Application of the City of Chattanooga for designation as a reserve city was referred to Mr. Harding, Mr. Delano and Mr. Williams as a special committee.

A draft form for use in arranging for increase and decrease of the capital stock of Federal reserve banks, recommended by Counsel of the Board, was approved.

Mr. Harding made a general statement with reference to his conclusions as to the question of clearing checks, giving the results of study of the subject during the past few days.

A resolution of recognition and appreciation regarding the Gold Fund work was ordered drafted for transmission to the Gold Fund Committee.

The Board approved the applications of the National

Bank of Sumter, South Carolina and the First National Bank of Spencer, North Carolina, for admission to the system, and the applications of a number of banks for additional stock in Federal reserve banks, the same having been approved in every case by Mr. Harding, as Chairman of Committee #6, as follows:
