


At a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Federal Reserve Board, held in the office of the Governor at 12:00 P. M. on Saturday, September 23, 1916,

PRESENT:


- Governor Harding, presiding, Mr. Miller.

A telegram was presented from the Federal Reserve Agent at Dallas requesting the shipment of \$1,000,000 in Federal Reserve notes of the \$10 denomination, and this request was approved. The Secretary was directed to ask the Director of the Bureau of Engraving and Printing to expedite the printing of \$10 notes for the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas.
