Applications for Federal Reserve notes, approved by the Committee on Issue and Redemption, were approved by the Executive Committee as follows:-

Application of the Federal Reserve Agent at Philadelphia that \$300,000 in fives, \$200,000 in tens, and \$640,000 in twenties, be released by the Assistant Treasurer at Philadelphia to him.

Application of the Federal Reserve Agent at Atlanta, that \$260,000 in fives, and \$240,000 in tens, be released by the Assistant Treasurer at New Orleans to the New Orleans Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta.
