spent night.

Wednesday, July 11. Had car gone over and oil changed. Left Rapid City, S.D. at 8:21 a.m. Lunch Gillette, Wyoming. Sodas at Sheridan, Wyoming (Hospital Drug Store) Arrived Billings, Montana (Northern Hotel) at 7:15 p.m.

Thursday, July 12. Malcolm not feeling well. Got pluto water from drug store. Left Billings at 10:40 a.m. Lunch Northern Pacific lunch room. Stopped Pipe Clay Pass on the Divide from Bozeman to Butte. Arrived Butte (Hotel Tinden) at 5:25 p.m. Spent night.

Friday, July 13. Left Butte at 8:25 a.m. Lunch at Palace Hotel, Missoula, Montana, at 11:20 a.m. Soda at Kalispell. Arrived Lake McDonald Hotel, Glacier Park at 5:45 p.m. Mother, Malcolm and I took boat ride on Lake McDonell.

Saturday, July 14. Lunch Lake McDonnell Hotel. Left at 12:40 p.m. Drove over Logan Pass (beautiful). Arrived at Many Glacier's Hotel at 3:40 p.m. Rooms 211-213. Found letter from Lucy.

Sunday, July 15. Went to church service in Hotel. In afternoon walked on trail to Josephine Lake.

Monday, July 16. Mother and I walked to Falls on lake near hotel. Bill, Malcolm and I took launch over Swift Current Lake, then walked to Josephine Lake, then walked to Grimwell Lake.

Tuesday, July 17. Left Many Glacier's Hotel at 7:50 a.m. Lunch at Macleod(?) Arrived Calgary at 12:45 p.m. Arrived Banff Springs Hotel at 4:40 p.m. No trouble crossing into Canada.

Wednesday, July 18. Rooms 444-446 Banff Springs Hotel. Left at 10:35 a.m. Arrived Lake Louise about 2:15 p.m. Lake Louise Hotel room 462-460. Bill rowed Mother, Malcolm and me across Lake Louise and we walked up the trail to the Glaciers. Spent night at Lake Louise.

Thursday, July 19. Left Lake Louise at 9:30 a.m. Arrived at Field at 10:30 a.m. Mileage St. Louis to Fields 2426 miles. Turned around at Fields and arrived Lake Louise for lunch, Chateau Lake Louise. Left at 1:55 p.m. Arrived at Banff at 3:30 p.m. Bill and I took walk over part of golf links to Bow Falls.

Friday, July 20. Malcolm had to leave to get back to office as vacation was over. We drove him to train at Banff, then we left at 2:25 p.m. for Calgary where we arrived at 4:30 p.m. Malcolm's train did not arrive until 5:20 p.m. We waited for it at station and saw him for about twenty minutes. We then got rooms 555 and 553 at Pallister Hotel and spent night.

Saturday, July 21. Left Calgary in morning and got

puncture in left rear tire about 60 miles from Calgary. Man working on road came up to help and said he came from Palmira, Mo. Reached Canadian border at 1:00 p.m. Arrived Many Glacier's Hotel at 1:35 p.m. Room 189 for Mother and Me, 109 for Bill. Found Mr. and Mrs. Carl Myers and Mrs. Vesper at hotel.

Sunday, July 22. Mother, Bill and I took walk to Cracker Lake.

Monday, July 23. Left Many Glacier's Hotel at 9:30 a.m. after getting beyond the Ranger Station and about five miles from hotel we turned back as I wanted to buy a carved wooden mountain goat to give to Mother. ^{Left hat forgotten} Left Many Glaciers second time at 10:00 a.m. Lunch at Dispurger Montana at Angell's Inn evidently run by widow of World War I. She had an assortment of dolls lying around. We got some not very inviting egg sandwiches and coffee. The widow not very careful in her dress, the surroundings rather weird and wild. Arrived at Great Falls, Montana, Park Hotel at 3:15 p.m. It was a holiday celebrating Commercial Day.

Tuesday, July 24. After having car gone over and oil changed left Great Falls at 8:25 a.m. Raining hard and road slick and difficult. Arrived Lewistown, Mont. at 12:25 p.m. and had lunch at Fergus House. Left Lewistown at 1:30 p.m. At a town called Round Up caught up again with a crowd touring in two trucks calling themselves "Black Hawk Hikes" from Moline and Rock Island, Ill, and Davenport, Iowa. Arrived at Billings, Montana, Northern Hotel, at 5:15 p.m. after hard trip over slippery road most of the way in so deserted a country it invited hold ups. In fact the papers recorded one soon after our

passage. Mileage Great Falls to Billings 252.

Wednesday, July 25. Had car washed. Left Billings at 8:50 a.m. Arrived Sheridan, Wyoming 12:15 p.m. where we ate lunch. Left Sheridan at 1:10 p.m. Went through Lavoie Wyoming (Tea ~~Pot~~ Dome). Arrived Casper, Wyoming, Henning Hotel at 5:00 p.m. Had trouble locating Carneal Spears, who is listed as "T. C. Spears". He came to hotel and we had a nice visit with him the morning of July 26.

Thursday, July 26. Left Caspar, Wyoming at 9:25 a.m. Lunch Golden Gate Cafe at Torrington at 12:40 p.m. Arrived at Scottsbluff, Nebraska at 2:15 p.m. New Lincoln Hotel. Sent telegram to Henning Hotel at Casper, Wyoming. Do not remember why. Rode out of town a little way and Mother, Bill and I sat on bench at foot of Scottsbluff at 4:40 p.m. At night we found two men in hoods and gowns standing with folded arms on each corner of the town and then a flaming cross appeared on Scottsbluff. We heard music and Bill and I went to High School where a band concert was being given on lawn. Later Bill and I went to a burro soft ball game.

Friday, July 27. Left Scottsbluff at 8:30 a.m. Lunch at Pawnee Hotel at North Platte; did not think much of hotel so drove on arriving at Kearney's, Nebraska, stopped at Fort Kearney Hotel at 4:15 p.m. Mt. time, 5:15 p.m. C.S.T. Time changed at North Platte.

Saturday, July 28. Left Kearney at 8:40 a.m. Lunch Pathfinder Hotel Fremont. Left Fremont 2:15 p.m. Arrived Omaha at 3:00 p.m. Day's run 203 miles. Sent telegram to Malcolm.

Sunday, July 29. Went to 1st Methodist Episcopal

Church, Omaha. Stayed at Fontenelle Hotel.

Monday, July 30. Left Omaha at 8:50 a.m. Lunch Chariton, Iowa 12:15 p.m. Arrived Ottumwa, Ia. at 2:15 p.m. Arrived Keokuk, Ia. (Iowa Hotel) at 4:15 p.m. Day's run 303 miles. Met Huey with whom I once worked at Miss. Valley Trust.

Tuesday, July 31. Went to see locks at Keokuk. Left Keokuk at 9:00 a.m. Drove through Bowling Green, Mo., and scene of our fire going out. Arrived St. Charles, Mo. at 12:45 p.m. and had lunch at St. Charles Hotel. Arrived 5055 Waterman at 1:55 p.m. Day's run 186. Total mileage for trip St. Louis to Banff, Lake Louise and Field and return 4732 miles.

1935

Virginia Beach and Sea Bright, N.J.

Saturday, July 20. Malcolm met Mother and me after closing time of his office, at parking place at Federal Reserve Bank and we left at 12:40 p.m. Crossed Eads Bridge and out of Louisville the New Albany Bridge. Arrived Louisville, Ky. at 7:40 p.m. Ate dinner at Brown Hotel and left at 8:35 p.m. Arrived at Lexington 11:20 p.m. Mileage 360 miles. Convention American Legion and had trouble getting rooms 617 and 618 at Lafayette Hotel. Clerk whom I did not know recognized the Kentucky family connection and some how or other arranged rooms.

Sunday, July 21. Raining so took taxi to my boyhood church the 1st Presbyterian. In afternoon visited Aunt Kate ~~S~~hears and Dr. and Miss Kate Clark. Visited cemetery. American Legion parade at night. Plenty of noise.

Monday, July 22. Left Lexington at 6:40 a.m. Went

through Winchester, Ashland over bridge to West Virginia. Had lunch at Daniel Boone Hotel. Drove through Clifton Forge and arrived at Dutch Inn, Lexington, Virginia, at 7:45 p.m. Mileage Lexington, Kentucky to Lexington, Virginia, 393. The road winding and slow, hard driving.

Tuesday, July 23. Had a short visit with Dr. and Mrs. Gaines, Mr. Mattingly and Hale Houston. Left Lexington, Virginia, at 9:45 a.m. Arrived Richmond at 1:10 p.m. Lunch at John Marshall Hotel. *Went through Williamsburg & Jamestown* Took Hampton Old Point Ferry to Norfolk where we arrived at 5:00 p.m. From there drove to Cavalier Hotel arriving at 6:15 p.m.

Wednesday, July 24. Bill had suggested that we try Peninsula Hotel at Sea Bright, N. J. so sent telegram to him and to Hotel. Malcolm and I went swimming.

Thursday, July 25. Malcolm and I drove to Norfolk and went swimming later.

Friday, July 26. Left Cavalier Hotel 6:00 a.m. Everybody in Hotel asleep. Had to get car out of garage and wait on ourselves. Fortunately had paid hotel bill night before as could not find clerk. Drove to Cape Charles Ferry landing. Ate breakfast on Ferry Boat. Arrived at Dover, Delaware, via *Cape Henry* ~~fake~~ Charles, at 12:30 p.m. Pleasant ride on Ferry. Lunch Duvall House, Dover. At Newcastle took ferry over Delaware River to Pennsville. Arrived Peninsula Hotel at 6:15 p.m. and Bill got off train from New York as we drove up. Our rooms 364-365.

Saturday, July 27. Mother, Bill, Malcolm and I drove

down beach road to Spring Lake. Later drove to Atlantic Highland and had a wonderful view of Sandy Hook with New York City in background.

Sunday, July 28. We four drove to Auditorium in Ocean Grove and heard Dr. Sizyo preach. We took Bill to Atlantic Highlands where at 5:30 p.m. he got boat for New York.

Monday, July 29. I was sick and did not go to lunch. Bill arrived about 6:30 p.m., took dinner with us and returned to New York.

Tuesday, July 30. Drove to Atlantic Highlands and over Rumson Road to Red Bank. Bill could not come over. Rented bath house and Malcolm and I went in ocean in morning and afternoon.

Wednesday, July 31. Swimming in morning. Met Bill at train. He took dinner with us and returned to New York.

Thursday, August 1. Left at 9:15 a.m. Arrived Ocean City, New Jersey, at 12:15 p.m. for lunch at Hascom Hotel. Drove around and saw building at 3rd and Corinthian where we stayed one summer with Flora, etc. Then drove to Atlantic City and arrived 2:15 p.m. Visited Mrs. Sneed at Chalfont and met Mrs. McCorkle who used to go to Charlevoix. Left Atlantic City at 3:15 p.m. and arrived Seabright at 6:15 p.m. for dinner.

Friday, August 2. Telegram from Bill saying he could not come over. Went swimming.

Saturday, August 3. Weather cloudy and cold. Bill arrived about 3:00 p.m. We drove around Rumson before dinner. Drove Bill to boat at Atlantic Highlands where he left at 10:15 p.m.

Sunday, August 4. Drove to Auditorium Ocean Grove and heard Robert E. Speer. There met Jim Wilson, a cousin of Miss Jennie Greenwood, his wife and three children. Bill came for dinner and Malcolm drove him to Atlantic Highlands so he could get 5:40 p.m. boat for New York. Stormy and raining very hard.

Monday, August 5. Changed rooms 364-365 for room 166 first floor as Malcolm had started on his way home as his vacation was over. Room \$84.00 per week.

Tuesday, August 6. Mother and I drove to Atlantic Highlands to meet Bill's boat. Missed him and found him sitting on Hotel porch. Drove Bill to catch 10:10 p.m. boat for New York.

Wednesday, August 7. Cold northeast wind, water rough.

Thursday, August 8. Left at 11:00 a.m. and Mother and I drove to Asbury Park. Drove to meet Bill. Missed him and found him on hotel porch. Took Bill to catch 10:00 p.m. boat to New York.

Friday, August 9. Too rough and cold for swimming. Took walk up Rumson Road.

Saturday, August 10. Mother and I drove to Highland, Water Witch and again saw the Marine View of Sandy Hook.

Sunday, August 11. Mother and I never found the Rumson Pres. Church. Got lost, finally went to Embury M. E. Church in Little River, N. J., a suburb of Rumson.

Monday, August 12. Had car gone over oiled and greased. Bill came over for dinner and I took him to 10:10 p.m. boat.

Tuesday, August 13. Mother and I left Sea Bright at 8:35 a.m. Arrived Pennsville 11:55 a.m. a 20 minute ride on ferry to New Castle, Delaware. Lunch Old State House Tea Room. Weather very hot. Left New Castle at 12:30 p.m. Arrived Baltimore at 2:30 p.m. Frederick, Md. 4:30 p.m. Cumberland, Md. 6:45 p.m. Races were on and could not get room at Fort Cumberland, Hotel, but got one at Algonquin Hotel. So hot Mother and I slept with our room door open to corridor.

Wednesday, August 14. Left Cumberland at 8:30 a.m. Wheeling, W. Va., 12:30 p.m. Lunch McClure Hotel. Left Wheeling at 2:10 p.m. Saw evidence of recent flood between Cambridge and Zanesville, but got through easily as only short distance of road still under repair. Soda at Zanesville. Arrived Columbus, Ohio, Neil House, at 6:15 p.m. Carburetor flooded just in outskirts of Columbus, but succeeded in going on to hotel.

Thursday, August 15. Left Neil House Columbus at 8:30 a.m. after having carburetor adjusted at garage. Went through Richmond and after detour arrived Indianapolis 1:00 p.m. Lunch Claypool Hotel. Left Indianapolis at 2:15 p.m. Arrived Terre Haute, Ind. (Hotel Denning) at 4:00 p.m. Found a comfortable room so stopped for night. Mileage 267 miles from Columbus.

Friday, August 16. Left Terre Haute 8:15 a.m. Took a walk at Vandalia, Ill. Arrived Greenville 11:00 a.m. and ate lunch. Left Greenville at 11:45 a.m. Arrived St. Louis at 1:20 p.m.

1936

New England via New York to Sea Bright

Friday, July 3. Mother, Malcolm and I left St. Louis by New York Central for New York City and we took Buick with us via train. Presley Edwards took us to train. We had a compartment and one lower leaving in the morning.

Saturday, July 4. New York Central Station Agent and Bill met us at New York. We went to Biltmore Hotel but had had breakfast on train. We ate dinner at Schaffs. The four of us took bus ride downtown then up to 43rd Street.

Sunday, July 5. Went to Broadway Presbyterian Church and met one of the Johnson girls from St. Louis who was studying at Columbia. Used subway to and from church.

Monday, July 6. Used subway to Times Square and returned by taxi. Could not get any trace of Buick that had come on train.

Tuesday, July 7. During breakfast at Biltmore met Mr. Upthegrove. Finally located Buick at 59th St. N. Y. Central Station. It was badly damaged, differential broken etc and opera glasses etc taken from glove compartment. Went to N. Y. Central general offices and saw W. F. Cunningham, Ass't General Freight Claim Agent. After dinner we took bus ride to Fort Tyron.

Wednesday, July 8. Buick taken to Gliffen Buick Corp. 561 West 55th St. N. Y. City for repair. They said it would take several days to repair car so we took our baggage out of

car and took it to Sandy Hook dock. Checked out of Hotel at 11:45 a.m. Boarded Steamer "Sandy Hook". Malcolm and I ate lunch on boat but Mother would not eat. Arrived Sea Bright at 3:00 p.m. Malcolm and I went swimming. Mother's weight 104 pounds.

Thursday, July 9. Turned hot. Swimming good.

Friday, July 10. Very hot. Rooms 166 and 161.

Saturday, July 11. Malcolm left Sea Bright early to get Buick in New York as they reported it was fixed. He paid Glidden Buick Corporation \$173.04 which later was refunded by the N. Y. Central. He had lunch with Bill then he and Bill drove car to Sea Bright arriving about 4:00 p.m. We all then drove to Atlantic Highlands and Rumson.

Sunday, July 12. Drove to Ocean Grove for services. Drove Bill and Burton Carson to Atlantic Highlands to catch boat for N. Y.

Monday, July 13. Hindenburg Zeplin flew over our heads about 7:30 a.m. This was zeplin that later exploded at Lakehurst. We left Sea Bright at 8:30 a.m. going through Hudson Tube arriving N. Y. City about 10:30 a.m. Lunch Leo's Inn Patchogue, Long Island. Went through Forest Hills, L. I. to Montauk Point where we, including car, took boat to New London. Arrived 6:30 p.m. Mochian Hotel, New London.

Tuesday, July 14. Left New London 8:30 a.m. Drove through Hartford, Conn. 10:00 a.m. Springfield, Mass. 11:00 a.m. Holyoke College at South Hadley, Mass. Ate lunch at Lord Jeffrey Inn Amherst, Mass. Saw Amherst College then Smith College at Northampton, Mass. Saw Jonathan Edward's church and

town where Coolidge lived. Went through Greenfield, Mass.,
Bottleboro, Vt., Bellow Falls, Vt., White River Junction, Vt.,
arrived in evening at Hanover Inn, Hanover, New Hampshire and
saw Dartmouth College.

Wednesday, July 15. Left Hanover Inn at 9:40 a.m.
Bought gas at Wolfboro, N. H. Lunch at Allen A. restaurant

6:00 p.m. Sat on lawn overlooking the Hudson. View beautiful.

Friday, July 17. Left West Point 8:30 a.m. Arrived
Princeton, N. J. 12:20 p.m. Lunch Princeton Inn. Arrived Sea

Tuesday, June 22. Left Dallas 8:05 a.m. Lunch at Austin 12:30 p.m. Arrived San Antonio 3:25 p.m. Saw Alamo and went to Saint Anthony Hotel.

Wednesday, June 23. Left San Antonio at 8:10 a.m. Arrived at Laredo at 11:00 a.m. Visited Chas. Mumm, AAA representative who was very helpful about custom requirements etc. Changed \$100.00 for 357 pesos. Spent about an hour getting information. Lunch Hotel Plaza, Laredo. Arrived at Customs at 12:50 p.m. and got through at 1:45 p.m. Needed four identification cards @ \$3.50 or \$15.50 and auto permit \$3.00. Arrived at Gran Hotel, Encina, Monterrey at 4:30 p.m. Gas was in liters not gallons.

Thursday, June 24. Left Monterrey at 8:05 a.m. Arrived at Victoria 12:10 p.m. where we ate lunch at El Patio

which we had some trouble locating. Arrived Casa Grande, Valles, at 5:00 p.m. Dinner at Casa Grande.

Friday, June 25. Left Valles 8:10 a.m. Picked up small Mexican near Zimepan and rode him to Tasquillen. Lunch at Simpsons in Tasquillon. Arrived at Police Barrier on outskirts of Mexico City at 5:50 p.m. Here got a driver guide and arrived at Hotel Reforma at 6:30 p.m. Total mileage to Mexico City 1958 miles. Rooms in Reforma 610-612.

Saturday, June 26. Hired a guide Paul Gomez Prieto who could drive car and he saved us a good deal of time going places. We visited Chapultepec, Cathedral, Thieves Market, Flower Market and Guadalupe Shrine.

Sunday, June 27. Between downpours went to Hotel Geneva and took taxi back to Reforma. As dinner at Hotel was too much ate in Reforma Drug store. Bill was slightly upset. Bill keeping a check on "Little Rainy Season."

Monday, June 28. Our driver guide had car at hotel at 9:00 a.m. which he seemed to think was unusually early and we went to La Viga Canal and Xochimilco. Took boat ride, our driver asking if he could go along. Had our pictures taken and boatman was evidently asking outrageous fees which our driver objected to our paying. After this I let him pay where payment seemed necessary. We then went to see Calender Stone etc. at National Museum and returned to Reforma at 1:15 p.m. We had Ed Miller and his wife for dinner but though plenty was served we were not in very good condition to eat.

Tuesday, June 29. Our ^{driver-guide} reported at 9:15 a.m. and we ^{with} ~~drove~~ to Pyramids of Sun, Juan Teotihuacan, Temple of ~~Inetzalecatt~~, ^{Metzcalcatt}

Pyramid of Moon and went in and Aztec Building. Also went through ruins of Convent of Acolman. Returned to Reforma at 1:25 p.m. before the afternoon shower. In evening Bill, Malcolm and I went to Hai Lai game.

Wednesday, June 30. Our driver-guide no longer needed. We left Mexico City at 9:55 a.m. Arrived Hotel de la Sylvia 12 noon. Bought slippers at Public Square in Cuernavaca. Place greatly changed since Mother and I were there in 1905 on honeymoon. Not near as attractive. Hotel we stayed in then now a storage house. Charlton Messick arrived about 5:15 p.m. from his place of work Zacatopic, and we all drove to Astoria Hotel recommended by him where we had dinner at 8:00 p.m. He stayed all night as our guest at Hotel de la Silva.

Thursday, July 1. We visited the Borda Gardens, not near as attractive as when Mother and I were there in 1905. Also viewed the Diego frescos in Cortes' first palace now a public building. Left Cuernavaca at 1:15 p.m. Drove 56 miles to Taxco and stopped at La Borda Hotel recommended by Mr. Marstinez of the Reforma who gave me a card to Mr. Dispray, Manager. Beautiful drive and Hotel beautifully situated on a high hill just out of but in sight of the town. There was a religious parade in the village.

Friday, July 2. Bought obsidian indian mask copied from Pyramid for Malcolm to be made into a watch fob. Left Taxco at 12:15 p.m. Arrived Mexico City at 4:35 p.m. Vacation of Malcolm over and he left by train at 10:00 p.m.

Saturday, July 3. Took taxi to Zocalo (public square) Mother, Bill and I. Visited book store. Near Zocalo found name

"Pelacio" on building which was a hotel, the only one we could find with a room with bath when Mother and I were there in 1905. It seemed very much of a joint and I was afraid to let Mother do much more than look in. We walked to the Alameda and sat on a bench there for a while and took taxi to Reforma. There was a tea dance at hotel. We three went to Sanborns for dinner. Took taxi to Liberal Arts Building for a quick visit, then a taxi to Reforma.

Sunday, July 4. Stayed around hotel. "Little rainy season."

Monday, July 5. Left Mexico City at 9:15 a.m. Arrived Taxco at 1:15 p.m. Stopped at Borda Hotel rooms 405-406 which had small balconies from which we could look at the mountains and also see what was going on in village. Met Mr. and Mrs. Moreno and Mr. and Mrs. Ashcraft and their daughter Bettie all from St. Louis. After dinner Bill read out loud from "Viva Mexico". Next to hotel was a working silver mine.

Tuesday, July 6. Had breakfast at 6:10 a.m. and drove to Iguala, which was a typical tropical city where they were selling parrots on the streets. Did not go to Acapulco, which is on the coast as some returning tourists I met at filling station said part of the road was bad and would be difficult for a car as large as ours. We had a Buick Limited. Returned to Taxco where we arrived about 1:30 p.m. About 4:00 p.m. Mother, Bill and I walked up hill near Hotel Borda to a shrine on top of hill, erected as far as we could make out inscription to five missionaries who had arrived there in 1778.

We sat on steps going up to shrine and talked to five boys between the ages of 6 and 12 who were flying kites. While we were there two women, a small boy and girl brought flowers and knelt before the shrine. Returned to Borda Hotel at 6:00 p.m.

Wednesday, July 7. We visited village and bought a lantern for Lucy.

Thursday, July 8. In morning Bill started out to climb mountain. The foliage was thick and he was gone so long we feared he was lost as he could easily have been. Mother stayed at hotel and I walked to village and climbed the tower of Borda Cathedral.

Friday, July 9. Drove to plaza at Taxco and bought a few small breast pins (silver). Had to watch car carefully as small boys were stealing hub caps etc at every chance, then selling them back saying they had found them. Mother in afternoon stayed on her balcony and Bill and I walked up the hill to the shrine.

Saturday, July 10. Had early breakfast (5:10 a.m.) and left Hotel de la Borda, near which a silver mine was in operation, at 8:50 a.m. Arrived Mexico City at 12:25 p.m. Ate our lunch at Reforma and our dinner at drug store.

Sunday, July 11. Stayed all day, except for short walks between showers, at Reforma. Took taxi to 159 Chilpancingo to see Lucy Chambers, but she had not arrived.

Monday, July 12. Left Reforma Hotel, Mexico City, at 8:30 a.m. very early for hotel and garage. Lunch at Simpson at Zimapan. Arrived Casa Grande at 5:40 p.m. (Valles)

luckily ahead of other cars and got room 586. Many could not get rooms. Our dinner was very bad.

Tuesday, July 13. Left Valles (Casa Grande) at 7:45 a.m. Arrived Victoria at 10:45 a.m., lunch at El Patio. Arrived at Monterrey (Hotel Gran Encira) at 3:15 p.m. Dinner at Sanborns, where we found something we could eat.

Wednesday, July 14. Left Monterrey at 8:15 a.m. Arrived Customs at ~~Nuevo~~ Laredo at 1:10 a.m. and was through at 1:20 a.m. Saw Mr. Mumm at Laredo. U.S.A., received two letters from Federal Reserve Bank and changed 181.50 pesos for \$50.27. Left Laredo at 12:35 p.m. Arrived San Antonio St. Anthony Hotel at 3:45 p.m. Sent telegrams to Malcolm and Grace and Baker Hotel, Dallas.

Thursday, July 15. Left San Antonio at 8:05 a.m. Lunch at 12 noon at Hotel Roosevelt, Waco. Left Waco at 1:00 p.m. arrived at Baker Hotel, Dallas at 3:00 p.m. Bill and I went to Exposition and saw opening ceremonies of Pan American games followed by soccer football between Argentina and U. S.

Friday, July 16. Left Dallas at 7:55 a.m. Arrived Oklahoma City at 12:50 p.m. Had lunch at Biltmore Hotel. Arrived Tulsa at 4:45 p.m. and seeing Adams Hotel was advertising air conditioned rooms went there instead of to Mayo Hotel.

Saturday, July 17. Left Tulsa at 8:15 a.m. Arrived at Joplin, Mo. 11:25 a.m. Springfield 1:10 p.m. where we ate lunch at Colonial Hotel. Left at 2:05 p.m. Arrived at Rolla Mo. at 4:45 p.m. Left hat at Springfield or Tulsa.

There was a bad storm during the night.

Sunday, July 18. Went to Baptist Church in Rolla, finding that Presbyterian Church only had Sunday School and no church service. Met Mr. Chamberlain, formerly of St. Louis. In afternoon Mr. Chamberlain and Harold (I think his son) took Bill and me to a sulphur mine and a clay pit where they were getting out dispara (?) and then to the Meramac Spring near St. James. Mr. Chamberlain, Harold and his wife and 5½ year old son took dinner with us at hotel.

Monday, July 11. Left Cincinnati at 8:00 a.m. Lunch at Morrisfield. Arrived Oil City which Malcolm wanted to visit 6:45 p.m. Stayed at Arlington Hotel.

Saturday, July 16. We met Bill at 1:20 p.m. boat. In morning Malcolm and I went in water and in afternoon all three went in. After dinner Bill, Malcolm and I went to Midget races at Long Beach.

Saturday, July 30. Tried to hire boat but none available. Took Mr. and Mrs. Holden riding. Bill came on 3:30 p.m. boat. I went in ocean in morning, Bill and I in afternoon.

Sunday, July 31. Drove to Ocean Grove and heard a modernistic sermon by Bishop Paul B. Kern. Bill left on 5:30 p.m. boat.

Monday, August 1. I went swimming in morning. At lunch Rebecca received telegram relayed by Miss Brauroth saying Leonora Woods passed away peacefully on July 29. Funeral August 1. Sent telegram to Matt in St. Louis and Mary Woods at New Orleans. Sent Buick to Red Bank for going over and greasing.

Tuesday, August 2. Visited Wm. V. Smith, Cashier Sea Bright National Bank. Bill telephoned at 1:30 p.m. and came over on 5:20 p.m. boat and returned on the 10:10 p.m. boat. Mother received letters from Malcolm, Lucy and Matt. Swimming in afternoon.

Wednesday, August 3. Holdens left for Spring Lake. I went swimming.

Thursday, August 4. Sitting around and swimming for me. Could never get Mother to go in.

Friday, August 5. Daisy Berryman called up asking us to spend day at Springlake. Could not go.

Saturday, August 6. Raining but I went in ocean in afternoon. Bill arrived on 6:30 p.m. boat.

Sunday, August 7. We three went to 1st Baptist Church, Grand and 3rd Avenue, Asbury Park. Bill left on 5:55 p.m. boat.

Wednesday, August 10. Left Chambersburg at 8:05 a.m. daylight saving time. Lunch Penn Albert Hotel, Greensburg, Pa., at 11:50 a.m. after going through Summit. Arrived at Hotel Berwick, Wheeling, West Virginia, 4:55 p.m.

Thursday, August 11. Left Wheeling about 9:00 a.m. Lunch Shawnee Hotel, Springfield, Ohio, 11:50 a.m. Very good. Drove through Richmond, Indiana and arrived at Claypool Hotel, Indianapolis, 3:30 p.m.

Friday, August 12. Left Indianapolis at 7:20 a.m. Arrived at Terre Haute, where Mother and I sat on bench in Park at 9:05 a.m. Lunch at Benwood Hotel, Effingham, Ill. at 10:50 a.m. Came into St. Louis over 140 to 66 and over Chain of Rocks Bridge. Arrived at 5055 Waterman at 2:45 p.m. Mileage Sea Bright to St. Louis 1003. Round trip 3148 miles over route

Saturday, July 15. Mother, Malcolm, and I left via Wabash and Union Pacific. Sister and Felix were at train.

Sunday, July 16. On account of a burned out bridge we made little or no progress during night. In morning were still at Denver. Cars were crowded and dining service disrupted. I succeeded in having breakfast for us three brought to our drawing room, as we could never have gotten in diner. Things were better and we succeeded in getting dinner in diner but in large measure food had given out and we had to take what we could get. Mrs. Jos. Lewis, Mrs. Lockwood Hill and Mrs. Taylor on train and we all gathered in our drawing room and had quite a talk fest. Going through the train I found Martha Bugbee (daughter of Ralph) and a Miss Fitzpatrick. Col. Green of Cotton Belt and Mrs. Green were also on train.

Monday, July 17. New diner put on at Ogden and we got a good lunch.

Tuesday, July 18. Col. and Mrs. Green, Mrs. Lewis, Mrs. Taylor, Mother, Malcolm and I on deck of ferry and view of San Francisco Bay in morning beautiful. We went to Mark Hopkins Hotel, where Mr. Day had engaged rooms for us. When we secured rooms (hotel was crowded on account of Exposition)

Malcolm and I went to Hertz Drive Yourself at 175 Turk St. and got a chevrolet which we had arranged for from St. Louis. We then got Mother and we drove to Presidio and along beach. We rode Ferry about 2:30 p.m. to World's Fair. Ate dinner at Manila Inn on Exposition Grounds.

Wednesday, July 19. Left San Francisco at 8:27 a.m. Went out over Golden Gate Toll bridge. Stopped at Eureka for night.

Thursday, July 20. Left Eureka and arrived at Grant's Pass at 12:50 p.m. Lunch there at Redwood Hotel. Arrived at Crater Lake Inn at 5:55 p.m. Beautiful. Here the chipmunks were tame and came to us as we sat on hotel veranda.

Friday, July 21. Left Crater Lake at 10:00 a.m. Arrived at Pilot Butte at 12:20 p.m. Ate lunch Pilot Butte Inn. Arrived Dallas on Columbia River 5:00 p.m. Drove on to Hood River and arrived at Columbia Gorge Hotel near there at 6:00 p.m.

Saturday, July 22. Left Columbia Gorge Hotel at 8:30 a.m. Arrived Portland at 10:00 a.m. Lunch at Longview, Washington. Arrived at Paradise Inn, Mt. Ranier, about 4:40 p.m. Went to lecture in Guidehouse and were entertained by a solo on mouth harp.

Sunday, July 23. Malcolm and I walked about 1000 feet up Mt. Ranier in snow. Big Sunday crowd from Seattle and Tacoma.

Monday, July 24. Mother, Malcolm and I took a short walk to Lodge of Paradise Valley. Left Paradise Inn at 1:30 p.m. One of the waitresses was from Missouri about 20

miles north of St. Louis. Arrived Olympia Hotel, Seattle, at 4:30 p.m. Fleet in harbor and town decorated. Here we gave up the Hertz Chevrolet and engaged rooms on boat to Vancouver and Victoria, B. C. and return to Seattle.

Tuesday, July 25. About 11:30 a.m. paid Hertz for use of car for 1265 miles, \$128.40 or 11.26½ cents a mile including gasoline and storage along the way. Malcolm and I took ferry over ^{Puget}~~Boe~~ Sound to Bamberton. Left Seattle at 11:15 p.m. on boat Princess Margaret.

Wednesday, July 26. We got off at Vancouver and took sight-seeing ride. Malcolm suffering from time spent on sea. Left Vancouver at 11:30 a.m. None of us ate lunch on boat. No rooms available at Empress Hotel, Victoria, until 5:30 p.m. Hotel clerk not accomodating and had to be forced. They were serving High Tea, so mother and I got something to eat. Malcolm still not feeling like eating.

Thursday, July 27. Took ride around Victoria, visited Bonchert's Garden, Oak Log, etc. Left Victoria on boat Princess Margaret at 5:30 p.m. Arrived at Seattle at 9:00 p.m. Dinner at 9:30 p.m. at station lunch room. A ship had just arrived from Japan and we saw them get off. Big crowd in station and had to stand in line to get accomodations.

Friday, July 28. Mother and Malcolm had finished breakfast on train before I got up. Mother did not want lunch but Malcolm and I ate. Arrived at Lake McDonald about 5:30 p.m. and Malcolm stayed on train as his vacation over and he had to get to St. Louis. Waived goodbye to him at Belton about 5:00 p.m. Mother and I spent night at Lake McDonald Hotel.

Saturday, July 29. Mother and I left Lake McDonald in bus at 8:30 a.m. We went over Logan Pass and arrived at Many Glacier Hotel at 11:45 a.m. Mother's new suit case carried dressed in perfect shape.

Sunday, July 30. Went to Protestant services in morning. Telegram from Bill to Mother arrived 4:00 p.m.

Monday, July 31. Very high wind all day.

Tuesday, August 1. Wind stopped blowing. Mother and I took over an hour's walk on Swift Current Trail in the morning. At 2:15 p.m. saw fire drill at hotel. In afternoon while I was walking on one of the trails saw smoke ^{from a forest fire} and finding an automobile with a bucket, filled it at a small stream and was pouring water on fire before the Rangers and boys from nearby CCC Camp arrived. We soon got it under control. At lecture on Glacier Park at 8:15 p.m. Someone came in and announced that two grizzly bears could be seen from the porch. It broke up the lecture as entire audience went to see the bears.

Wednesday, August 2. We took boat trip ^{on} to Swift Current and Josephine Lake to Grinnell Glacier.

Thursday, August 3. We took walk so I could show Mother where I had discovered forest fire. Mother's nap disturbed about 3:30 p.m. by management who wanted to change springs on bed. Later Burlington Tour party arrived. Very noisy and disturbing. The hotel more like a road house than a decent hotel. Management very inferior to that ~~at~~ when we were there before. A Mr. Ellis was manager.

Friday, August 4. Mother and I took walk to Swift Current Falls.

Saturday, August 5. Left Many Glacier's hotel at 9:50 a.m. and by bus arrived at Price of Wales Hotel at 11:30 a.m. Walked to village of Waterton and took taxi back. A Mr. and Mrs. Dobelbrower from Lafayette, Ind., who were touring

in a DeSoto car introduced themselves.

Sunday, August 6. It rained all night and we saw snow falling on the nearby mountains in the morning. Rebecca wrote birthday letter to Matt. In evening met a Miss Cook and a Mrs. Davis, wife of a vice-president of the C. & O. also a lady from Chicago.

Monday, August 7. We took launch and rode across Waterton Lake to Goats Haunts, in the United States. The boundary divides this lake in two. After lunch I walked down trail to Waterton.

Tuesday, August 8. Received letter from Miss Brauroth inclosing F.R.B. statements. Mother and I walked down trail in front of hotel to Waterton. At dinner was handed card from Mr. and Mrs. Swenson saying they were sorry not to see us before they left. Mr. Swenson was professor of Government at New York University. Entire afternoon cold and disagreeable and heavy rain .

Wednesday, August 9. Mother and I took walk and I ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ rescued her from horses. We took another walk in afternoon. We saw a stag swim an arm of Waterton Lake.

Thursday, August 10. Mother received letter from Malcolm. We took drive to Cameron Lake about 25 miles round trip. On this trip saw mountain sheep jump from road and leap up the mountain. We saw the Northern lights. There was a basket of fruit and flowers placed in Mother's room by the management.

Friday, August 11. In afternoon I walked around the swimming lake.

Saturday, August 12. At 8:30 a.m. we took bus for Glacier Park Hotel. On the way we saw a fawn, a small black bear, several pheasants and grouse. Arrived Glacier Park Hotel at 12:10 p.m. and ate lunch there. At 2:00 p.m. took bus to Two Medicine Lake. Mother and I walked to Frick Falls during a launch ride on the lake. Returned to Glacier Park Hotel at 5:00 p.m.

Sunday, August 13. Met a Mr. Norris and his wife who were with us in bus on ride from Prince of Wales Hotel. He is expert chemist in charge of Graduate Work at M.I.T. There was some kind of Indian pow-wow followed by a protestant service. We did not go.

Monday, August 14. Mother and I visited Indian Camp and the Fish Hatchery and saw fish come from the eggs. I took a long walk through camp, cottages, golf course and grounds where there was a totem pole. We left Glacier Park at 7:00 p.m. on second section of Empire Builder. We ate dinner on train.

Tuesday, August 15. On train.

Wednesday, August 16. Arrived at Chicago early at Dearborn Station. Mother and I walked to park in front of Stevens Hotel and enjoyed sitting there. We left Chicago via Wabash at 11:33 a.m. In afternoon on arrival at 5055 Waterman Grace met us at door. Cost of trip \$1,066.00.

Saturday, June 29. Malcolm, Mother and I left St. Louis at 1:05 p.m. Drove through Urbana (University of Illinois)

lunch at Kankakee. Lost hat. Arrived South Bend, Indiana, at 11:15 p.m. Weather good and we had an enjoyable day. Stayed at Hoffman Hotel.

Sunday, June 30. Think we drove around Notre Dame University.

Monday, July 1. Left South Bend at 7:50 a.m. Arrived at Grand Rapids, Michigan, at 12:35 p.m. Where we had lunch. Had visited Waterville, Douglas, Macatawa, and Holland.

Tuesday, July 2. Arrived Mackinaw City 2:20 p.m. Car and us were taken on Ferry Cheboyen to St. Ignace. Arrived Saulte St. Marie 5:00 p.m. Hotel Obigway. Saw the big freighters going through locks.

Wednesday, July 3. Left Hotel Obigway 7:50 a.m. on Ferry to Disbury, Canada. Lunch at Murray. Arrived at North Bay Ontario 5:00 p.m. Empire Hotel.

Thursday, July 4. Left North Bay 7:05 a.m. (8:05 a.m. North Bay time) Imperial Filling Station at Pembroke Ontario without asking gave me \$5.50 Canadian for \$5.00 U.S. Extremely nice service. Lunch at Pembroke where we left at 12:45 p.m. E.S.T. Arrived Ottawa 3:30 p.m. As we had been there did not stop for more than a look around. At Prescott Ontario took ferry to Ogdensburg, N. Y. Had to prove U. S. citizenship to Customs. American Legion celebration going on streets noisy and crowded, so went on to Potsdam, N. Y. where we arrived 6:15 p.m. day light (EST) saving time. Arlington Inn.

Friday, July 5. Left Potsdam 7:55 a.m. Arrived Lake Placid 10:00 a.m. Beautiful ride and we sat in park at

Lake Placid for a while. Arrived Port Henry, Lake Champlain and lunch at Sea House. Left at 12:30 p.m. Stopped for a short time on road by Lake George about 1:30 p.m. Arrived at Albany, N. Y. 4:30 p.m. where Bill having come up from

New York City joined us for dinner at DeWitt Clinton Hotel. *Due to much publicity, he was recognized by some in dining room.*

Saturday, July 6. With Bill with us left Albany at 8:10 a.m. Arrived Princeton Inn, N. J., at 12:30 p.m. where we had lunch. Arrived Sea Bright at 4:30 p.m. Total speedometer mileage from St. Louis 1850. At Peninsula House Mather and I room 166, Bill and Malcolm 161.

Sunday, July 7. We went to First Baptist Church Grand and Third Avenues, Asbury Park, New Jersey. Bill left after dinner by train from Red Bank at 8:15 p.m.

Monday, July 8. Malcolm and I went in ocean in morning. Bill came over on 6:20 p.m. boat and returned via 10:20 p.m. boat.

Tuesday, July 9. We took tide to Fort Monmouth. Bill could not come over.

Wednesday, July 10. Took car for 1000 mile check. Bill could not come over.

Thursday, July 11. Put new battery in Buick. Malcolm spent day in N.Y.C. returned on 6:30 p.m. boat. Went swimming.

Friday, July 12. Raining and cold. Drove around country west of Red Bank. Bill arrived on 6:30 p.m. boat and after dinner went to our room where Bill read to us from book by Hall.?

Saturday, July 13. At 9:30 a.m. Mother, Bill, Malcolm and I left for Ocean City. Arrived there 12:30 p.m. Saw apartment where we all stayed with Flora. Ate lunch Hanscom Hotel at 1:00 p.m. Left Ocean City 3:45 p.m. Arrived Sea Bright 5:20 p.m.

Sunday, July 14. Mother, Bill, Malcolm and I went to First Presbyterian Church at Red Bank. Malcolm's vacation over so he left with Bill on train from Red Bank at 8:10 p.m.

Monday, July 15. Presley came over with Bill on 6:30 p.m. boat and had dinner with us.

Tuesday, July 16. Morning cloudy and cold. Went swimming in afternoon but water was 63°. Brought Bill in from 6:30 boat and we listened on our car radio to speeches at Democratic Convention. Finished listening to Barclay's speech at hotel. Got to bed at 12:30 a.m.

Wednesday, July 17. Mother and I drove to Point Pleasant and saw Miss Caroline Wallace at 350 Parkway Drive.

Thursday, July 18. Bill came for dinner on 6:30 p.m. boat and we listened on car radio to nominations for vice-president.

Friday, July 19. Weather warmer and I went in ocean morning and afternoon. Bill came on 6:30 p.m. boat for weekend.

Saturday, July 20. The hottest day so far. I went in the ocean twice.

Sunday, July 21. Mother, Bill and I went to First Presbyterian Church Red Bank. We took Bill to 8:10 p.m. train

at Red Bank. Weather very hot.

Monday, July 22. Bill came over on 6:30 p.m. boat for dinner.

Tuesday, July 23. Met Bill at 6:30 p.m. boat.

Wednesday, July 24. Phillip Walker of Farr Electrical Company of New York City gave me a Hyde Park pipe from Birks, Toronto. Bill did not come over.

Thursday, July 25. Bill had to go before S.E.C. in Washington. Flew from Washington to New York and barely caught boat, arriving Sea Bright 6:30 p.m. Said he thought conference was satisfactory. We took him to 10:20 p.m. boat.

Friday, July 26. Took my watch which had stopped running to Wilbur Jewelry Company at Red Bank. Said it needed cleaning but I feared to leave it. Bought a Westclox watch for \$1.50. Bill came over in heavy storm on 6:30 p.m. boat. I met him but Mother was not with me as the weather was very wild. Bill had with him Mr. Davis, Chairman of Newman & Davis and I met him. The home of P. W. Walker who gave me the pipe was in Leonia, New Jersey.

Saturday, July 27. Swimming in morning. After lunch 2:30 p.m. Bill, Craig Fitzpatrick and I went as Bill's guests to Sea Bright Tennis Tournament. Saw women Marble and Palfrey win finals from Arnold and Bundy. Riggs won over Kovacs.

Sunday, July 28. Mother, Bill and I went to First Presbyterian Church at Red Bank, where we found one of our hotel clerks, A. Leroy Baker was tenor in choir. Took Bill to 8:10 p.m. train at Red Bank.

July 29, Monday. Paid bills at hotel and H. L. Zobel Auto Company and took care of waitress (Muriel) the head waitress, Miss Mitchell, "Dr. Fosdick" guards, etc. Took Bill to train at Red Bank. Mother stayed to pack up.

Tuesday, July 30. Left Sea Bright at 7:15 a.m. *Mother & I*
Arrived Harrisburg at 1:00 p.m. for lunch. Arrived Chambersburg 3:10 p.m. and after a beautiful ride at Bedford, Pa. 5:30 p.m. This ride was over the mountains. Stayed at Fort Bedford Inn.

Wednesday, July 31. Left Bedford at 8:20 a.m. Washington, Pa. 12 noon. Arrived Wheeling, West Virginia at 1:20 p.m. day light saving and there ate lunch at Hotel McLure. Arrived at Columbus, Ohio, about 4:30 p.m. daylight saving. Traffic heavy and took some time to get through city. Arrived Springfield, Ohio, 7:15 p.m. daylight but found it 6:15 p.m. their time. Stayed at Shawnee Hotel.

Thursday, August 1. About three miles out of Springfield had an emergency purchase of gas. Left Springfield at 7:00 a.m. Arrived Indianapolis 11:30 a.m. Springfield time but only 9:30 a.m. Indianapolis time where Claypool Hotel was still serving breakfast. Arrived Decatur, Illinois, at 2:00 p.m. Got a good room at the Orlando Hotel, so Mother and I stayed there.

Friday, August 2. Left Decatur at 6:40 a.m. Had fan belt fixed at garage. Arrived ⁵⁰⁵²Waterman at 9:35 a.m. Total cost of vacation \$812.09.

Wednesday, June 25. Malcolm on vacation from Cotton Belt was taking the Bar Examination at Columbia, Missouri, so Mother and I drove there to pick him up. We left 5055 Waterman at 8:40 a.m. Left key to our house with Wynne. Arrived at Columbia at 11:15 a.m. Went to Malcolm's room 712 Tiger Hotel, but missed him as he was waiting in lobby. We finally connected and had lunch together. Malcolm took over the driving and we arrived Keokuk at 5:30 p.m. Hotel Iowa. After dinner drove around and sat in park above river.

Thursday, June 26. Left Keokuk where we viewed locks at 7:50 a.m. Arrived Cedar Rapids 11:20 a.m. Lunch Roosevelt Hotel. Arrived Winona Hotel, Winona, ^{Minn.} ~~Miss.~~, 5:50 p.m. Sat on chairs in front of hotel until drizzle drove us in. Sent telegram to Wynne at St. Louis.

Friday, June 27. Left Winona early drove through Eau Claire, Minn. Arrived for lunch at Northern Hotel, Chippewa Falls, 11:30 a.m. Went over bridge from Superior, Wis., to Duluth, Minn. Arrived Hotel Duluth at 4:40 p.m. Got an excellent room with fine view of lake and piers.

Saturday, June 28. Dense fog. Malcolm and I spent afternoon on pier and Minn. Point.

Sunday, June 29. Went to First Presbyterian Church and heard Archer E. Anderson.

Monday, June 30. Clear and we took skyline drive and saw Trading Block House preserved at Fron Du Lac, 55 miles

from Duluth. It had two bastions and logs were smooth outside. There were two rooms and a loft. There was a rough stone fire place.

Tuesday, July 1. Drove through Two Harbors and arrived at Gooseberry Falls State Park at 11:45 a.m. Round trip 87 miles. In afternoon sat in Lief Erickson Park. There is replica of boat in which he came to America before Columbus. Drove to breakwater for short stay.

Wednesday, July 2. Weather beautiful and spent morning in Lief Erickson Park. In afternoon Malcolm and I went to Pier and had an interesting talk with light house keeper.

Thursday, July 3. We had rooms 540 Mother and I and Malcolm had adjoining room 542. Fine location. Left Duluth 8:20 a.m. Lunch Iron Wood Hotel at Curry at 11:20 a.m. Had to wait until 12:00 noon for dining room to open. Left Iron Wood at 1:10 p.m. Arrived at Marquette, Michigan, at 5:00 p.m. Hotel Northland.

Friday, July 4. Left Marquette at 6:05 a.m. Hotel not open so got breakfast at Emmy's Grill. Not so bad. In coming out Hotel I tripped on top step and fell to the driveway; jarred a little but not hurt. Arrived St. Ignace 11:40 a.m. (EST) Took ferry "City of Munsing" over Straits of Macinac. Arrived Challevoix 3:10 p.m. and had pleasant visit with Vie Matthews. Left at 4:10 p.m. and arrived at Traverse City (Park Hotel) at 5:35 p.m.

Saturday, July 5. Left Traverse City at 8:40 a.m. Lunch at 11:50 a.m. at Stearns Hotel, Ludington. Not good. Muskegon 2:00 p.m. Drove around Spring Lake and Grand Haven and arrived at Warm Friend Tavern in Holland, Michigan, at 4:40 p.m. Mother visited Miss Carrie Miller in her room 369.

Sunday, July 6. Went to First Reformed Church. Miss Carrie Miller with us for dinner. Left Holland at 1:40 p.m. Arrived Kankakee 6:40 p.m.

Monday, July 7. Left Hotel Kankakee at 9:00 a.m. (EST) arrived Decatur, Illinois 11:00 a.m. where we had lunch at Orlando Hotel. Left Decatur 12 noon. Arrived St. Louis 5055 Waterman at 3:00 p.m. Miles traveled on this trip 2311. Cost of trip \$249.75.

We found the accommodations and meals good at Hotel Duluth. Took our rides from there and returned for meals as coffee shop was open at all hours.
